The Brewers have produced the 11th season in franchise history with 90+ wins: **1978** (93), **1979** (95), **1982** (95), **1987** (91), **1992** (92), **2008** (90), **2011** (96), **2018** (96), **2021** (95), **2023** (92) and **2024** (90).

The Hunt for October

The Brewers head to the postseason for the 10th time in franchise history and sixth time over the last seven seasons....the team has won the NL Central in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four and two in a row (2018, 2021, 2023-24).

Missed It By That Much!

The Brewers were just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons, missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game.

Brewing Consistency

The Brewers, Dodgers and Astros are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does *not* include the 2020 season.

Freddy K-rueger

Freddy Peralta needs 7 strikeouts tonight for his second career 200+ strikeout season (210 last season).... Peralta would become just the fourth pitcher in franchise history to have multiple 200+ strikeout seasons, joining **Teddy Higuera** (2x), **Corbin Burnes** (3x) and **Yovani Gallardo** (4x).

Dynamic Duo

Willy Adames and **Jackson Chourio** are the first teammates in franchise history to produce 20 HR/20 SB in the same season.

Willy Do It?

Willy Adames has a franchise-record 32 HR as a shortstop this season, breaking his own record of 31 HR in 2022....Adames (111 RBI) needs just 2 RBI to tie **Robin Yount** (113 in 1982) for the most RBI as a shortstop in a season in franchise history.

Action Jackson

In his last 92 games, **Jackson Chourio** has hit .306 (106-for-346) with 16 HR and 62 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .364 OBP/.538 SLG/.902 OPS.

TONIGHT'S GAME: Is the second game (1-0) of a 3-game trip to Pittsburgh....following this trip, the team concludes the regular season with 3 home games vs. New York-NL.

IN THE STANDINGS (181 days): The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 167, **SECOND:** 13, **THIRD:** 1, **FOURTH:** 0, **FIFTH:** 0....the team is in first place, leading the Cubs by 9.5 games, Cardinals by 10.0 games, Reds by 14.5 games and Pirates by 17.0 games....the Brewers clinched a postseason berth and the NL Central on Sept. 18.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 45-33 at home, going 14-9-2 in series play....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 45-34 on the road, going 14-9-2 in series play....are 20-9 in their last 29 road games....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing **Craig Counsell**....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009)....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach **Quintin Berry** (4th season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (3rd season), assistant pitching coach **Jim Henderson** (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (6th season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator **Walker McKinven** (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.... **Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach), **Matt Erickson** (infield coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 41 replay challenges this season, going 24-17....their last challenge (won) came on 9/15 at Arizona as an out call at first base involving Jackson Chourio stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (31gs, 11-8, 3.69)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 28, will be making his career-high 32nd start of the season and second against the Pirates....Peralta last started last Wednesday vs. Philadelphia and had no decision in a 2-1 win (5ip, 2h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 9k, 1hr, 1wp, 91 pitches)....the team is 19-12 in his starts....he has 11 quality starts....opponents are batting .227 (141-for-621, 26hr)....he needs 7 strikeouts for his second career 200+ strikeout season (210 last season)....Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

CAREER: Is 53-35 with a 3.80 ERA and 1 save in 177 games/128 starts (749ip, 316er)....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24)....has gone 45-33 with a 3.79 ERA as a starter (665ip, 280er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er)....was an All-Star in 2021.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 31-19 with a 3.52 ERA in 95 games/67 starts (407ip, 159er)....is 6-5 with a 4.01 ERA in 17 starts this season (94.1ip, 42er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 22-16 with a 4.13 ERA in 82 games/61 starts (342ip, 157er)....is 5-3 with a 3.28 ERA in 14 starts this season (74ip, 27er).

CAREER vs. PIRATES: Is 2-1 with a 3.56 ERA in 21 games/12 starts (78.1ip, 57h, 35r, 31er, 29bb, 91k, 7hr), including a no-decision in his only outing this season on 4/25 at PNC Park (4.2ip, 5h, 5r, 5er, 5bb, 5k, 1hr)....Brewers won, 7-5.
