**[COUNTRY]** is a programming instruction. The computer-assisted personal interviewing device will automatically display the country where the respondent has declared to be living for the interviewer to read out.

The same holds true for the programming instruction **[ROMA BACKGROUND]**. Roma background is used as an umbrella term and is tailored to the specific term(s) used in the survey countries.

Some of the questions for interviewers are checks (e.g. for plausibility and survey participation requirements). These checks will be formatted in the same way as normal questions.

There are questions where the interviewer is asked to show a card to the respondent (**SHOW CARD XXXX**). Show cards are visual aids from which the respondent chooses the answer to the survey question (see Annex III).
