Field Dates: April 24-25, 2024



SURVEY METHOD

This survey was conducted online within the United States from **April 24-25, 2024 among 1,961 registered voters by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.**

Respondents for this poll are recruited through opt-in, web-panel recruitment sampling. Recruitment occurs through a broad variety of professional, validated respondent panels to expand the sampling frame as wide as possible and minimize the impact of any given panel on recruiting methods.

Results are weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online. The margin of error for the total sample is +/- 2%.

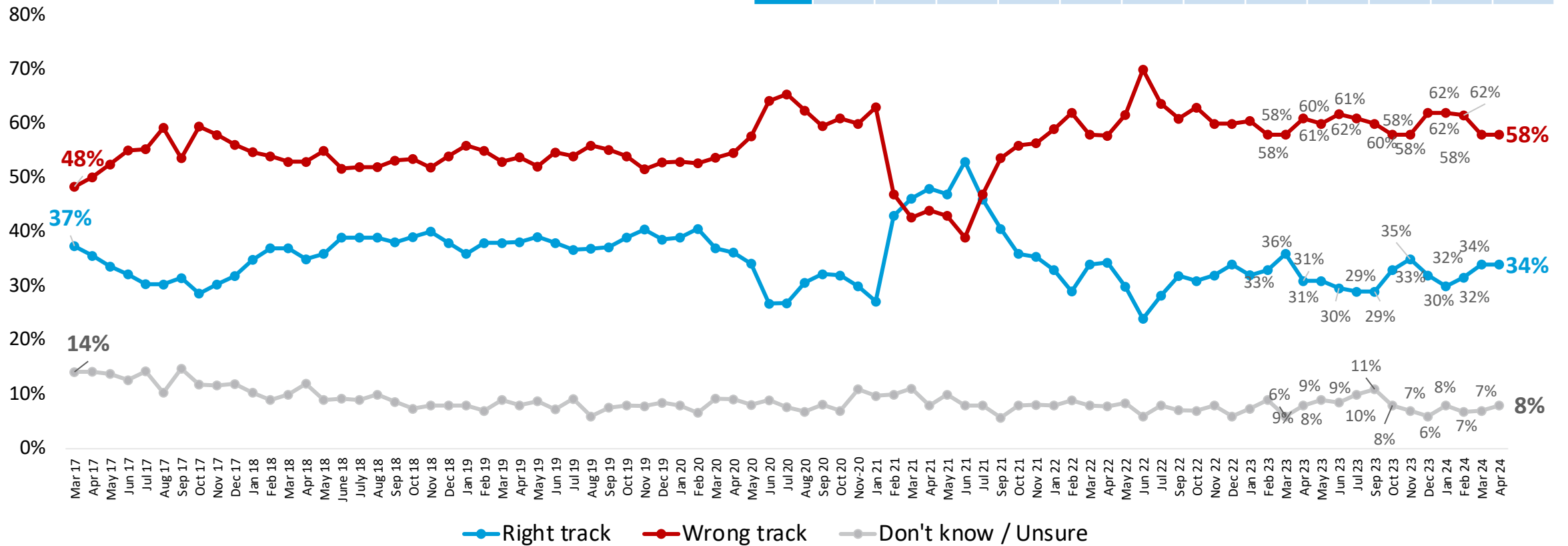

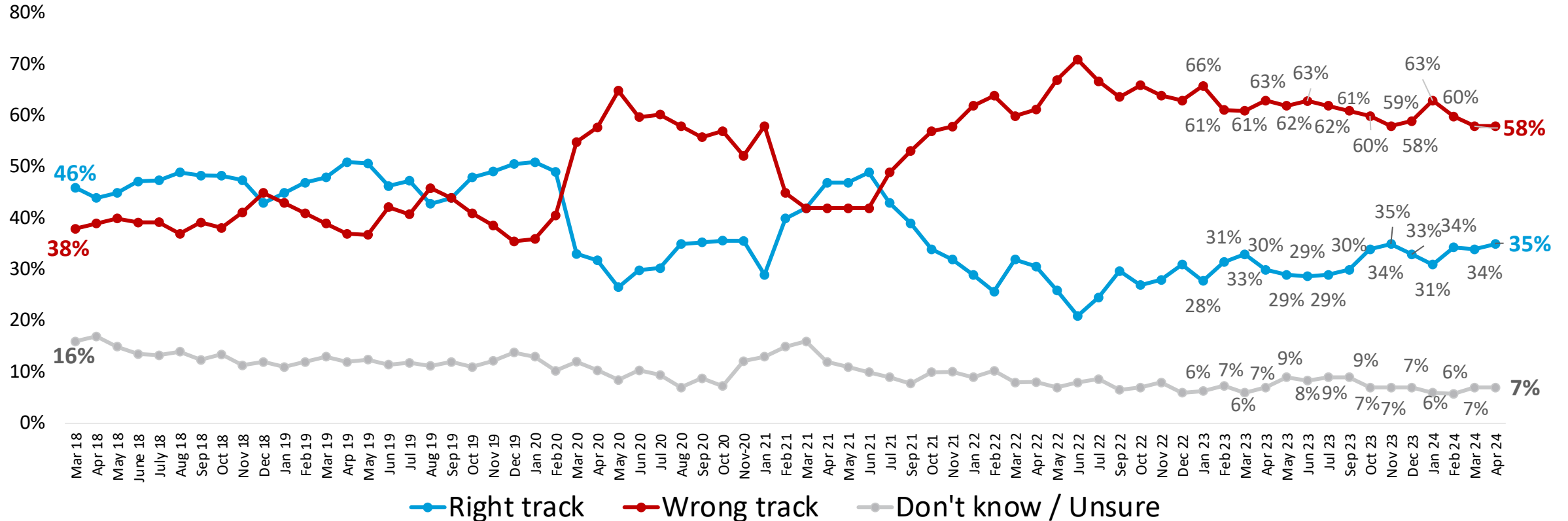

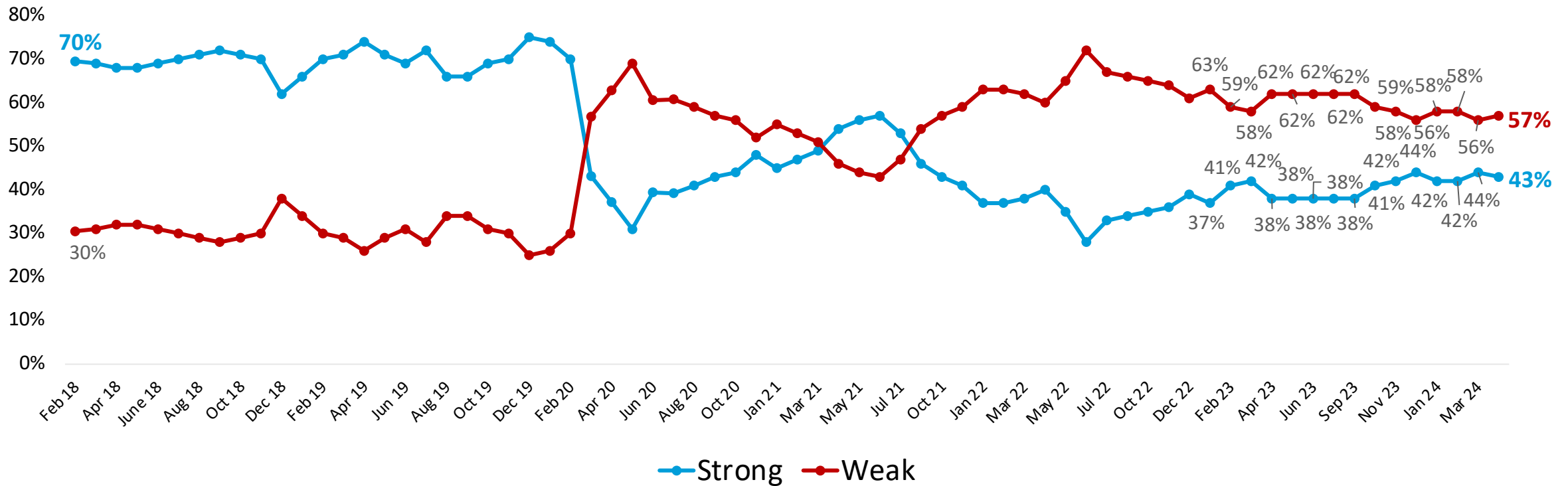
U.S. Economy: Right Track / Wrong Track



M2. In general, do you think the American economy is on the right track or is it off on the wrong track?

