


AnyCable learnings

Architecture vs. scaling

Realtime requests should be serviced and scaled independently from HTTP requests





Imagine your server as a phone line:

HTTP requests are like brief phone calls: you dial, get information, and hang up.

WebSocket connections are like the dial-up modem If the two are competing, WebSockets win all resources they need—as seen by our customers

Realtime requests should be serviced and scaled independently from HTTP requests





Startups at Evil Martians

- it worked with imgproxy and CanFy







- —Use AnyCable for LLM streaming over WS or SSE
