BE ON TIME. BUST YOUR BUTT. PLAY SMART, AND HAVE SOME LAUGHS WHILE YOU'RE AT IT: The I-70 interleague series resumes today as the St. Louis Cardinals and cross-state rival Kansas City Royals play a split doubleheader today at Busch Stadium ... After tomorrow's scheduled off day, the Cardinals welcome the division-rival Chicago Cubs to St. Louis for a

four-game weekend series that features another split twinbill on Saturday ... St. Louis went 5-2 over their recent seven-game road trip through Pittsburgh (2-1) and the Nation's Capital (3-1) before yesterday's rainout.

WINNING ISN'T EVERYTHING, BUT WANTING TO WIN IS: The Cardinals are a season-best six games above .500, and enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 4.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 2nd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns MLB's 2nd-best record (33-18, .647) behind Cleveland (33-17, .660) ... After 90 games, the Redbirds 48-42 record is a 10-game improvement from last season (38-52) and matches their 90-game start in 2022 when they finished 93-69 and won the NL Central. WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE: The Cardinals (-33) are the only Major League team with a winning record but a negative run differential.

I-70 SERIES: The Cardinals and Royals face off with both teams sporting winning records for the first time since Aug. 10, 2017 (STL 58-56 & KCR 57-56) ... Today's doubleheader opener marks the 7th regular season game ever between the teams when both were 6+ games above .500, with all six previous meetings occurring during the 2015 season.

CROWNING ACHIEVEMENT: Since Interleague play began in 1997, the Cardinals .604 win pct. (73-49) against the Royals is the best across MLB among Interleague natural rivals and their 2nd-highest against any opponent behind Arizona (.612) ... St. Louis has won 24 of its last 32 games over the Royals dating back to August 7, 2017.

SIX IS A SERIOUS NUMBER: St. Louis has scored six or more runs in 50 of 124 all-time games against the Royals (44-6 record), including in 18 of their last 25 wins over Kansas City (June 28, 2016-present) ... The Cardinals have scored 6 or more runs in their last six games overall since July 5.

THESE GO TO 11: The Cardinals have recorded 11 or more hits in five straight games (60 total hits) since July 4, their longest stretch of doing so since April 23-27, 2016 at San Diego and Arizona (66 total hits) ... The last time St. Louis played six or more consecutive games with 11+ hits was April 10-16, 2011 (7 games).

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT!: Brendan Donovan has reached base safely in a career-best 21 consecutive games since June 16 (.349/.407/.518, 29-83), longest active on-base safely streak in MLB ... Since Donny's on-base streak began on June 16, he ranks among MLB leaders in batting average (3rd), on-base pct. (T-10th), and times on base (37, T-7th).

SO FRESH, SO CLEAN: With a win in today's game, St. Louis would become the 4th MLB team since the introduction of the City Connect program in 2021 with wins in each of their first five contests wearing their specialty unis, joining the Giants (began 6-0 in 2021), Guardians (began 6-0 in 2024), and Rays (began 5-0 in 2024) ... The Redbirds four-game City Connect win streak is the 2nd-longest active in MLB behind the Mariners nine-game heater in their "Pacific Northwest" jerseys since last season.

INTERLEAGUE ENFORCER: Nolan Arenado ranks among the all-time Interleague leaders in RBI (186, 5th), doubles (67, 5th), and extra-base hits (123, 6th) ... Arenado has hit safely in 19 of 21 career games against Kansas City since 2014, batting .354/.422/.785 (28-79) with nine homers and a 1.207 OPS, his best offensive marks against any American League opponent.

The Cardinals and Royals faced off in the 1985 World Series, also known as the "Show-Me Se-

ries" or "I-70 Showdown Series."

Brandon Crawford and his San Francisco Giants faced the Royals in the 2014 World Series.

Michael Wacha, the Cardinals 1st round draft selection in 2012, pitched seven seasons (2013-19) in St. Louis and was voted MVP of the 2013 NLCS against the LA Dodgers. He and Chris Stratton became the 105th and 106th players to appear in at least one game for both the Royals and Cardinals.

Chris Stratton pitched parts of two seasons (2022-23) for the Cardinals. He was traded to Texas last year on July 30 in a five-player trade that brough LHP John King, RHP Tekoah Roby and IF Thomas Saggese to the Cardinals.

Danny Ontiveros, the Royals Vice President of Scouting, was a Cardinals scout from 1998-2004.

Hall of Fame manager Whitey Herzog managed the Royals for three seasons (1976-78)...piloted KC to three-straight A.L. West Division titles.

Cardinals broadcaster Brad Thompson games) appeared on the 2010 Royals squad.

Bobby Witt Jr.'s father, Bobby Witt, pitched in 17 games (five starts) for the Cardinals in the second half of the 1998 season.