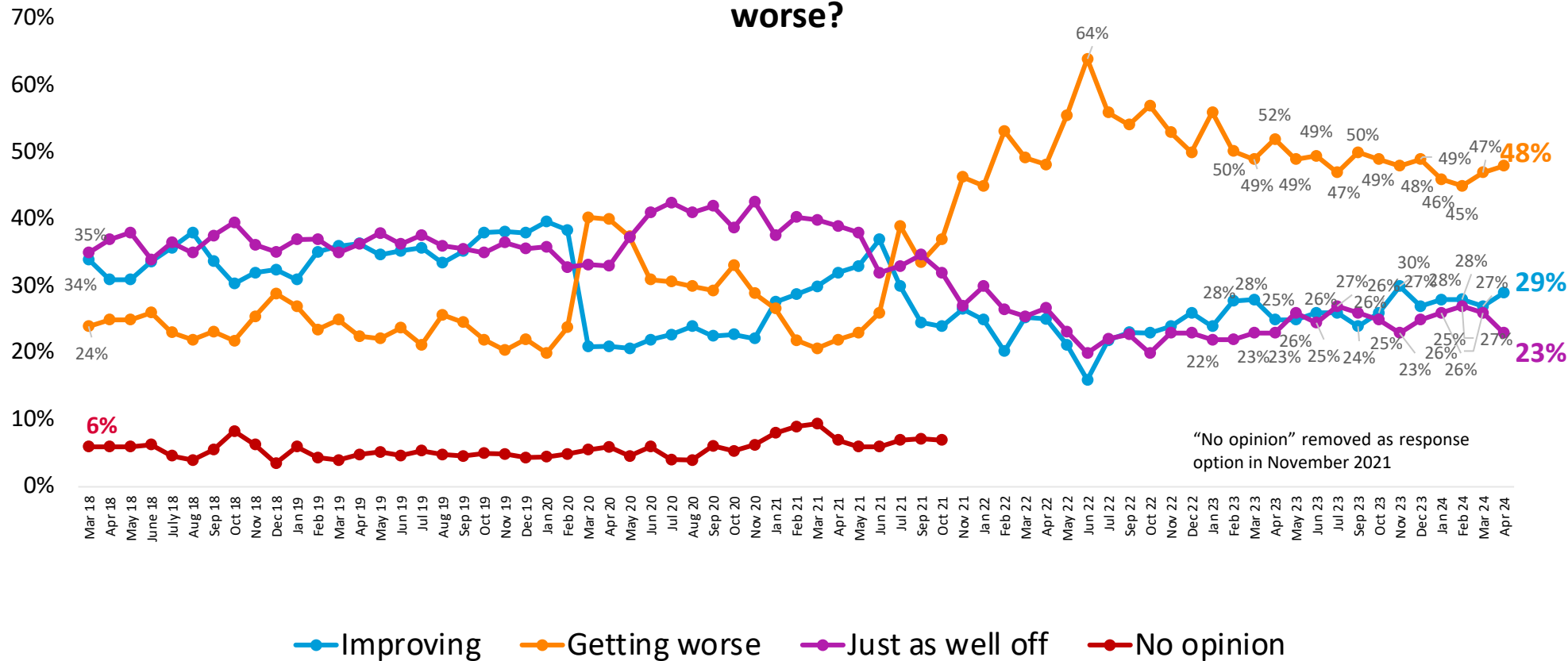

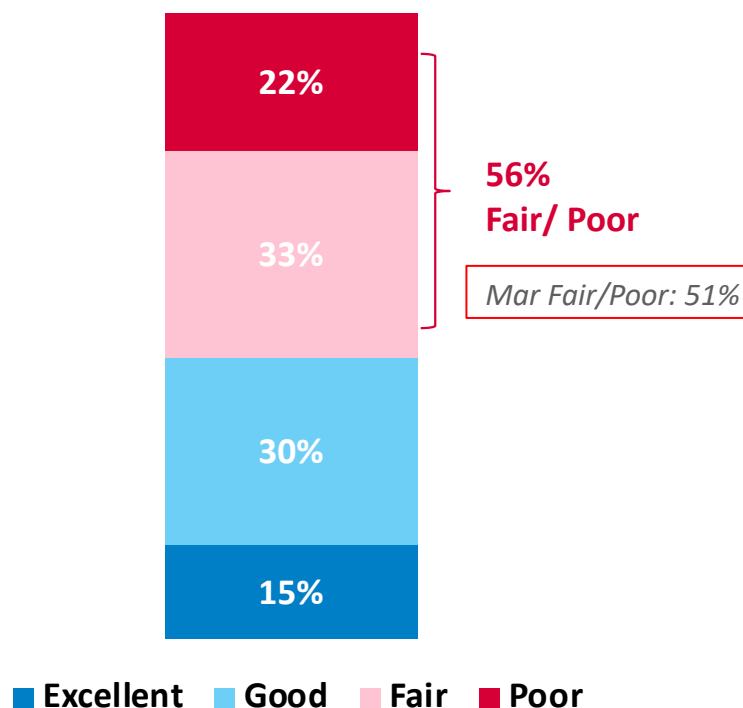

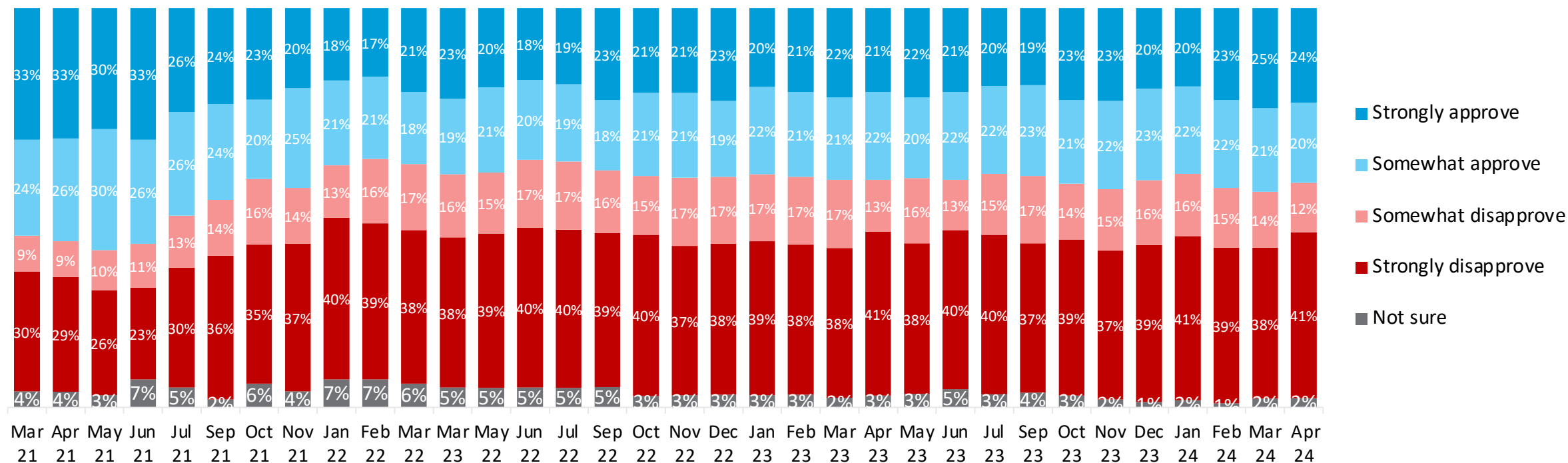

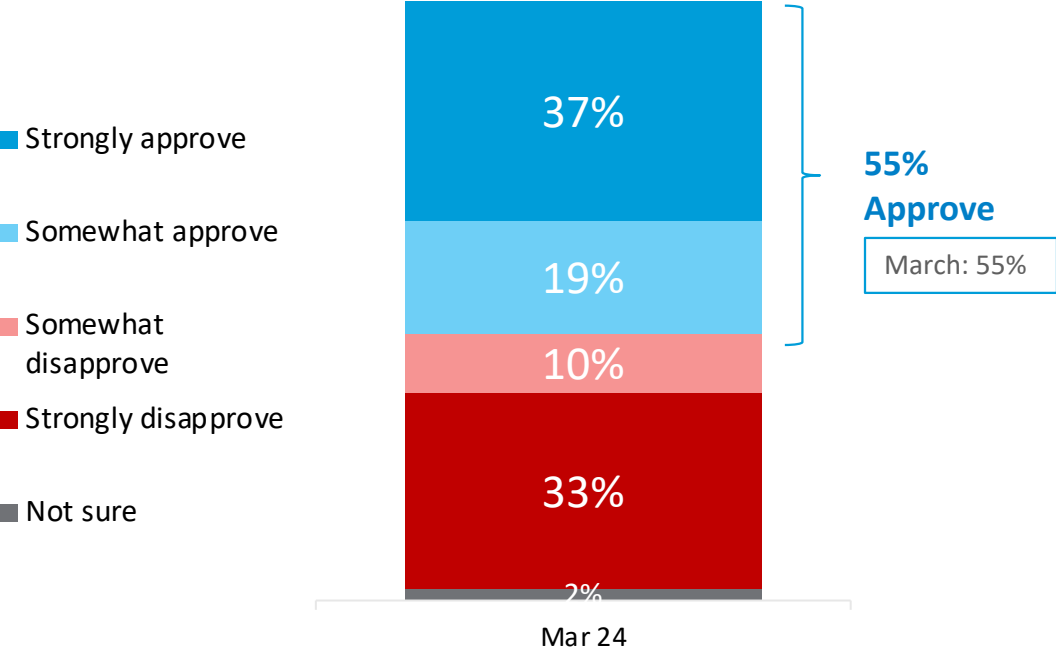

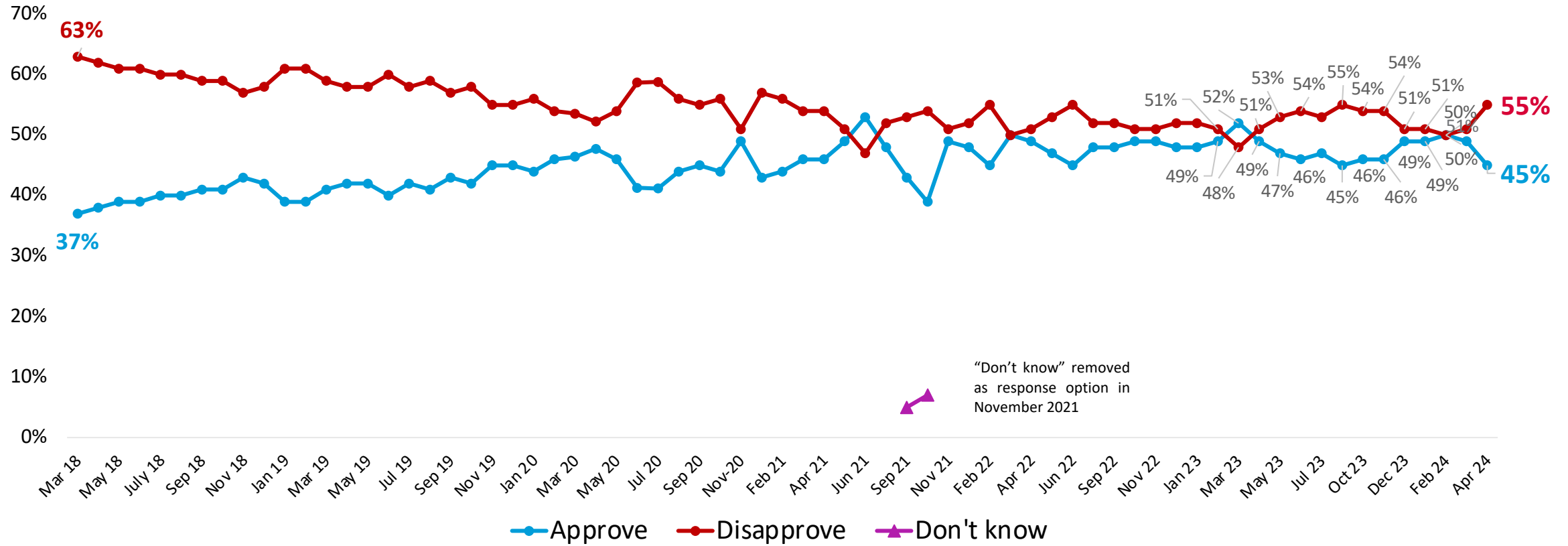

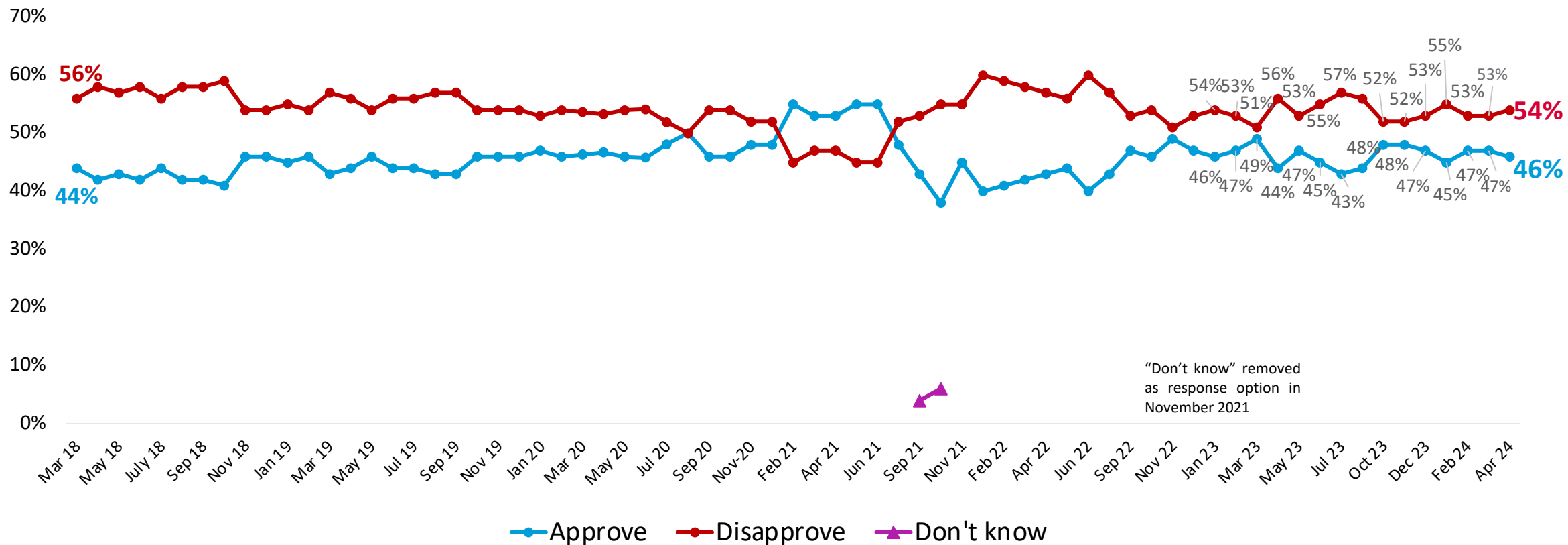

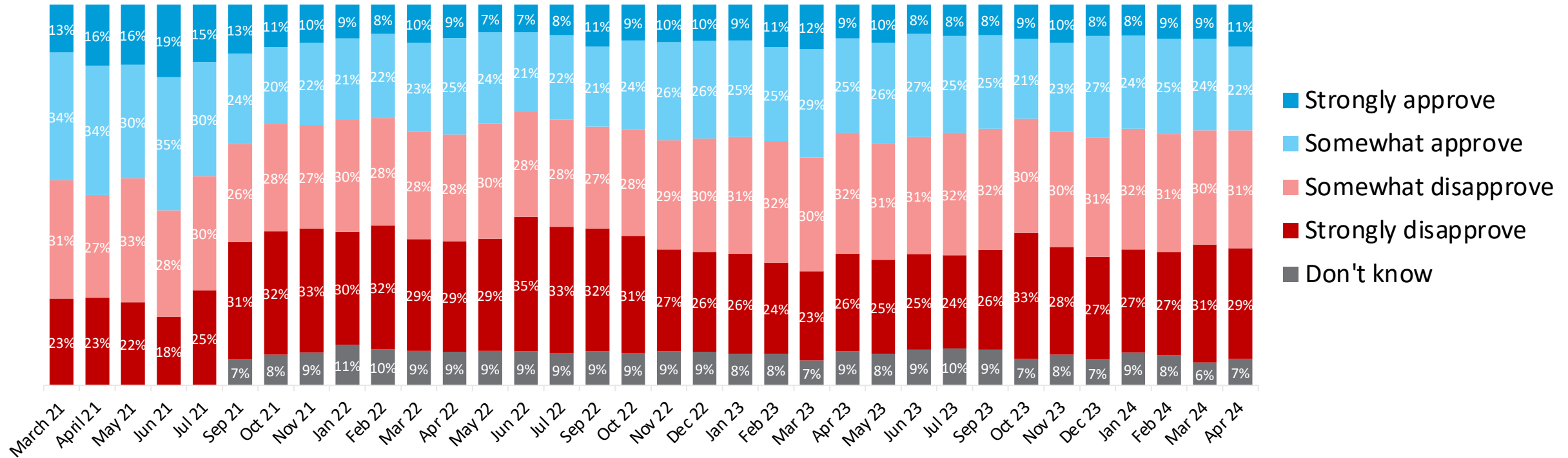

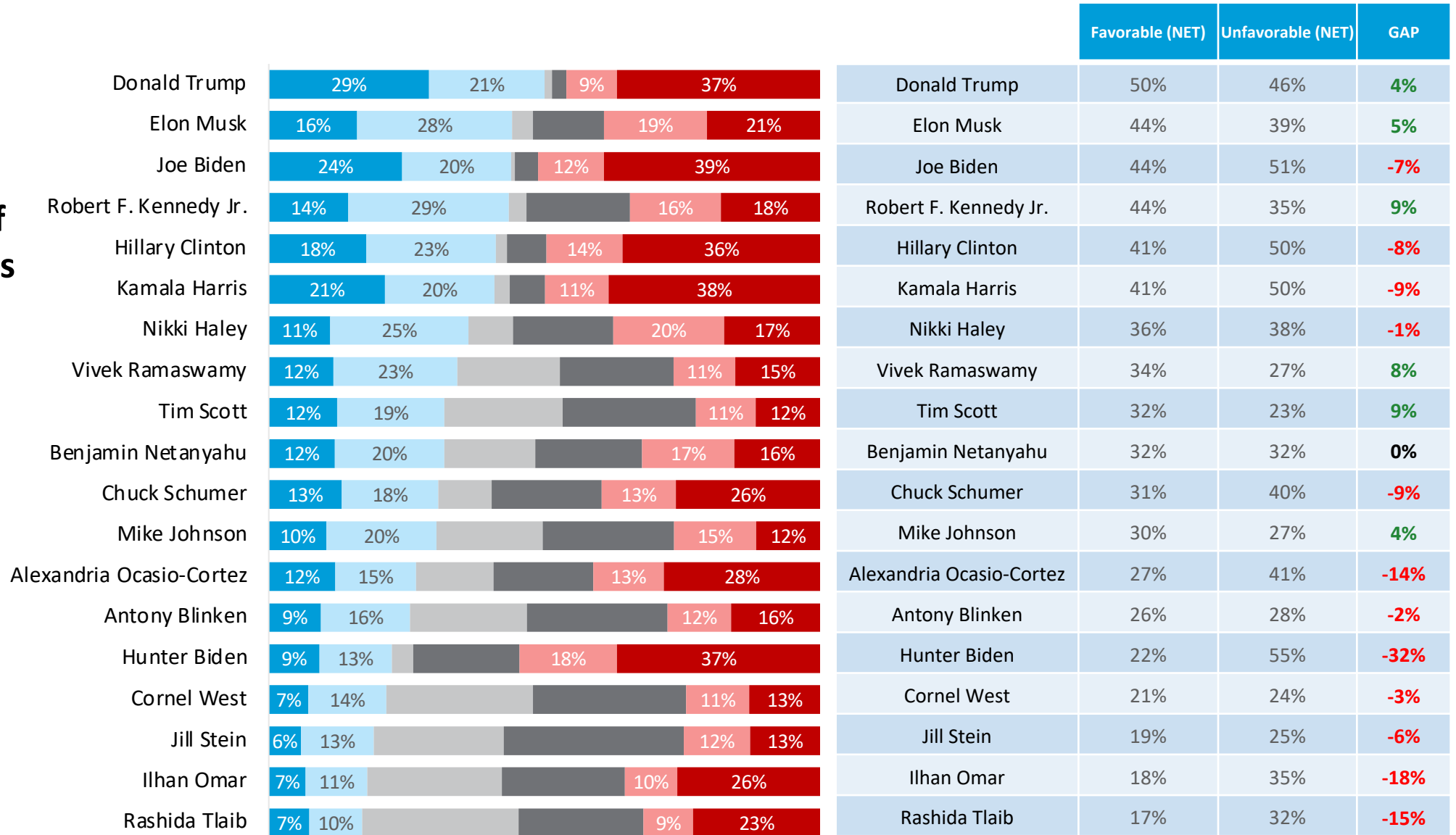

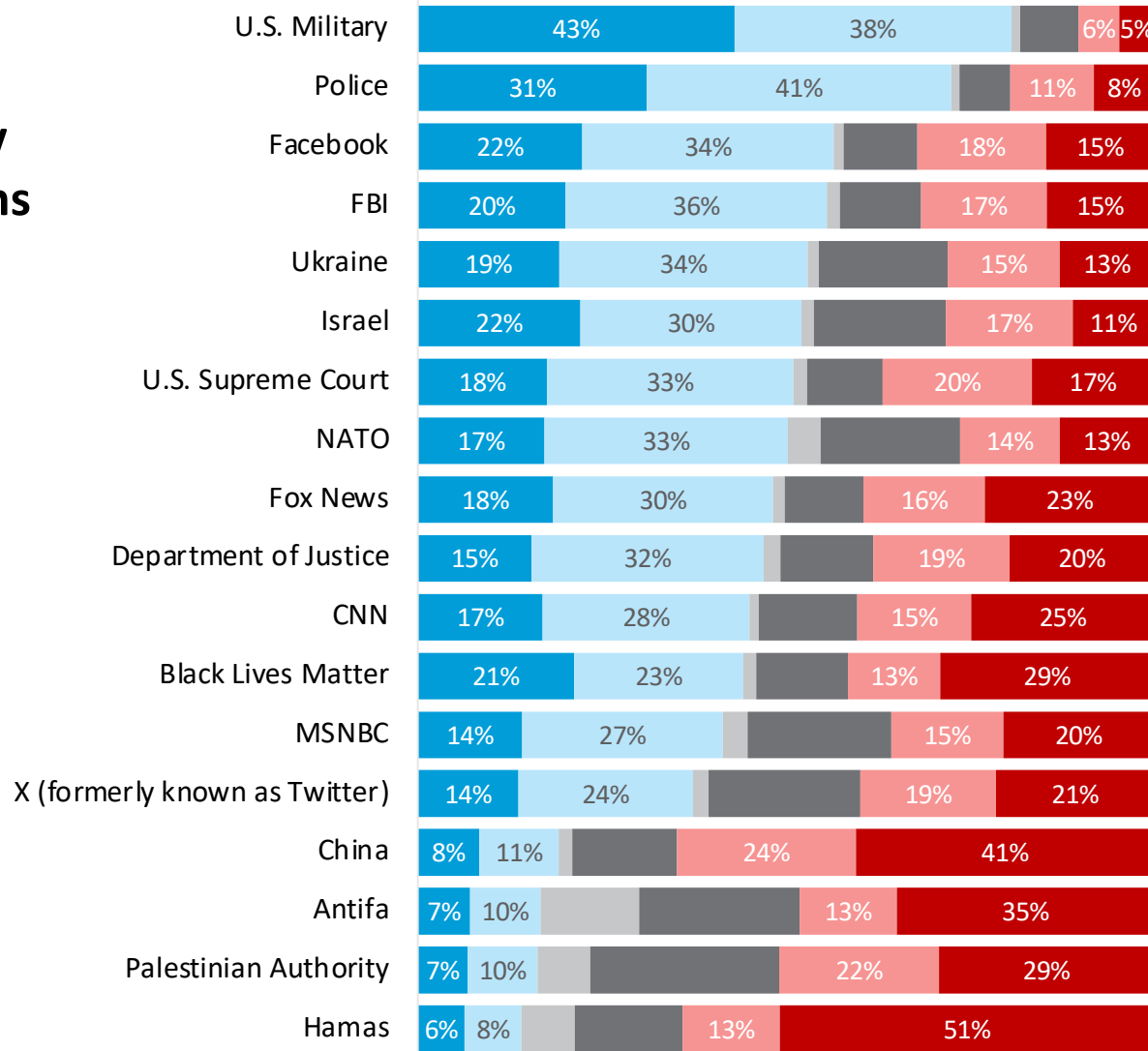

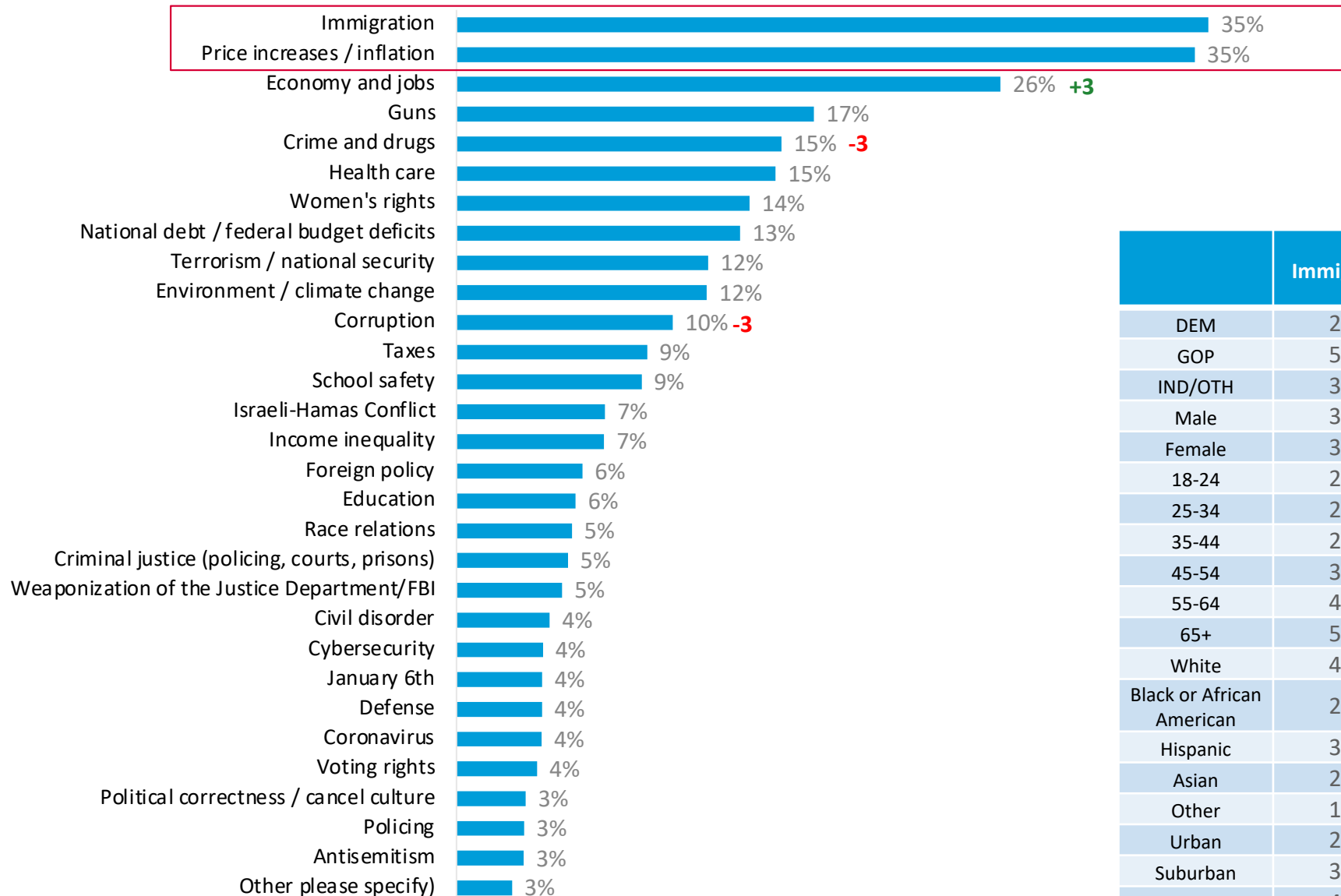

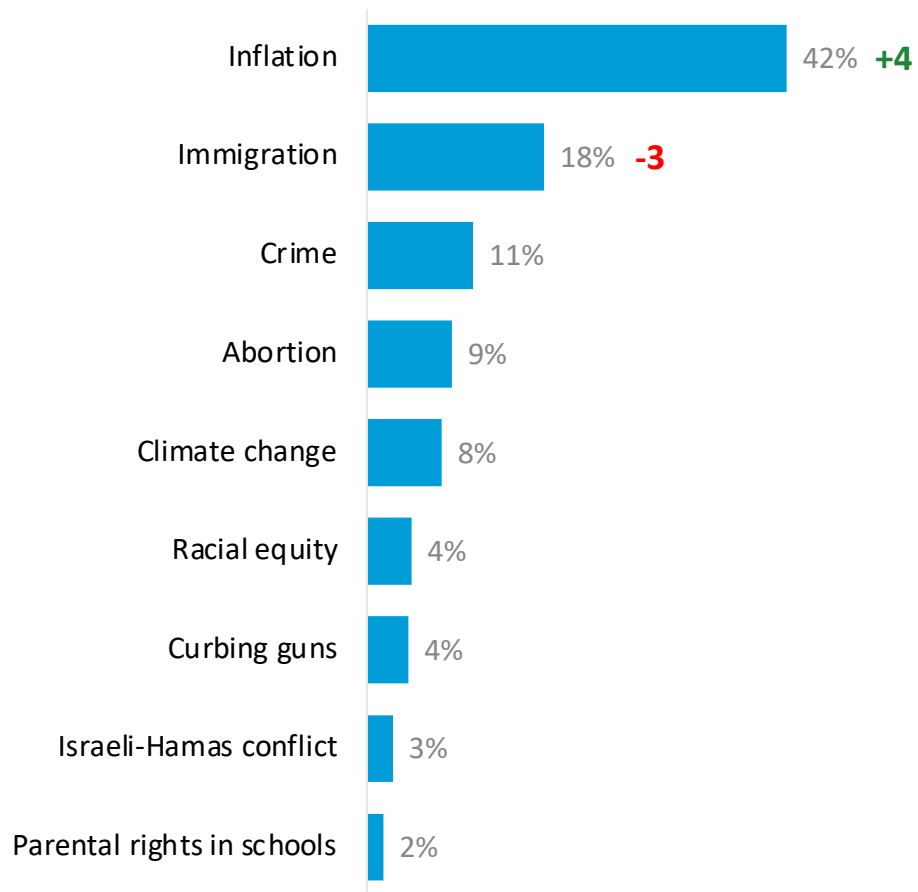

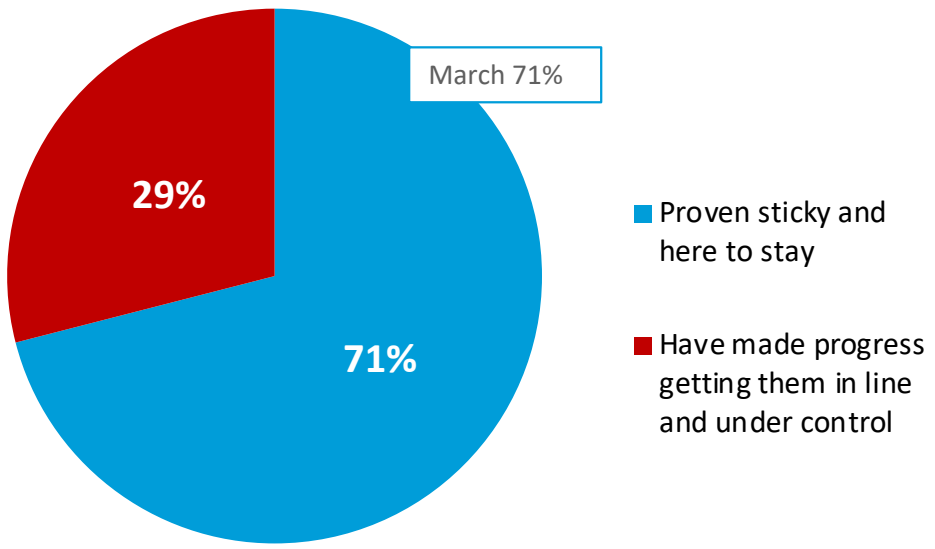

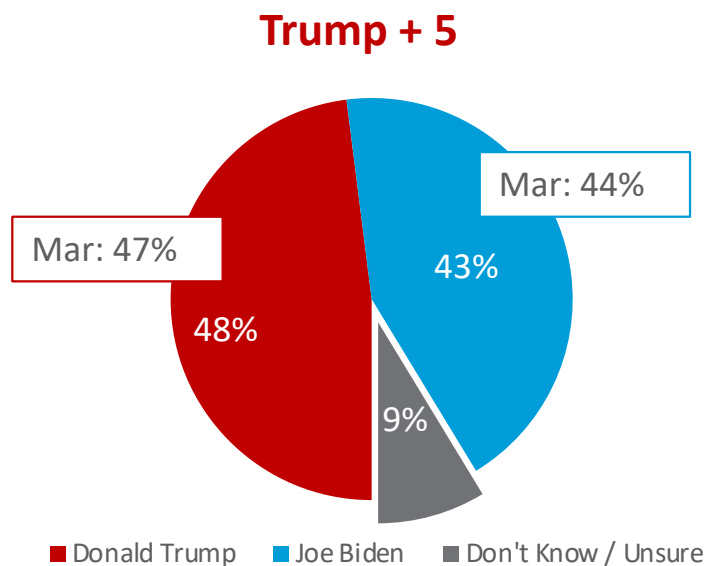

