Resources and Activity Worksheets

Slide 5: Break the Bank Counting Game

Students must determine the value of a group of coins and group of bills.

Slide 6: Think, Pair, Share

- Pair up students to discuss and listen to each other as they discuss why people need to earn money and how people earn money
- Discuss as a class
- Set up next slide: We are going to watch a video about a boy named Aaron who wants to earn money. Let's see if his reason matches any of ours.

Resources and Activity Worksheets

Slide 12: Silent Solo

- Before you play the video, ask the students to think for a couple of minutes about the different chores Aaron may have done to help him earn money to pay for his bike. And think about how adults earn money.
- In this video, 100 kids share what they want to be when they grow up. What do you want to be?