Bally Sports Kansas City reporter Joel Goldberg covered the Cardinals for FOX Sports Midwest for three seasons (2005-07)...worked parts of six years for KTVI FOX 2 in St. Louis.

Royals broadcaster Rex Hudler played three seasons in St. Louis (1990-92).

Royals Senior Advisor to the GM/Scouting & Player and Development **Mike Arbuckle** was selected by the Cardinals in the 1969 MLB Draft. Johnny DiPuglia, Royals Special Assistant, International Scouting, worked in scouting for the Cardinals from 1990-98.

Cardinals broadcaster Al Hrabosky pitched in 116 games over two seasons (1978-79) with Kansas City...traded to Kansas City for Mark Littell and Buck Martinez (Dec. 8, 1977).

Cardinals Hall of Famer Vince Coleman played parts of two seasons with Kansas City (1994-95).

Royals MLB.com reporter Anne Rogers covered the Cardinals for two seasons (2019-20).

Royals broadcaster Steve Stewart is a St. Louis native...called Cardinals games on KMOX in 2002.

Royals Special Asst. to the GM **Tim Conroy** worked as an area scout and an East Coast regional supervisor with St. Louis (1994-2000)...pitched for St. Louis for two seasons (1986-87).

TODAY'S GAME

- Making his 8th start of the season and 18th career. It's his first career start vs. the Royals and second appearance.
- Has made three career starts in Interleague games going 0-2 with a 7.82 ERA over 12.2 innings with one start this season (at HOU 6/4).
- Since returning to the Cardinals starting rotation on May 29, leads all National League pitchers with 8 GIDP and 2.06 GIDP/9 IP. Leads the Cardinals and ranks T-4th in the National League with four wins. Would rank 10th in the N.L. with a 3.34 ERA, but is 7.0 innings shy of qualifying.
- Threw a season-high 7.0 innings in his last start at PIT (7/4). His longest outing since a career-high 8.0 IP at WSH (7/31/22). Received a no decision as the Cardinals won 3-2 in 10 innings.
- Had been involved in the decision in his first six starts this season alternating wins and losses over the first five games before winning back-to-back decisions (W-L-W-L-W-W).
- Started and earned the win vs. SF (6/20) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala. Joined **Alan Benes** (4/19/1997 vs. SD) as the only two Cardinals starting pitchers to earn a win at a neutral site game.
- Made seven starts this season and has held his opposition to one run or less in 5-of-7.
- Had his 17.0 IP scoreless innings streak as a starter snapped in an 8-5 defeat at HOU (6/4), pitched 3.0 innings allowing six runs.
- The scoreless inning streak had dated back to the 1st inning (3 runs allowed) of his 7/26/22 start at Toronto. Blanked Washington for 8.0 IP in 7/31/22 start at Nationals Park, followed by 6.0 scoreless IP in start at CIN (5/29/24).
- Is 7-5, 3.73 ERA in 17 career starts (89.1 IP/37 ER) and 4-1, 2.52 ERA (39.1 IP/11 ER) in seven career home starts at Busch Stadium. Has won his last four straight home starts dating back to July 15, 2022 vs. Cincinnati.
- Was recalled on May 26 from Memphis (AAA), and made first start in Major League Baseball since July 31, 2022 at Washington at Great American Ball Park vs. CIN (5/29).
- Appeared in four games (three starts) in Memphis (AAA) after being optioned from St. Louis on April 21, going 1-0 with a 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP), 13 walks, nine strikeouts, and a 1.65 WHIP.
- Was 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA in nine MLB relief appearances before his option on April 21.
- Only pitched with human umpires calling balls/strikes in Memphis. Did not pitch to the ABS system while in Triple-A this season.
- Since his 7/31/22 start at WSH, was 6-3 with a 4.50 ERA over 90 relief appearances with 19 Holds and 63 strikeouts over 104.0 innings pitched.
- Top pitch total in Memphis was 84 pitches vs. Gwinnett in his 5/17 start. Highest pitch total in his MLB career is 100 vs. PHI on July 10, 2022.

 Allowed one run over a season-high 7.0 innings on Independence Day at PNC Park as the Cardinals hung on to a 3-2 win in 10 innings over the Pirates.

- Pitched over 50.0 IP as both a starting pitcher and relief pitcher during the 2022 season, making him one of two pitchers in MLB to do so in that season along with Nick Martinez (SD). Was the first Cardinals rookie pitcher since John Urrea in 1977 to accomplish the feat and the first rookie in MLB since Hisanori Takahashi for the New York Mets in 2010.
- Ranked 3rd among National League rookies with 108.0 innings in 2022.
- Led all MLB rookies with 17 ground into double plays in 2022.
- Finished the 2021 Arizona Fall League season with 15.0 consecutive scoreless innings.
 Named an Arizona Fall League All-Star with a 1.29 ERA, 2nd in the league.