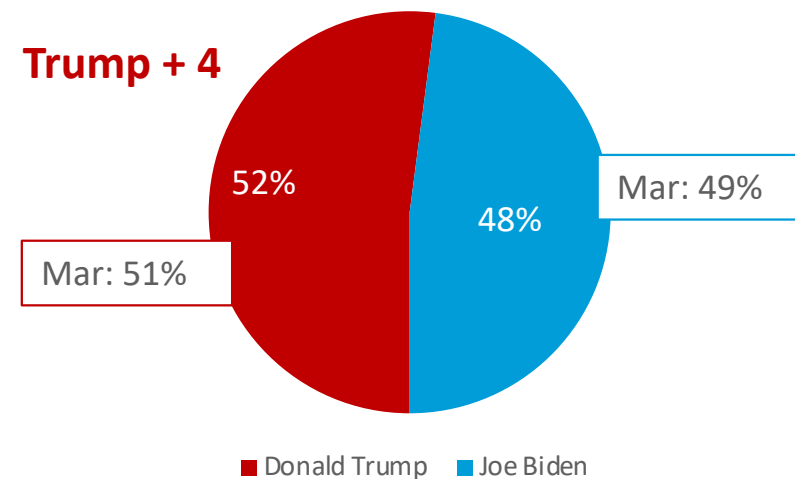

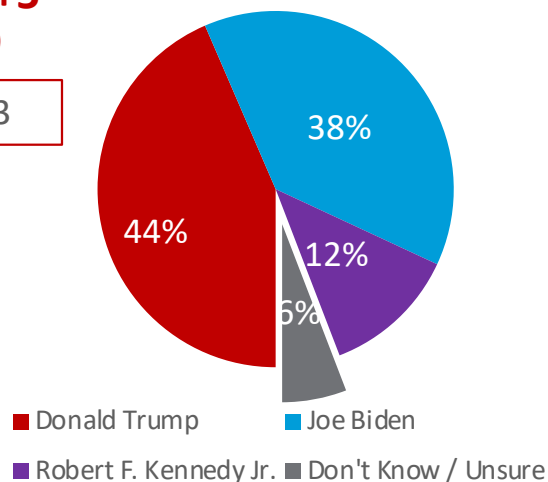

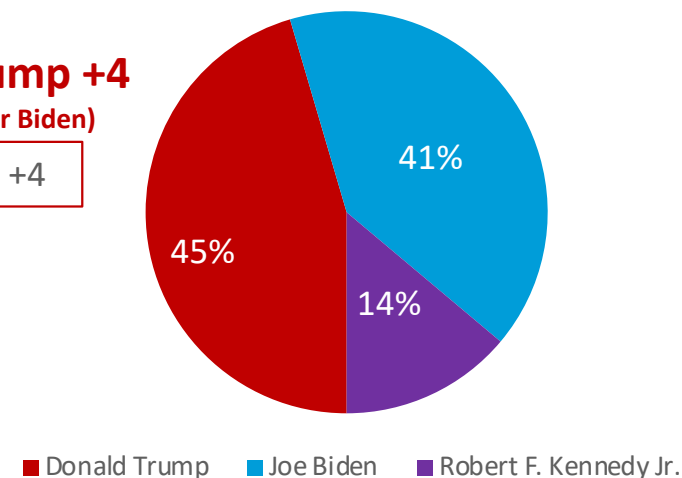

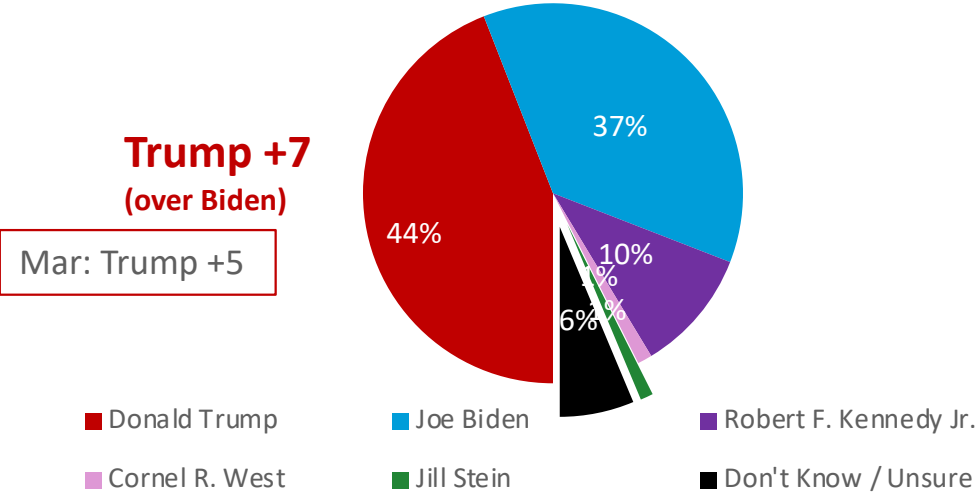

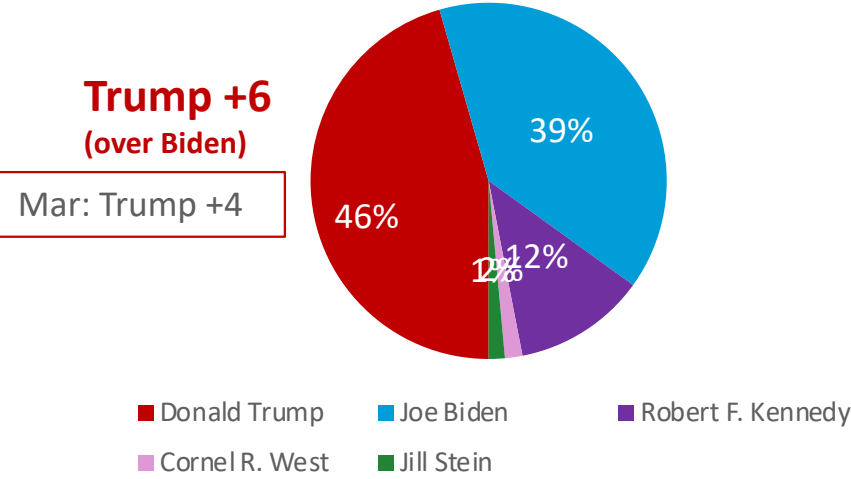

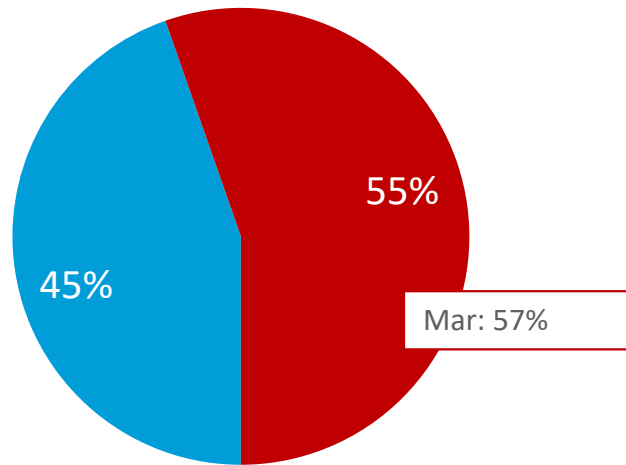

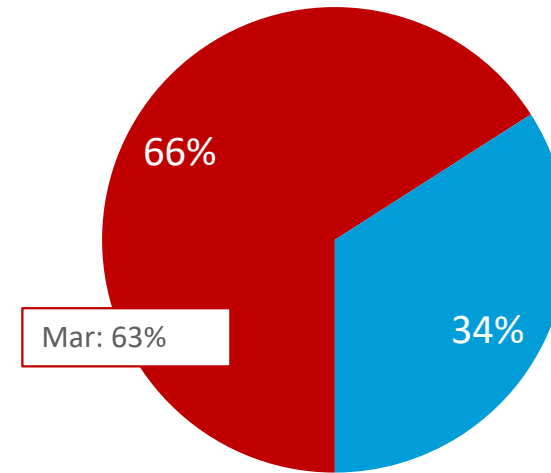

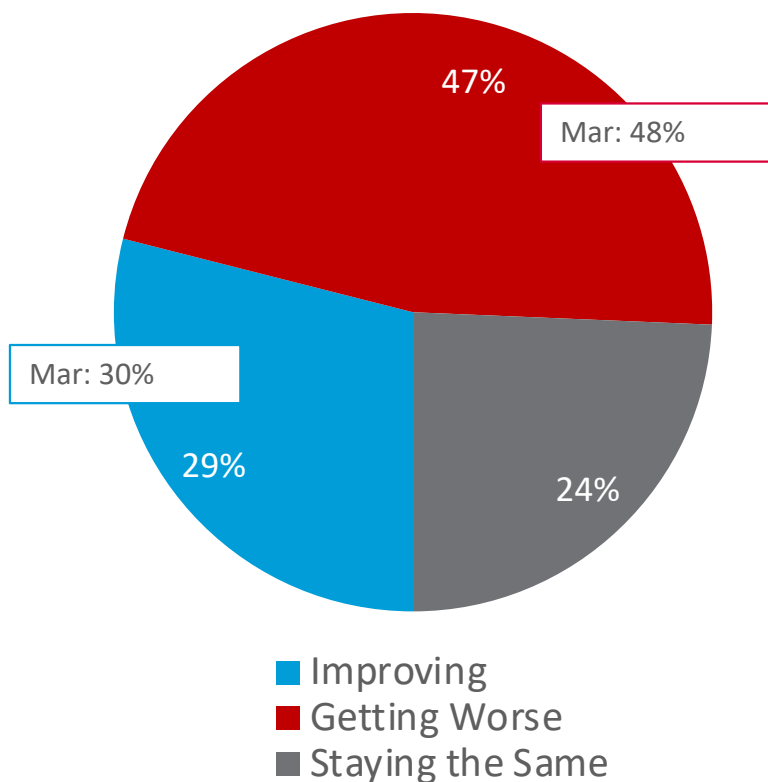

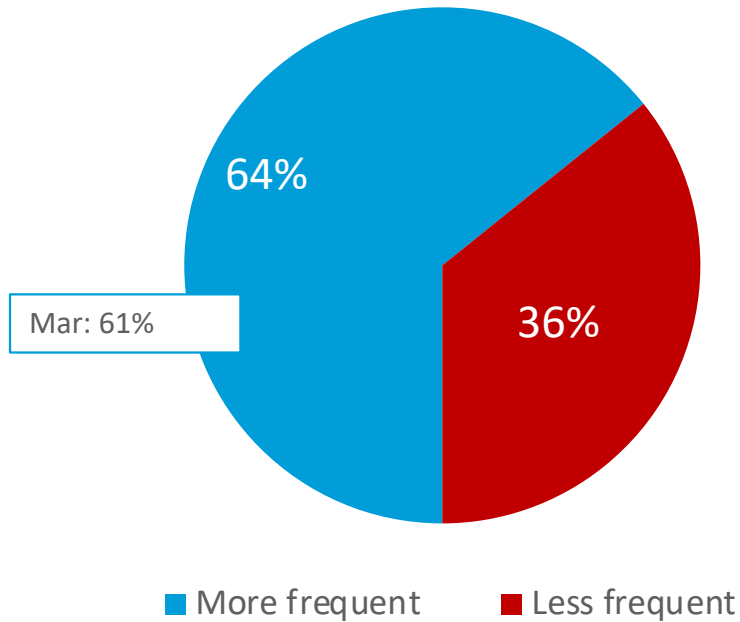

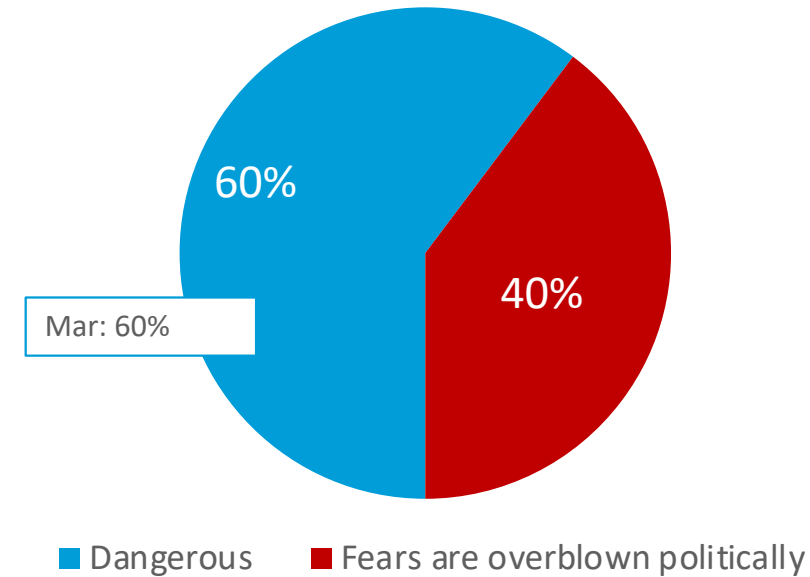

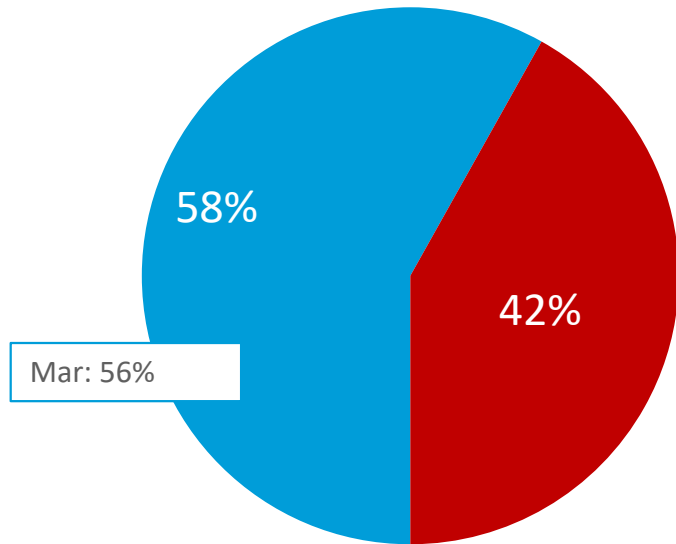

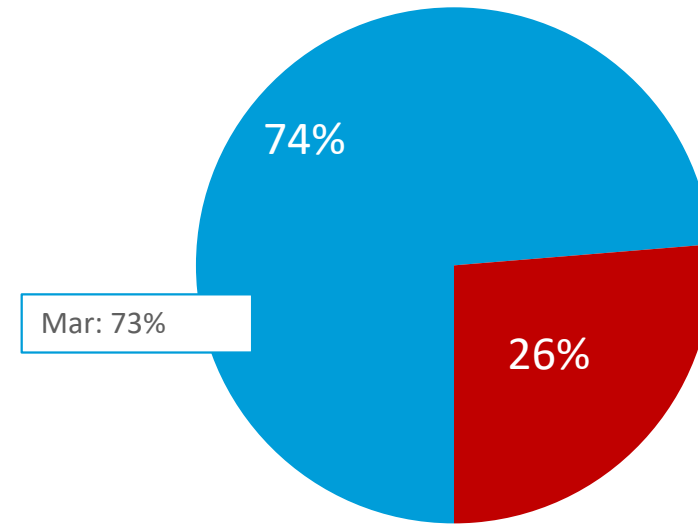

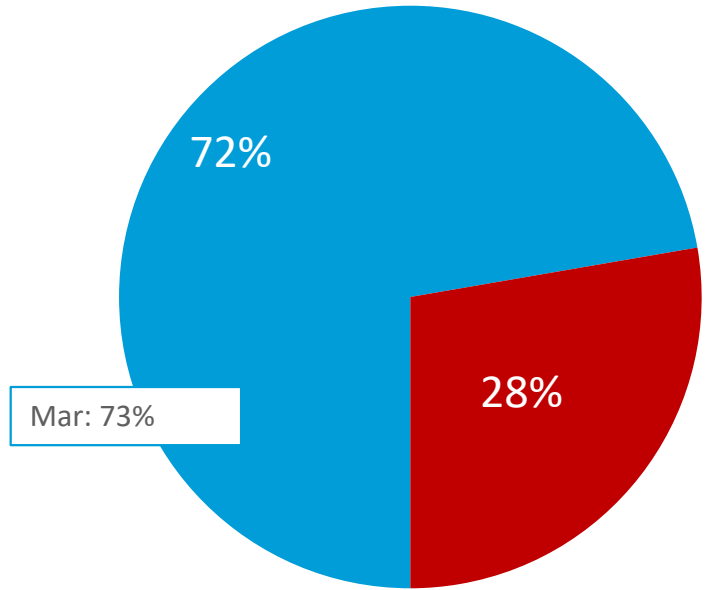

