



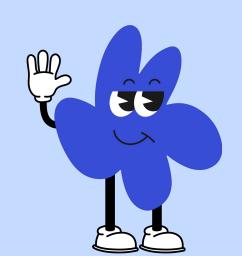

Slide 5: Bingo


- Give each student a Bingo card.

Slide 7: Needs & Wants Book


- Give each student the Needs and Wants Book (With and Without Pictures).
- Have them fill in the words Needs and Wants, and their names.





















Call List
