



Through a variety of business and organization partnerships, Extension is able to unlock diverse perspectives, shared resources, and synergy to increase impact beyond what we can achieve alone.

In 2023, Richardson County Extension partnered with over 20 local businesses and organization to implement 4-H and youth development programs. By partnering with Falls City Chamber of Commerce, Richardson County offered a Lemonade Stand Camp for the third consecutive year. At the camp, youth learn entrepreneurial and business start-up skills to create and host a lemonade stand coinciding with a major downtown event. Chamber director said, “Our kids and businesses look forward to this event every year. We could provide this program without our partnership with the Extension Office!”

### Programs At-A-Glance

- Private Pesticide Trainings - 49 local clientele were certified as private pesticide applicators. Clients said, “As labels change daily, this information provides good reminders.”
- Co-Parenting for Successful Kids: Over one dozen Richardson County families completed the program. Parents who participated reported learning helpful strategies to reduce conflict.