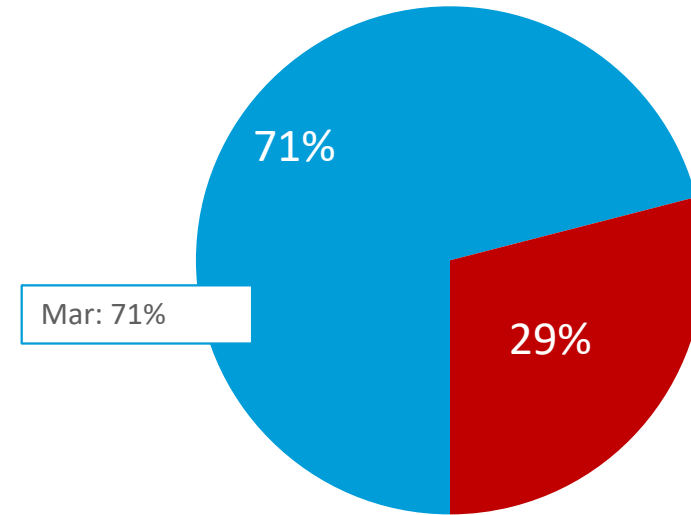

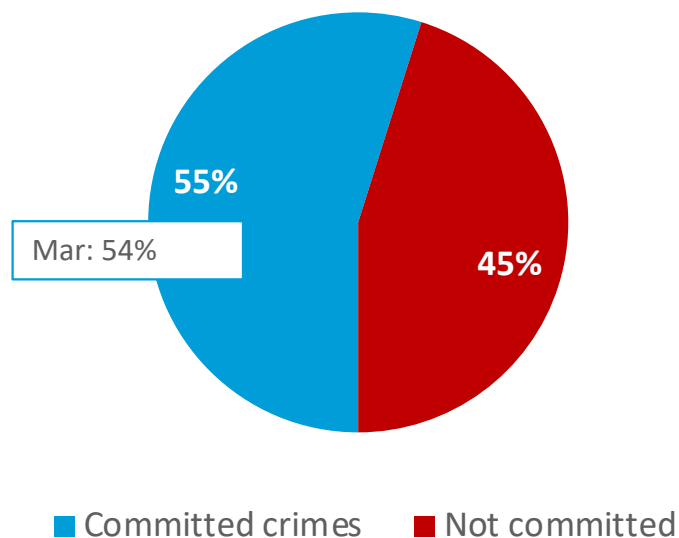

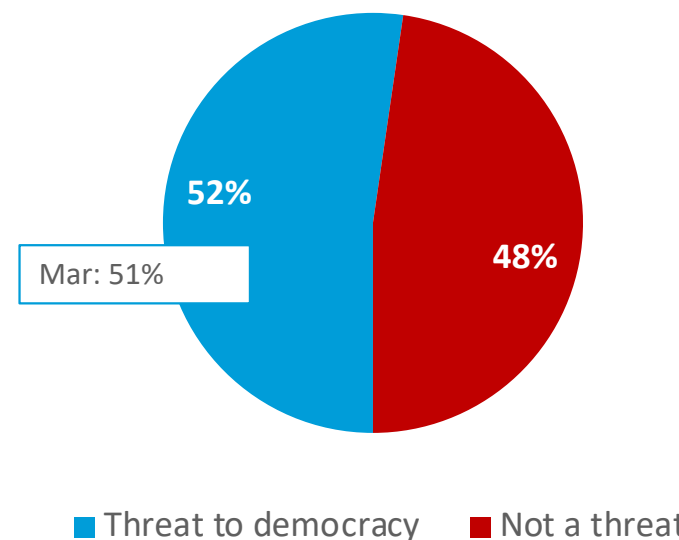

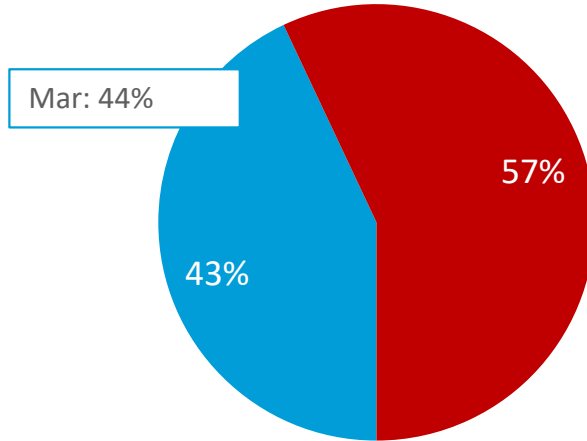

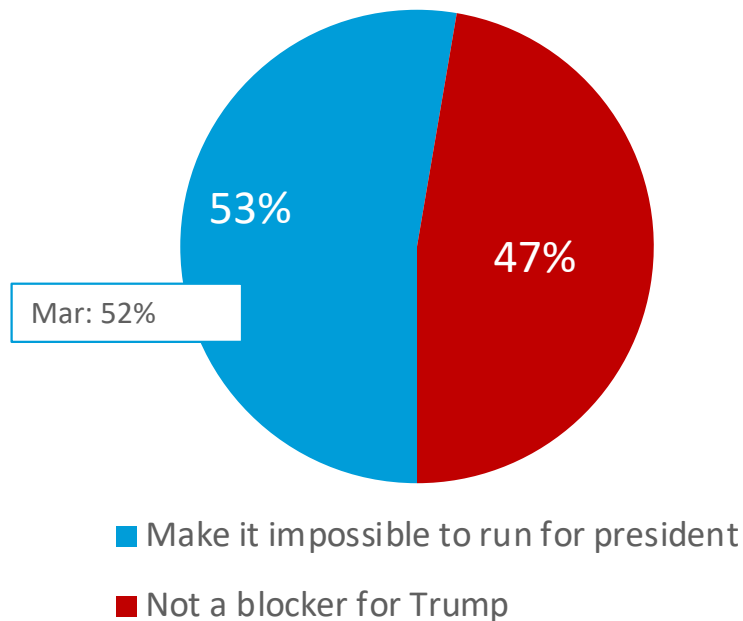

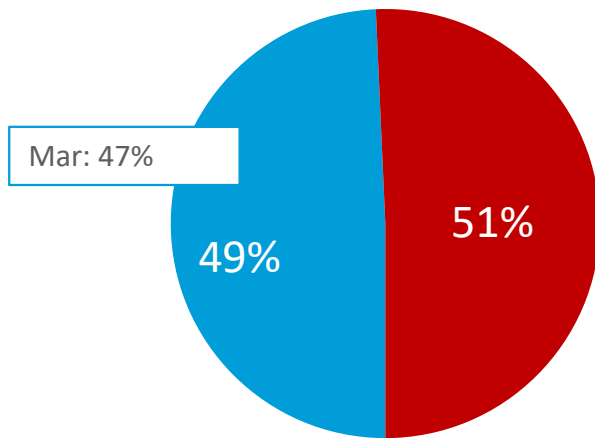
Do you think Donald Trump's legal cases make it impossible for him to be a viable candidate for president or is that not a blocker for Trump?

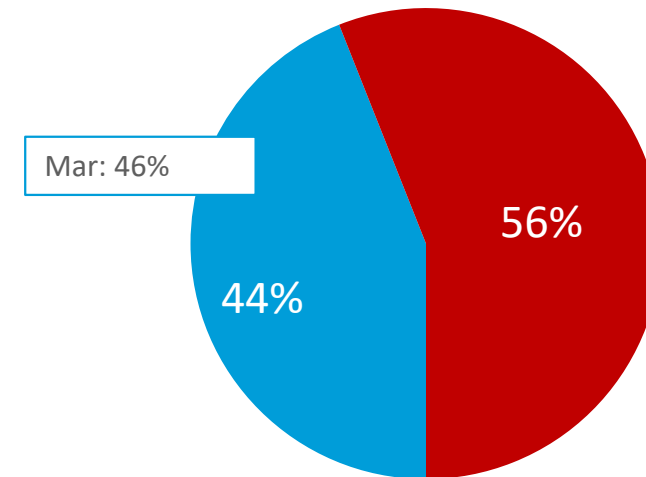
Do you think Donald Trump has committed crimes for which he will be convicted, or do you think he will not be convicted of any crimes?

