RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals play the last of a four-game series against the Cincinnati Reds this afternoon. This concludes a 10-game "home" stand that began on June 20 at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., against the San Francisco Giants. The Cardinals swept the Giants and took 2-of-3 against the Atlanta Braves in a series that included a split doubleheader on Wednesday. The Cardinals are 6-3 on their longest homestand of the 2024 season.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 6.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 3rd position in the National League Wild Card race. Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis is tied for the second most wins in MLB (27) and owns the best winning percentage in the National League at .628 (27-16).

BOSIOKOVIC SELECTED; GRACEFFO OPTIONED: Prior to today's game, the Cardinals selected RHP **Jacob Bosiokovic** off the Memphis (AAA) roster and optioned RHP **Gordon Graceffo** to Memphis. LHP **Kolton Ingram** was designated for assignment. The 30-year-old Bosiokovic was converted from an infielder to pitcher prior to the 2019 season and was originally selected by the Colorado Rockies in the 2016 draft out of The Ohio State University. He was 3-0 with a 3.00 ERA in 25 games with Memphis this season.

BO KNOWS?: When **Jacob Bosiokovic** makes his MLB debut, he will become the first North American-born Cardinals pitcher aged 30 or older to make his MLB debut since **Kevin Ohme** at Milwaukee on April 14, 2003 at 32-years-1-day.

NOOT NEWS: Cardinals outfielder **Lars Nootbaar** (oblique strain) continued his injury rehabilitation assignment with Springfield (AA) last night and was 1-for-3 with a solo home run while playing seven innings in right field. Nootbaar last played in a Major League game on May 29 at Cincinnati and has appeared in 39 this season, missing 42 due to injury.

NO JUNE SWOON: A win today would not only give the Cardinals a split of the series with the Reds, but a 16-win June, marking their most wins in the month since the 2015 Cardinals posted an 18-8 record en route to a 100-win season and the N.L. Central title.

HOW DO YOU SPELL R-E-L-I-E-F: Yesterday afternoon, rookie RHP **Gordon Graceffo** became the seventh Cardinals to make his Major League debut this season and fifth pitcher. He threw 4.1 innings, the longest relief outing by a Cardinals pitcher in his MLB debut since **John Martin** in 1980, who threw 7.0 innings vs. Philadelphia on Aug. 27, 1980.

STOP THIEF! The Cardinals have allowed 11 stolen bases in the first three games of this series against the Cincinnati Reds. This is the most allowed in a four-game series by an opponent since 1990 when the Montreal Expos totaled 12 (**Delino DeShields** 5, **Tim Lincecum** 3, **Mike Aldrete**, **Dave Martinez**, **Spike Owen**, **Tim Wallach**). The Expos set the four-game series record against the Cardinals two years earlier with 13 (July 28-31, 1988) as **Otis Nixon** stole seven by himself in the four-game series.

SUN-DAZE: Today marks the 37th day game the Cardinals have played in 2024, posting a 15-21 mark. The .417 winning percentage ranks T-24th with their opponent, the Cincinnati Reds, also at 15-21 under the sun. The Detroit Tigers lead all of MLB with 44 day contests this season while the nocturnal Los Angeles Dodgers have played the fewest at 23. Cleveland holds the highest winning percentage in day tilts at .724 (21-8).

MAKING THEM COUNT: **Alec Burleson** recorded his team-leading 8th game-winning RBI Friday night. It's the most by a Cardinals player pre All-Star Break since **Yadier Molina** had 10 in 2021. The last pure Cardinals left-handed hitter with eight or more GW-RBI pre All-Star Break was **Matt Adams** with nine in 2014.

SAVE CRAVE: **Ryan Helsley** has converted 29 straight save opportunities since April 1, the longest active streak in Major League Baseball and the longest in Cardinals history. The 29 straight saves is the Majors longest streak since **Josh Hader** nailed down 32 straight from July 18, 2021 to June 5, 2022. With his next save before the All-Star Break, Helsley will tie **Lee Smith** (1993) for the franchise record for most saves by a Cardinals pre All-Star Break with 30. Smith locked down 15 saves in June 1993, while Helsley has 11 this month, the 2nd-highest mark for June in Cardinals history.

Michael Siani was selected by the Reds in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...played in 12 games for Cincinnati over two seasons (2022-23).

