32 HR as a shortstop this season, breaking his own record of 31 HR in 2022.....Adames (109 RBI) needs just 4 RBI to tie Robin Yount (113 in 1982) for the most RBI as a shortstop in a season in franchise bietory. season in franchise history.

Brewers clinched a postseason berth and the NL Central on Sept. 18.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 44-32 at home, going 14-8-2 in series play,...,the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 44-34 on the road, going 14-9-2 in series play....are 19-9 in their last 28 road games.....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing Bud Black in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 41 replay challenges this season, going 24-17.....their last challenge (won) came on 9/15 at Arizona as an out call at first base involving Jackson Chourio stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #32 - RHP AARON CIVALE (29gs, 7-8, 4.48)

CIVALE AT A GLANCE: Aaron Civale, 29, makes his 30th start of the season and 13th with the Brewers.....Civale last started on Monday vs. Philadelphia and earned a 6-2 win [5ip, 7h, 1r, 1er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr, 90 pitches].....his teams are 12-17 in his starts [7-5 with Brewers].....he has 7 quality starts.....opponents are batting .258 [152-for-589, 27hr]..... he is 5-0 with a 2.56 ERA in his last 7 starts [38.2ip, 31h, 11r, 11er, 11bb, 34k, 5hr].....Civale was acquired from Tampa Bay on July 3 in exchange for INF Gregory Barrios....he went 2-6 with a 5.07 ERA in 17 starts with the Rays [87ip, 93h, 51r, 49er, 27bb, 84k].....he has gone 5-2 with a 3.68 ERA in 12 starts with the Brewers [63.2ip, 59h, 28r, 26er, 21bb, 58k, 11hr]....he is signed through the 2025 season.....name is pronounced "sih-VAH-lee."

CAREER: Has gone 38-34 with a 4.05 ERA in 115 starts (626ip, 282er).....is in his sixth Major League season pitching for Cleveland (2019-23), Tampa Bay (2023-24) and Milwaukee (2024).....Civale was selected by Cleveland in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft out of Northeastern University.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 4-1 with a 1.98 ERA in 7 starts, all coming this season for the Brewers (41ip, 9er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 17-16 with a 4.12 ERA in 59 starts (314.1ip, 144er).....is 2-3 with a 6.34 ERA in 13 starts this season (61ip, 43er).

CAREER vs. DIAMONDBACKS: Civale has never pitched against Arizona, one of four teams he has not faced (also Atlanta, Houston and Tampa Bay).

RHP Frankie Montas makes his 29th start of the season and 10th with the Brewers.....Montas last started on Tuesday vs. Philadelphia in a 5-1 loss (5.2ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, 2bb, 10k, 2hr, 100 pitches).....his teams are 12-16 in his starts (6-3 with Brewers).....he has 9 quality starts.....opponents are batting .240 (132-for-549, 20hr).....he was acquired from Cincinnati on July 30 for RHP Jakob Junis, 0F Joey Wiemer and cash.....Montas has gone 3-3 with a 3.55 ERA in 9 starts with the Brewers (50.2ip, 39h, 23r, 20er, 20bb, 60k, 6hr).....he is 1-2 with a 7.24 ERA in 3 career starts against Arizona (13.2ip, 13h, 12r, 11er, 7bb, 15k, 2hr), including a 6-2 loss this season as a member of the Reds on 5/7 in Cincinnati (6ip, 4h, 2r, 1er, 1bb, 7k).