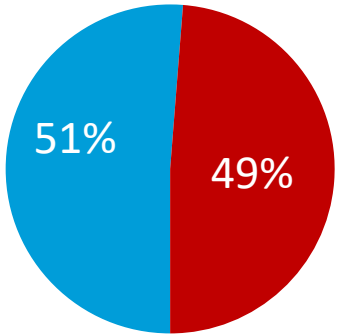

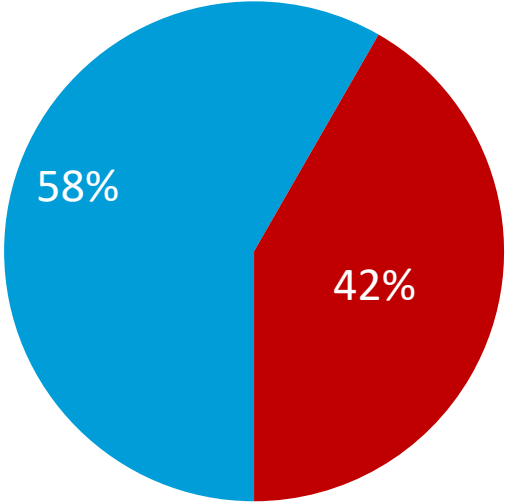

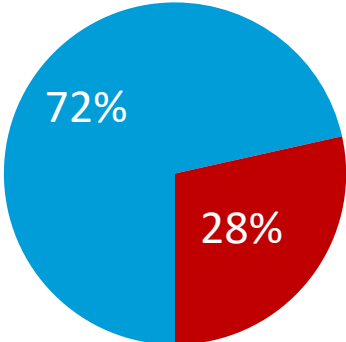

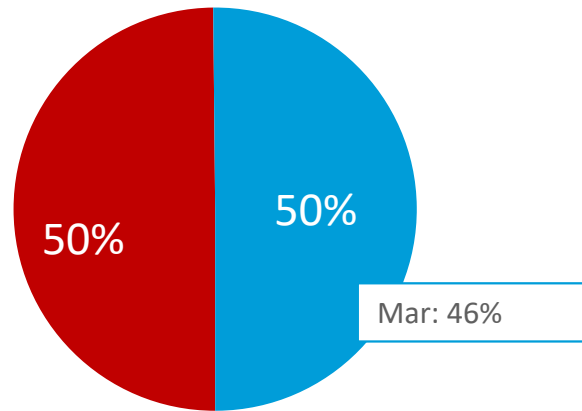

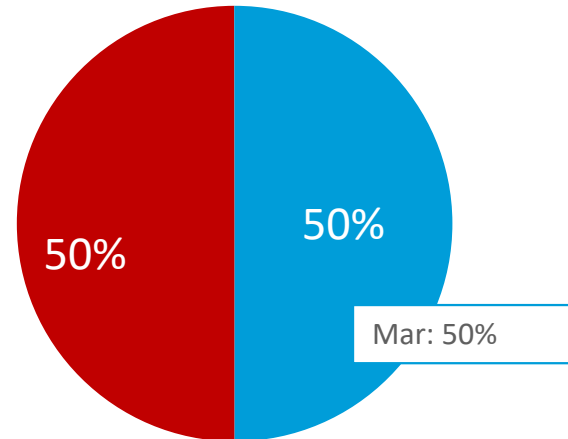

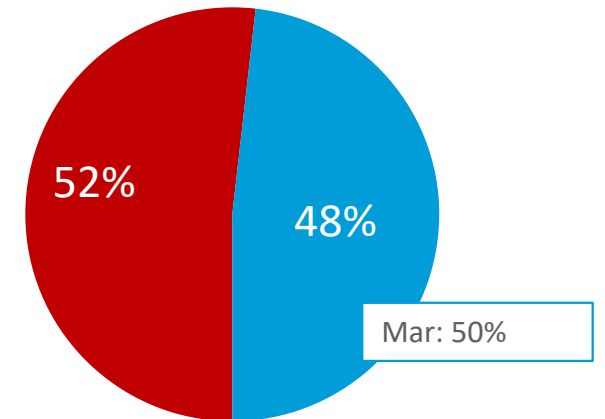

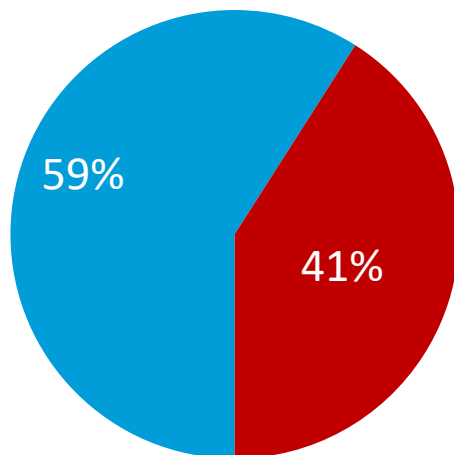

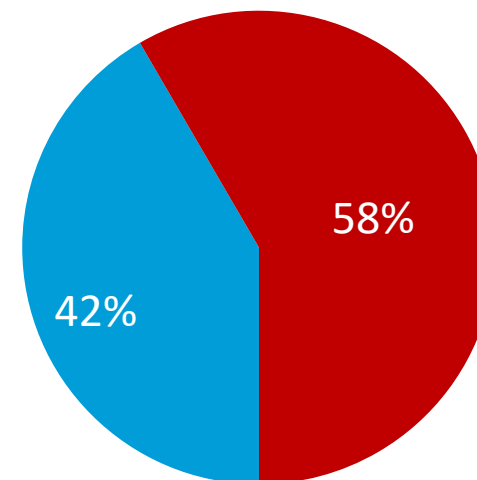

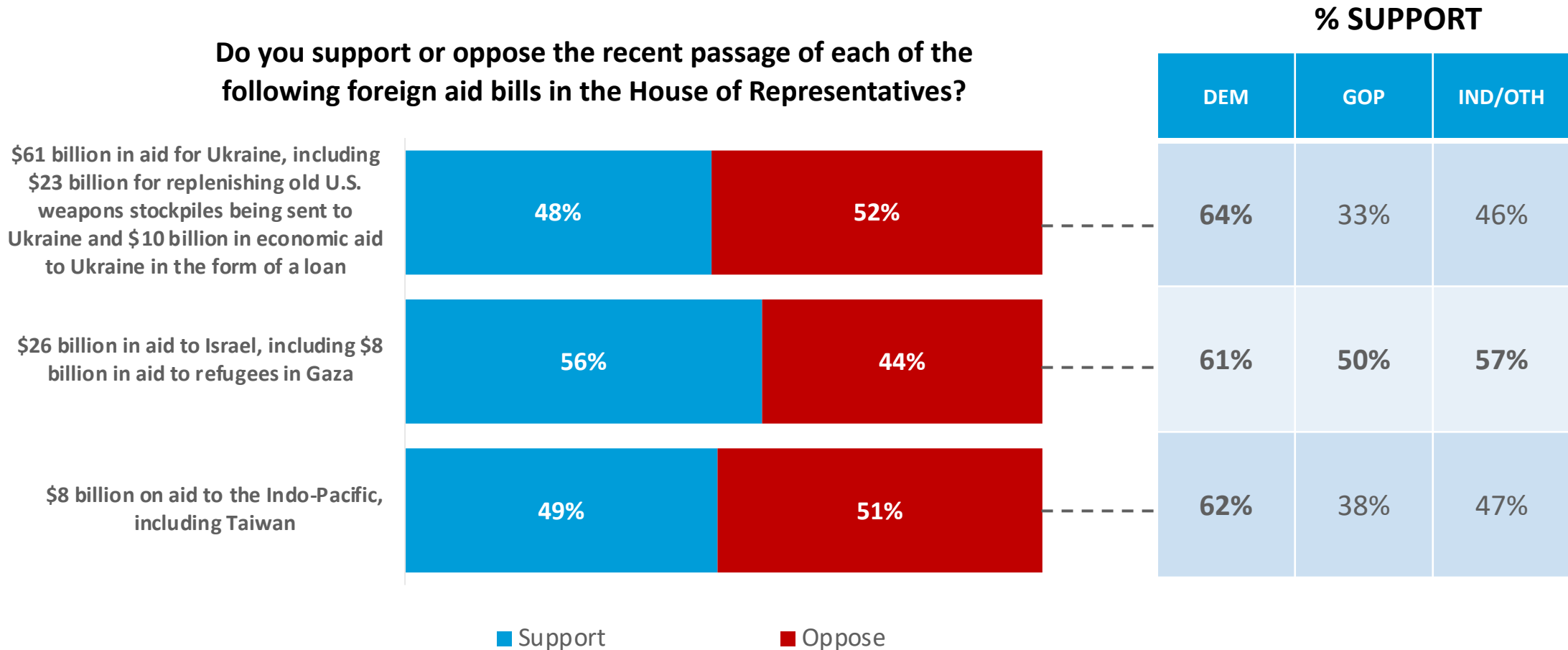

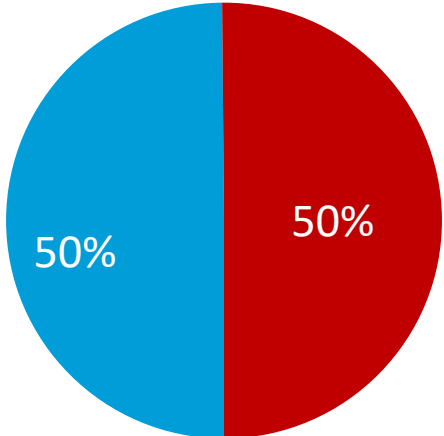

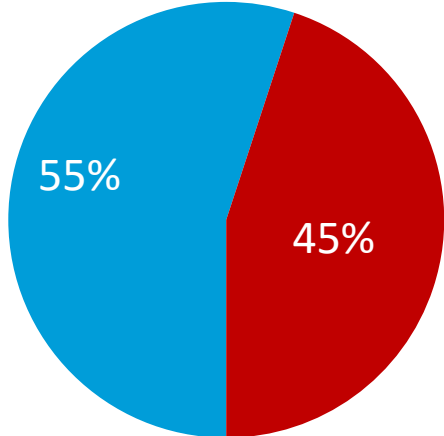

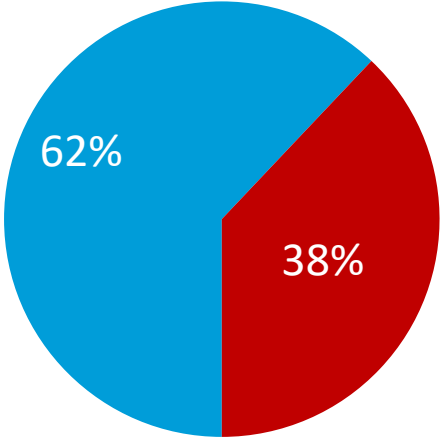

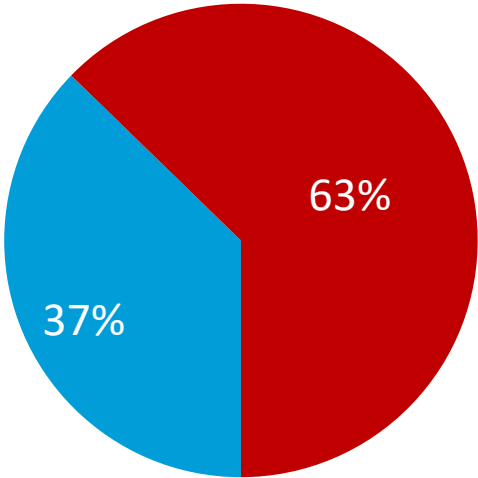

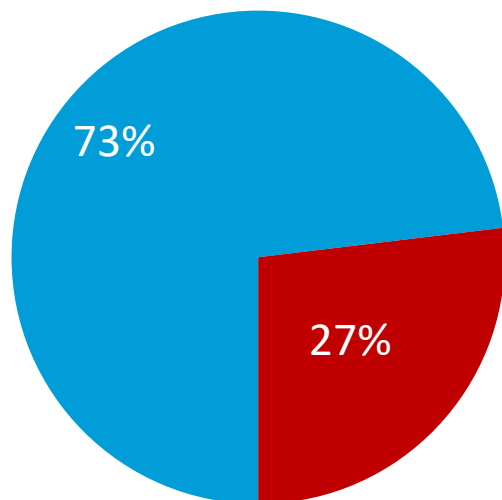

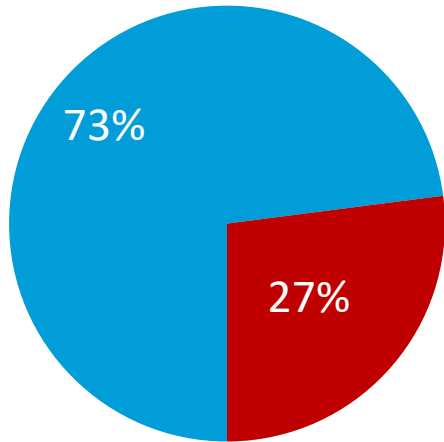