Sonny Gray pitched three seasons with Cincinnati (2019-21)...named a 2019 NL All-Star.

Reds pitching coach **Derek Johnson** played baseball and coached at Eastern Illinois University (1991-94)...coached at Southern Illinois University (1995-97)...was **Sonny Gray's** pitching coach at Vanderbilt University.

Willie McGee (May 10, 1982 at Busch II) and **Steven Matz** (June 28, 2015 at Citi Field) made MLB debuts vs. the Reds.

Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** played his final four seasons with the Reds (2009-12)...won the 2010 Gold Glove and was a two-time All-Star (2010-11).

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **William DeWitt Jr.** was a prior owner of the Reds and shareholder of the Cincinnati Bengals...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, was a sole owner of the Reds from 1961-67.

Julio Rangel served as Bullpen Coach for the Reds in 2019.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** played in 33 games for Cincinnati in 1996.

Reds Hitting Coach **Joel McKeithan**, is a brother of minor league catcher **Aaron McKeithan** in the Cardinals organization ... Grandfather, **Jerry Sr.**, spent seven years in the Cardinals organization ... Brother, **Tim**, is a Pirates Assistant Coach.

Reds Assistant Hitting Coach **Terry Bradshaw** was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1990 MLB Draft...played parts of two seasons for the Cardinals (1995-96).

Drew Rom was born in Cincinnati...graduated from Highlands High School in Fort Thomas, Kentucky...resides in Fort Thomas.

Reds broadcaster **Jeff Brantley** pitched in 48 games for St. Louis in 1998.

MLB Ranks: Unearned Runs Allowed (13, 1st)

- Makes his 17th start of the season and the 334th of his career (358th appearance). Will be making his 10th career start vs. CIN at Busch Stadium and holds an outstanding 8-1 record vs. the Reds at Busch Stadium.
- Ranks among active leaders vs. the Reds in wins (12, 2nd), games started (20, 2nd) and strikeouts (119, 2nd).
- Has not suffered a losing decision since his last start vs. CIN, coming at Great American Ball Park on Memorial Day (5/27) in a day game after Sunday Night Baseball.
- Threw 6.2 innings vs. ATL (6/24) in his last start, 2nd-longest start of the season (4/16 at OAK, 7.0 IP) and did not walk a batter for the second straight start, first time since July 29-Aug. 3, 2022.
- The Cardinals are 9-7 in his starts, with wins in four of his last six outings since 5/21.
- Struck out five batters vs. PIT (6/13) passing 2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** (1997-2005) for 6th all-time in franchise history with 987.
- Is 16 strikeouts shy of 2,000 for his career and 25.1 innings from 2,000. Would become the 6th active pitcher with 2,000 strikeouts (**Justin Verlander**, **Max Scherzer**, **Clayton Kershaw**, **Chris Sale**, **Gerrit Cole**). Needs 11 strikeouts for 500 at Busch Stadium III.
- Has thrown 4-Seam Fastballs for 618 of his 1,424 total pitches (43.3%) this season.
- In the *Baseball Savant* database (2008-present), Lynn has thrown the 2nd-most fastballs (27,760) of any MLB pitcher behind **Jon Lester** (32,520).
- St. Louis has played extra innings in five of his 16 starts this year
- Ranks 1st among NL starters with 10 no-decisions in his 16 starts.
- Ranks 1st in MLB with 15 batters faced with the bases loaded, and leads MLB pitchers with 10 strikeouts.
- Has pitched 6.0 innings or more in just four of his 16 starts (all quality).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout in National League play on May 10 at Milwaukee after fanning Brice Turang (swinging) to lead off the 1st inning.

LAST TIME OUT

- Earned a win for the first time since May 21 (vs. BAL) with 6.2 innings allowing one run on four hits with no walks and five strikeouts.
- Was his 2nd-longest start of the season and his first time not issuing a walk in consecutive starts since 2022.

- Two-time All-Star with the National League (2012, DNP) and the American League (2021). Pitched a scoreless inning at Coors Field in 2021 in relief of pitcher **Shohei Ohtani**. Current teammates **Kyle Gibson** and **Andrew Kittredge** also pitched for the A.L. in that game.
- Placed in Top 10 in the AL Cy Young Award voting in 2019 (5th), 2020 (6th) & 2021 (3rd).
