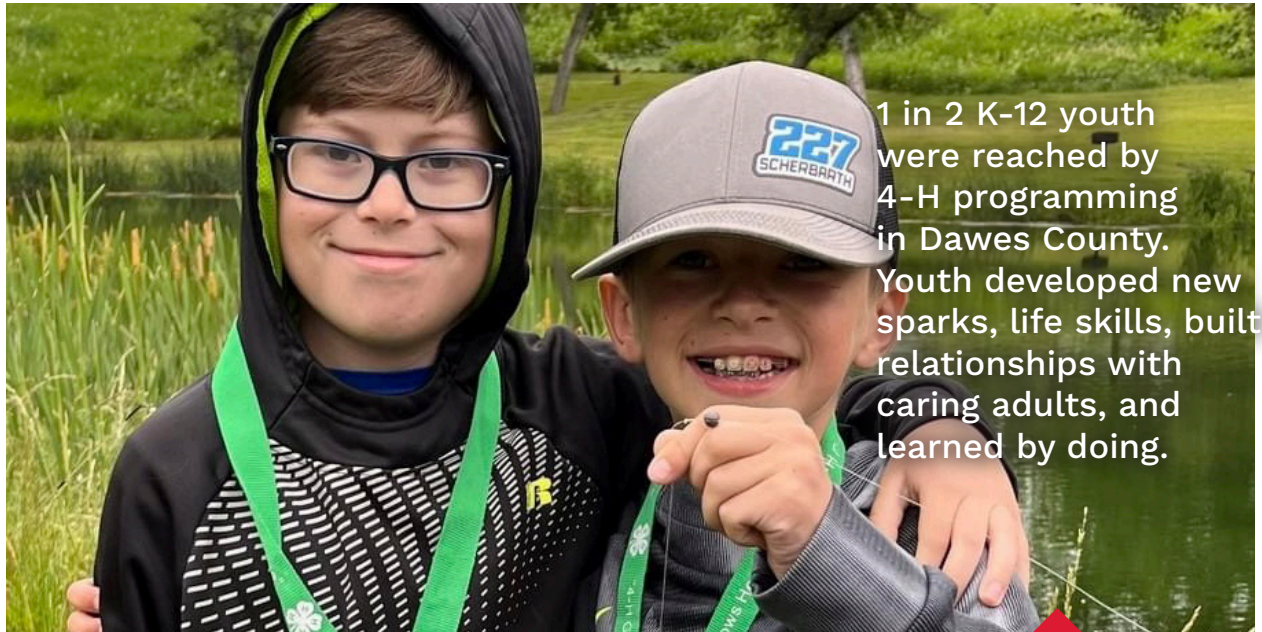


# Dawes County

Nebraska Extension Dawes County partnered with Nebraska Game and Parks to offer a 4-H fishing workshop in Nebraska's Chadron State Park. Youth learned about common types of fish in Nebraska, differences in fishing poles, baits, angler ethics, and spent a few hours fishing.