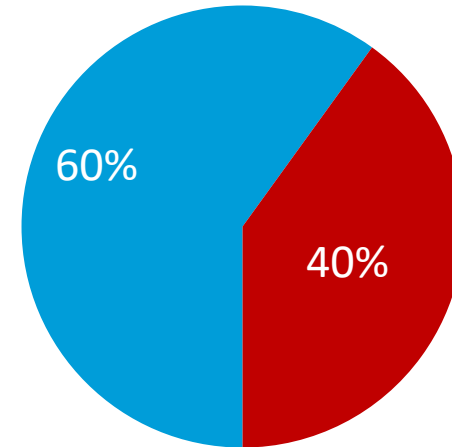

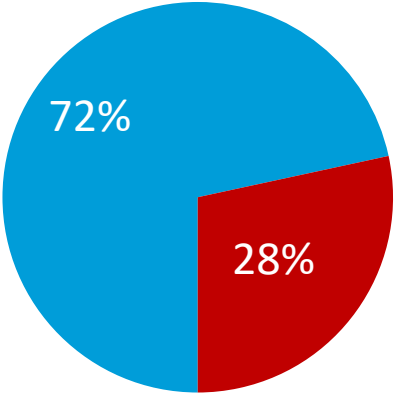

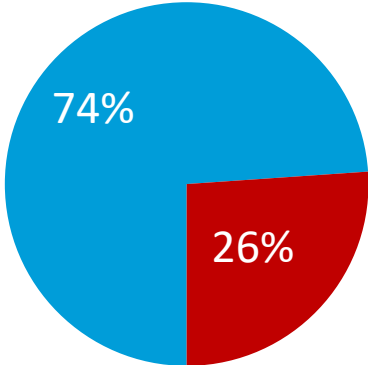

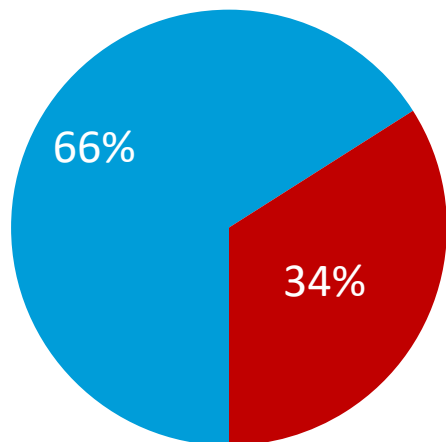

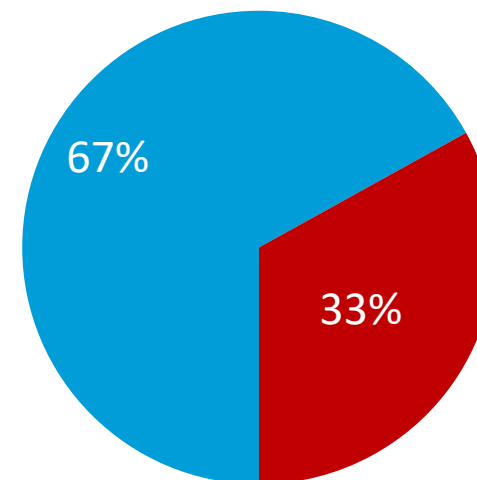

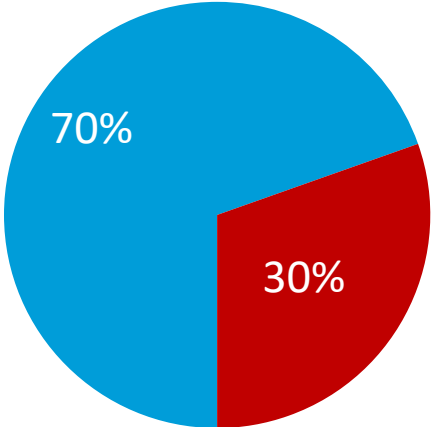

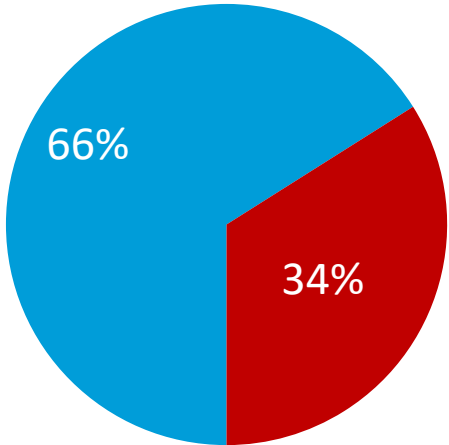

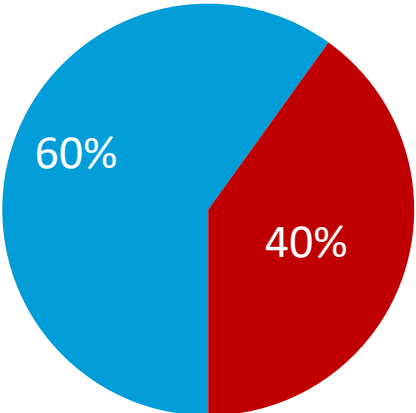

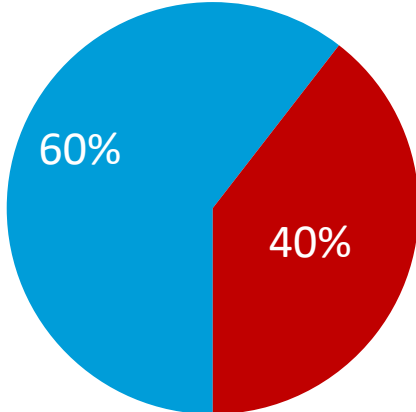

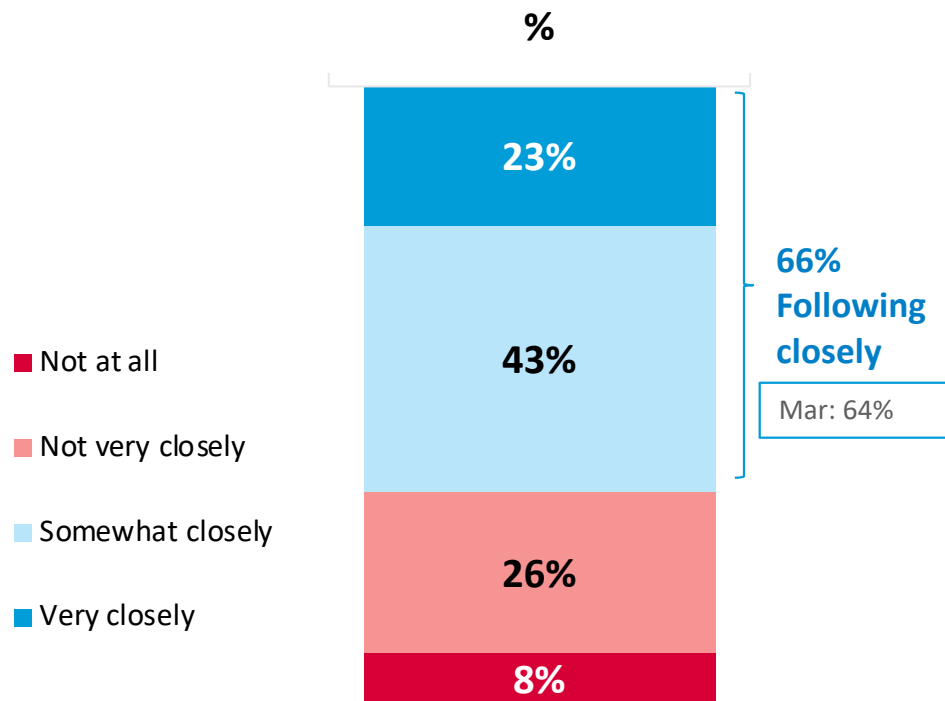

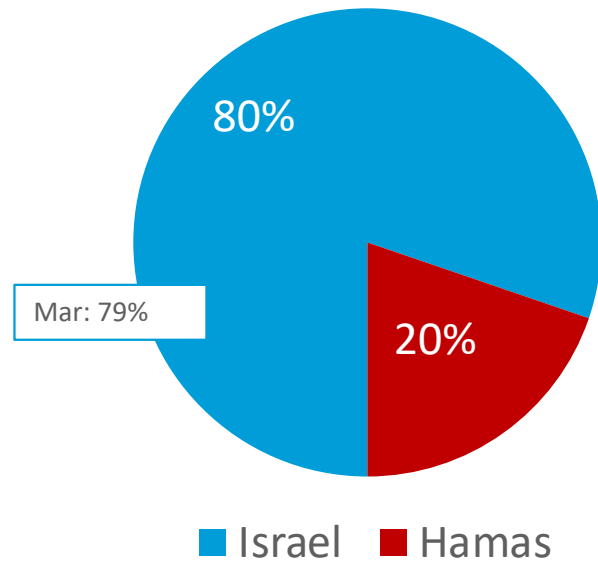

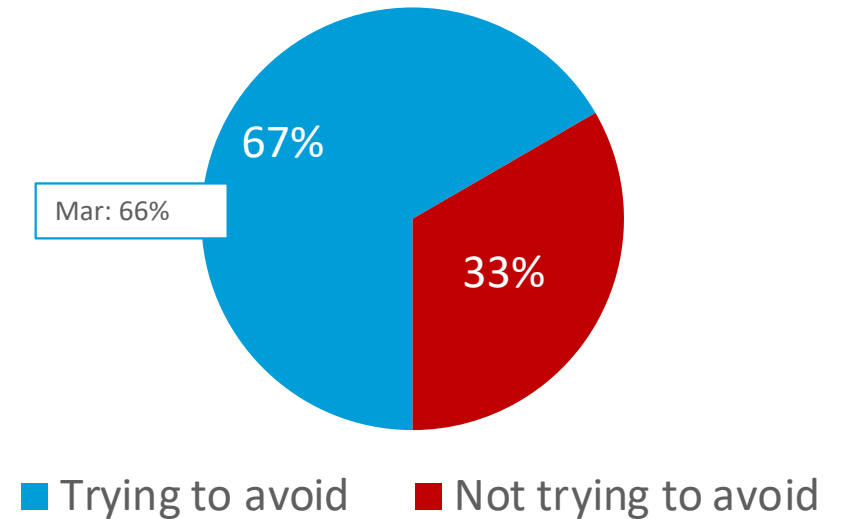

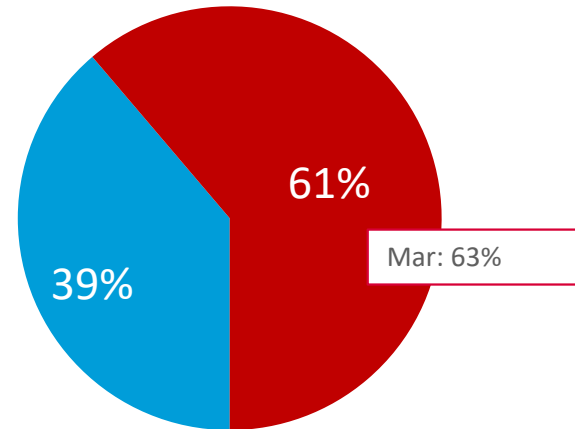

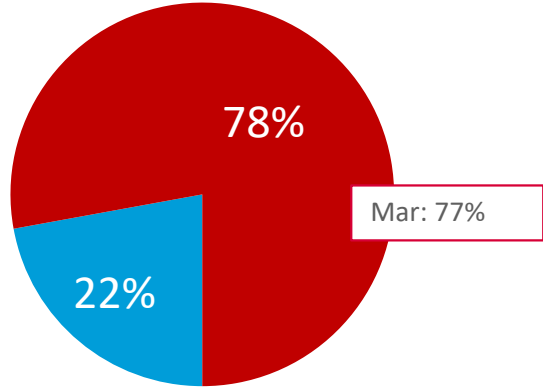

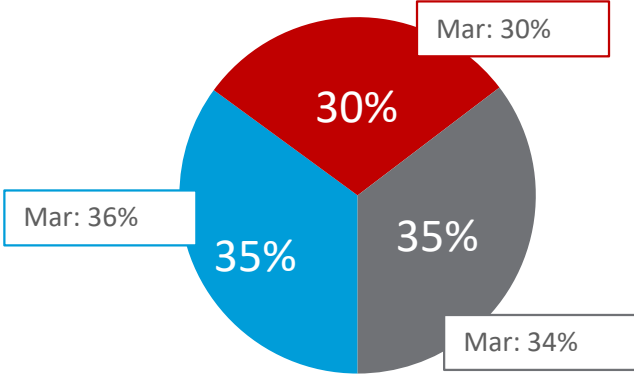

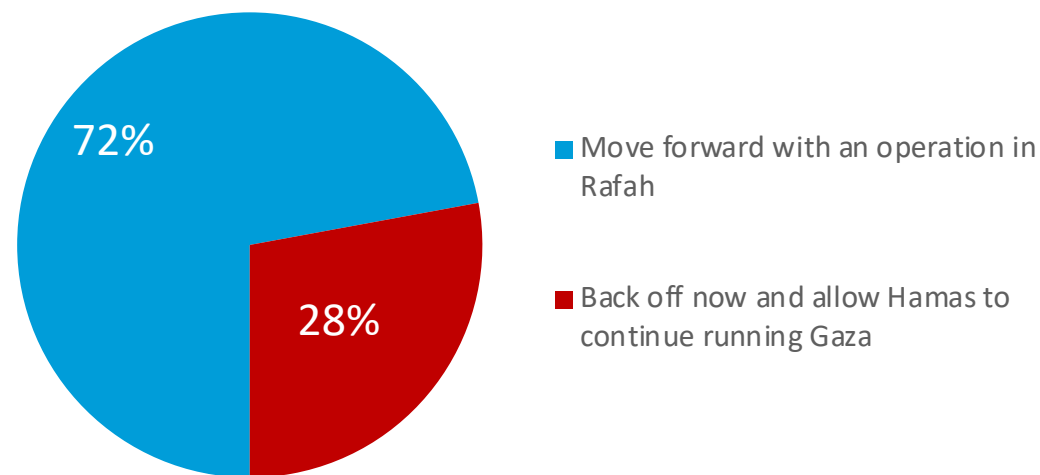

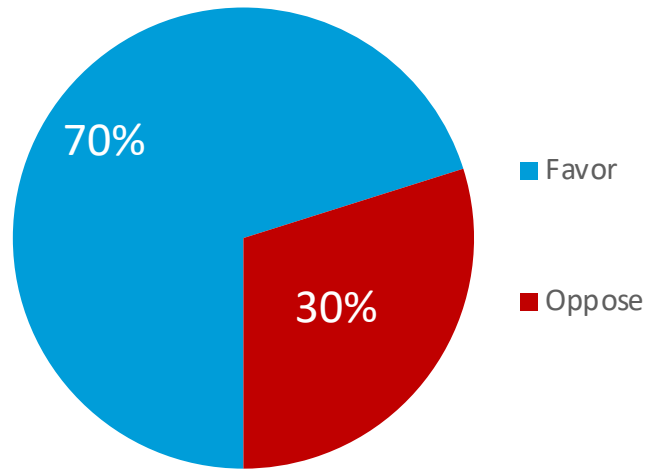

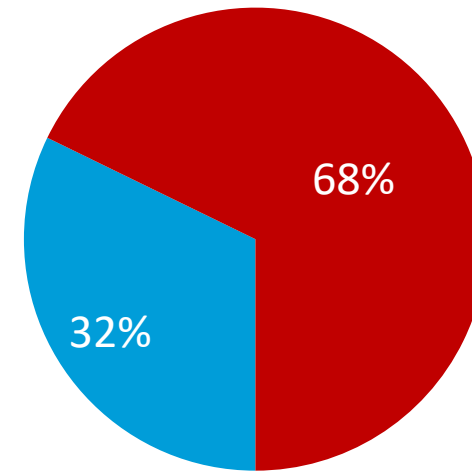

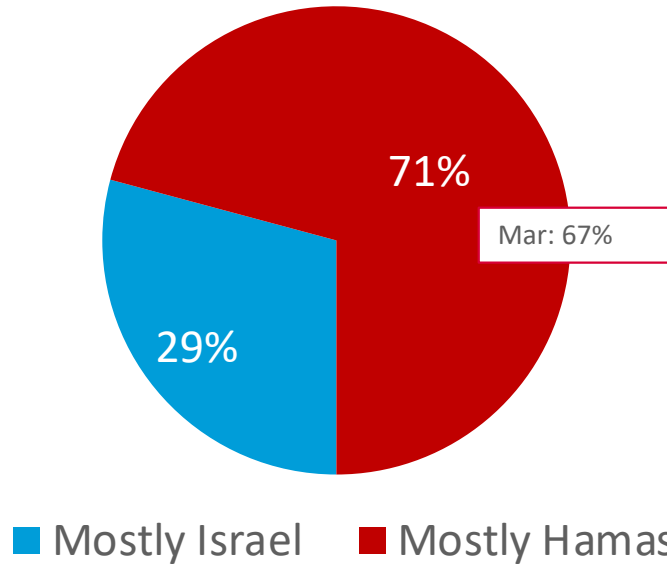

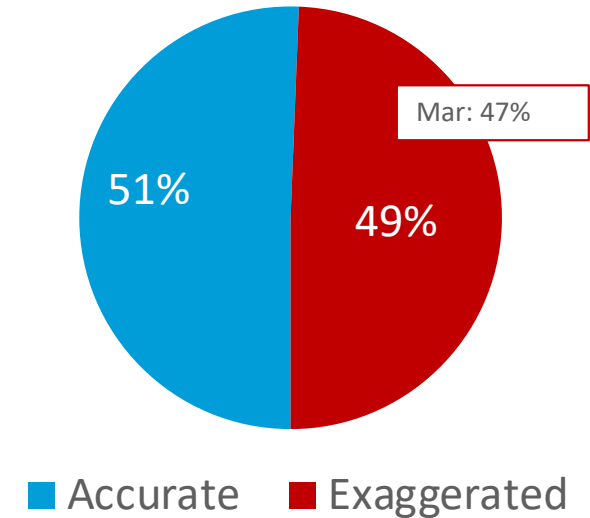

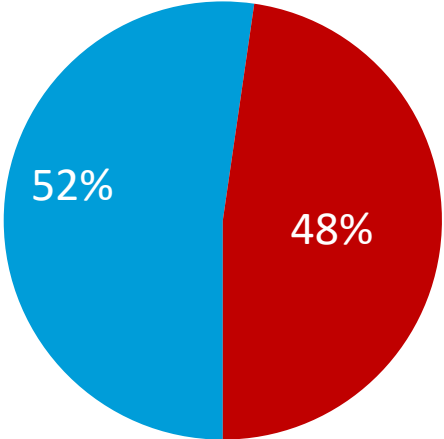

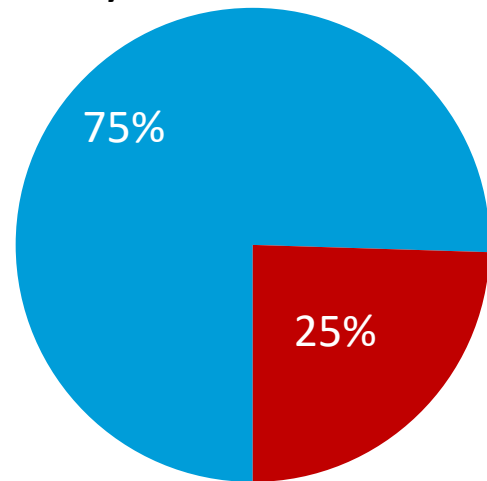

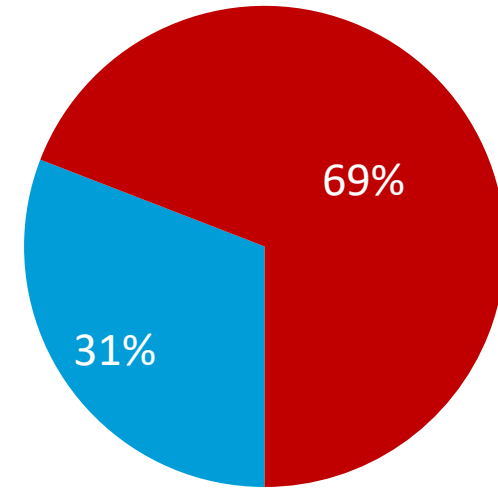

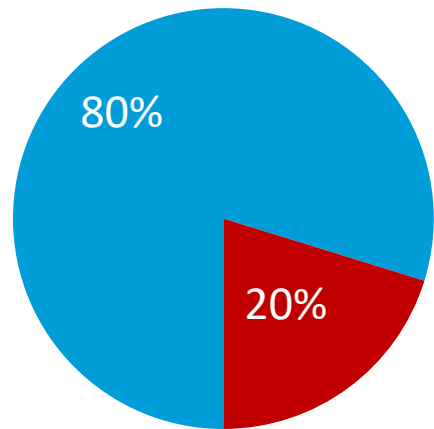

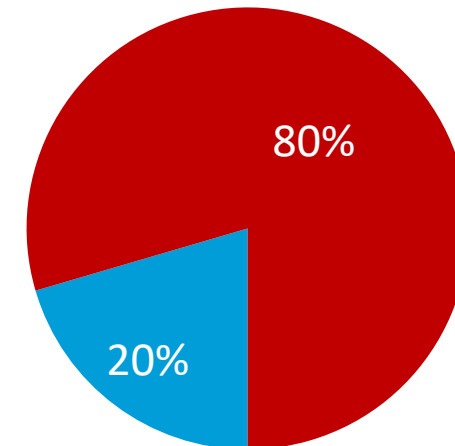

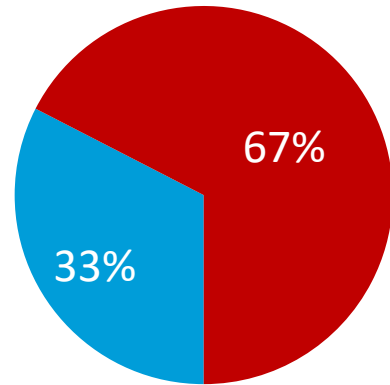

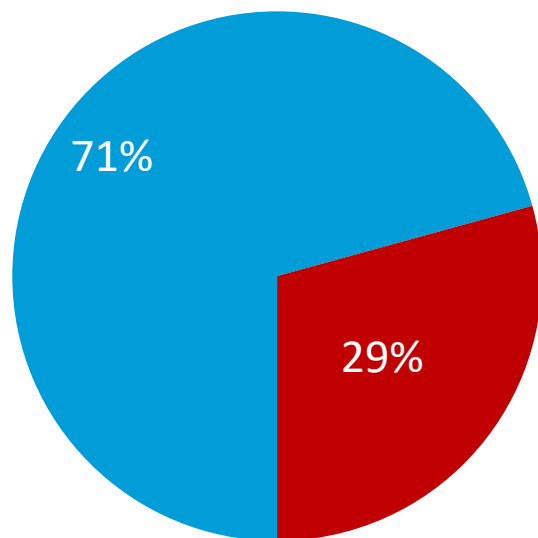

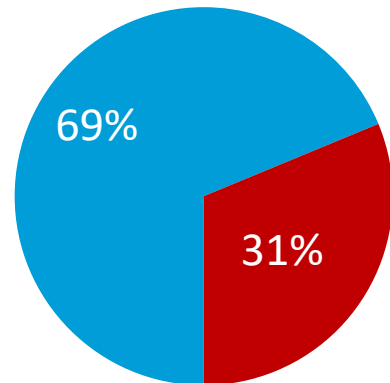

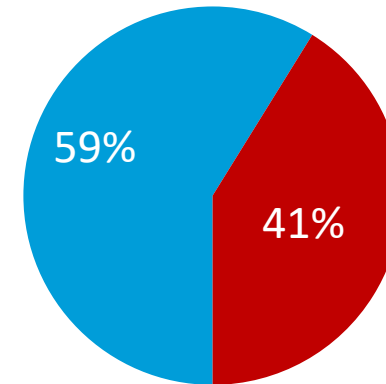

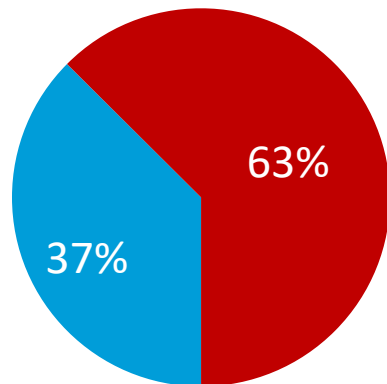

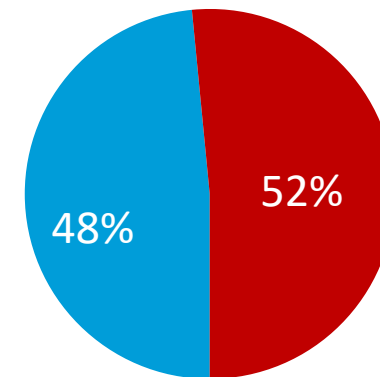

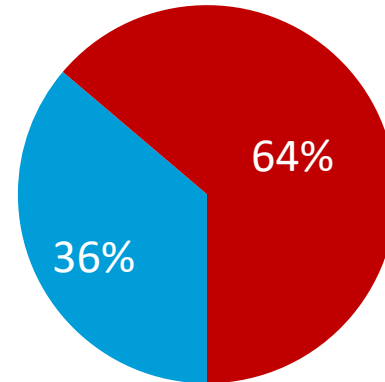

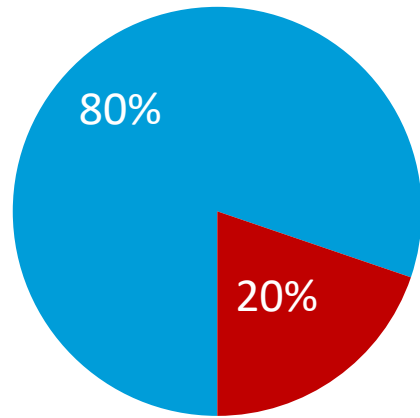

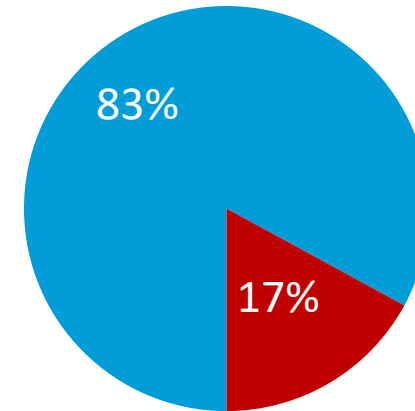

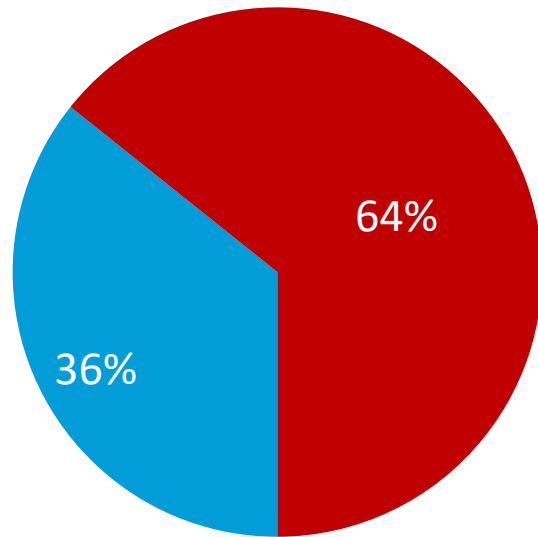

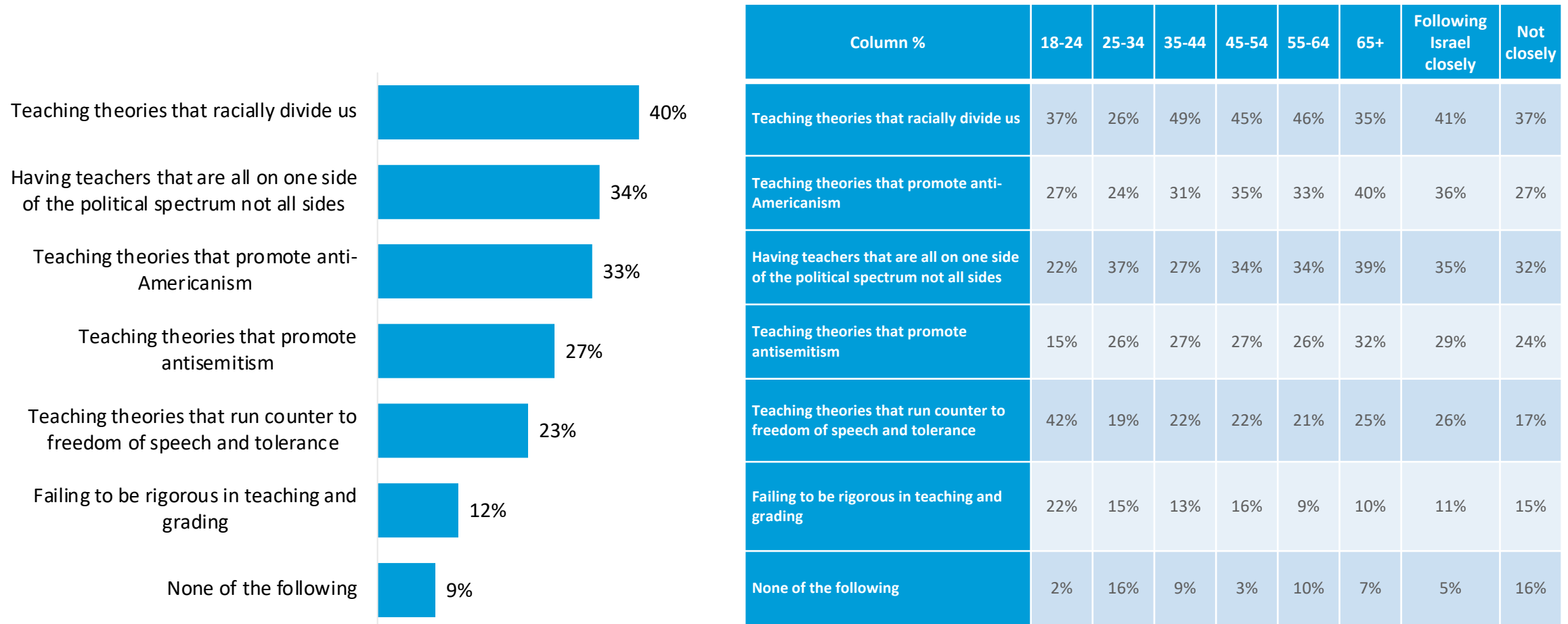

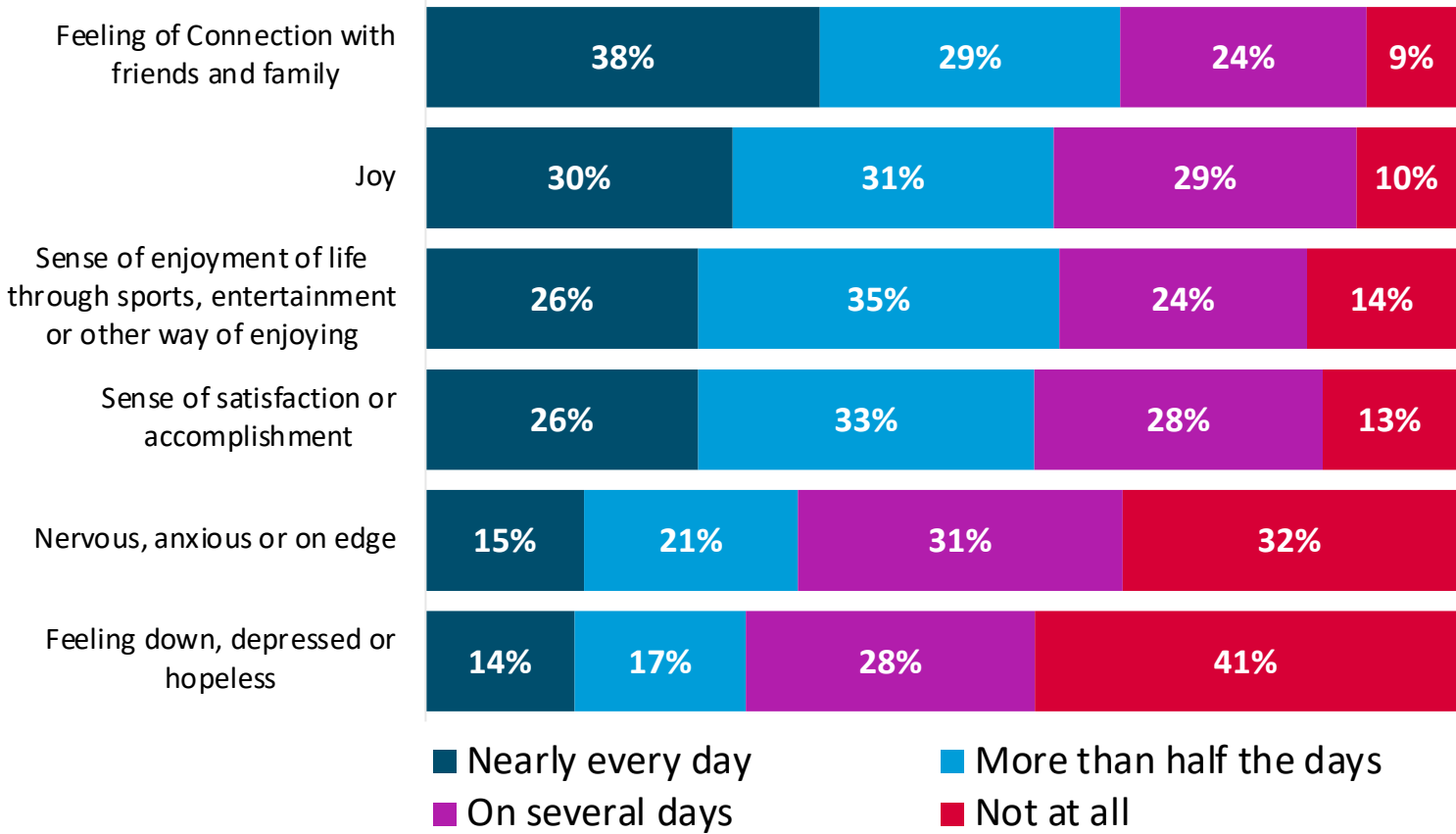

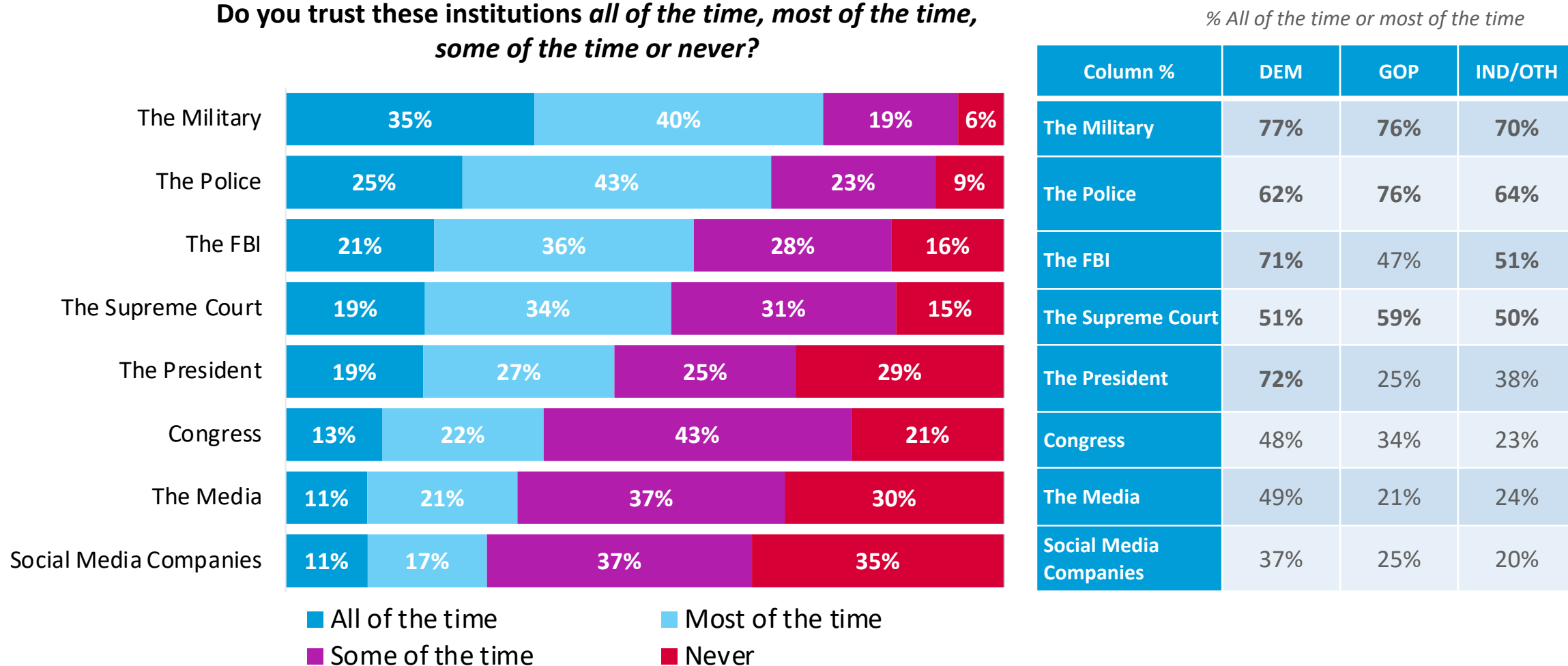

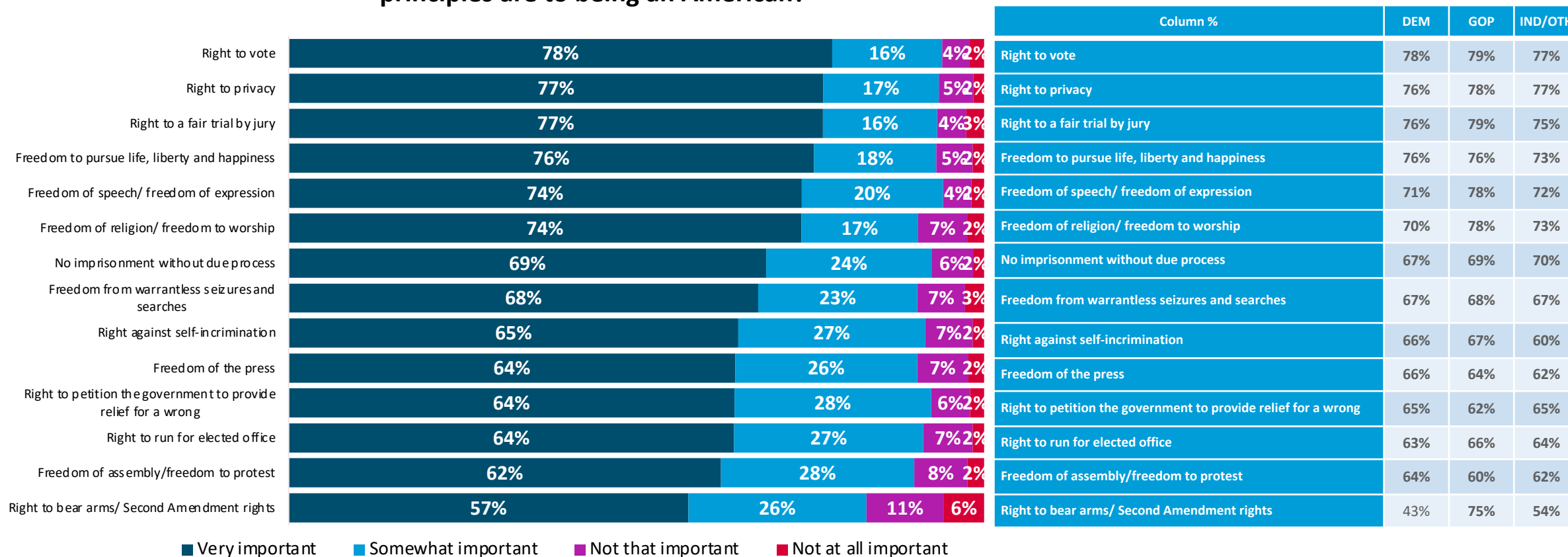

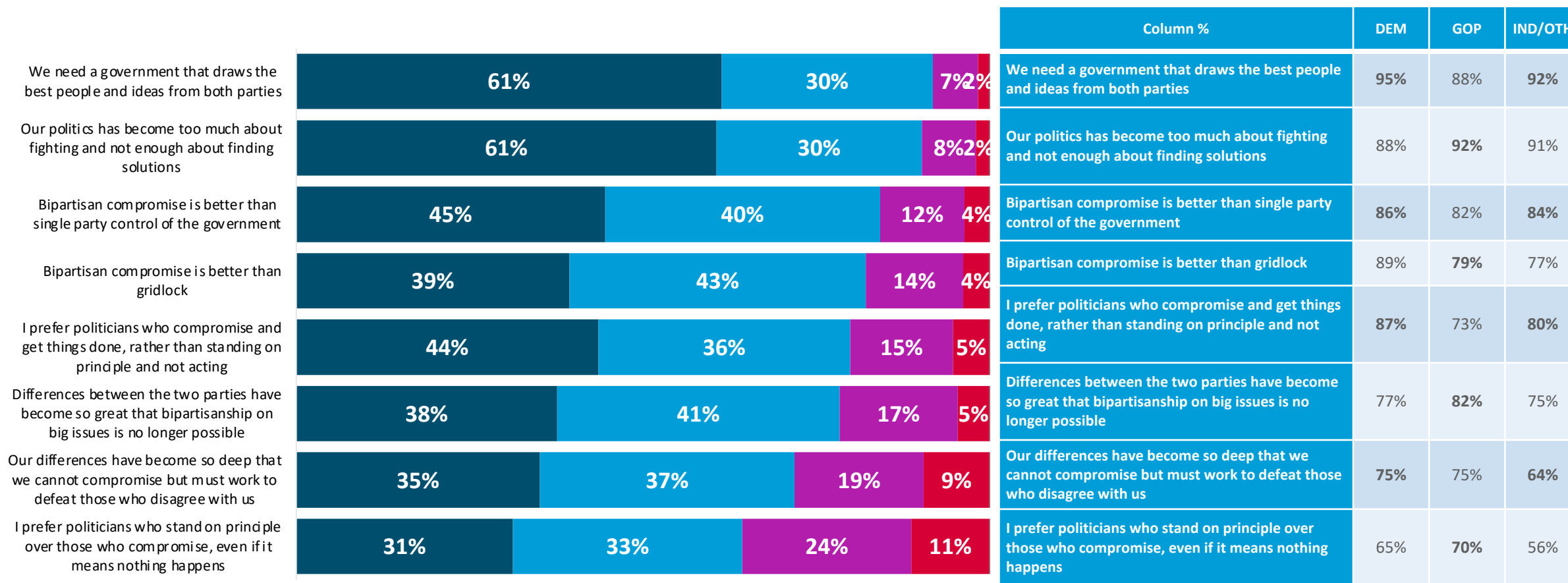
How important or unimportant do you think each of the following principles are to being an American?

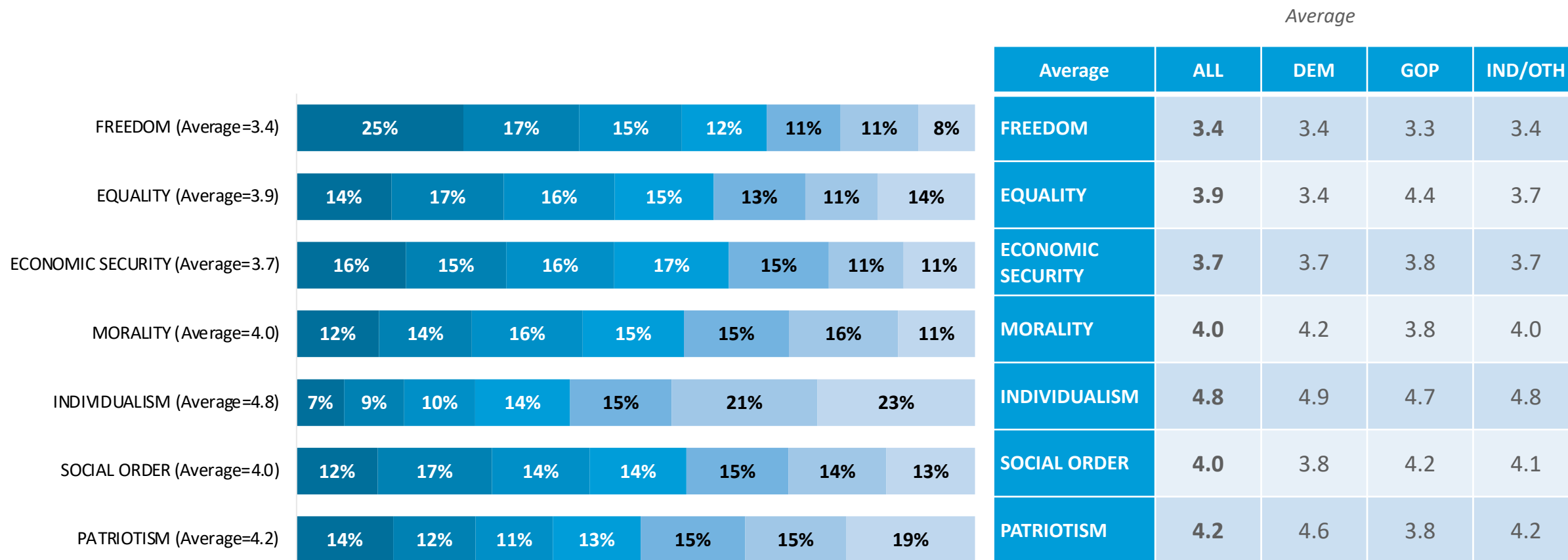
