RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Washington Nationals wrap up a four-game wraparound weekend series today at Nationals Park as the Redbirds conclude a seven-game road trip through Pittsburgh (2-1) and the Nation's Capital (2-1) ... St. Louis is hitting .295 (69-234) on the road trip, and has recorded double-digit hit totals while scoring six or more runs in every game of the series.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 5.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 2nd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns MLB's 2nd-best record (32-18, .640) behind Cleveland (32-16, .667) ... The Cardinals (-39) are the only Major League team this season with winning record but negative run differential.

NOOT NEWS: Prior to today's series finale, the Cardinals activated OF **Lars Nootbaar** from the 10-Day Injured List and optioned INF **José Fermín** to Memphis (AAA) ... Nootbaar, who has missed a total of 49 games this season due to a pair of IL stints (36g-oblique strain and 13g-left rib contusion), batted .261/.414/.565 (6-23) in a recent seven-game rehab assignment at Springfield (AA).

HELSEY RETURNS TO ALL-STAR GAME: Cardinals closer **Ryan Helsley** was selected by Major League Baseball to represent the Cardinals at the 2024 Major League All-Star Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Tex... With his 2nd career All-Star nod (2022 and 2024), Helsley:

- joins Hall of Famers **Lee Smith** (1991-93) and **Bruce Sutter** (1981, 1984) as Cardinals closers to make multiple All-Star games
- is the first since **Carlos Martinez** (2015, 2017) who was developed by the Cardinals and became a two-time All-Star with St. Louis
- is the 9th Cardinal and 2nd pitcher (**Matt Morris**, 2001-02) since 1965 who was drafted and developed by the Cardinals and made multiple All-Star games.

HAPPY FLIGHT: The Redbirds have won 12 of their last 13 series finales since May 22 (vs. Orioles, vs. Cubs, at Cincinnati, at Philadelphia, at Houston, vs. Rockies, vs. Pirates, at Cubs, vs. Giants, vs. Braves, vs. Reds, & at Pittsburgh), and are 14-14 overall in the final game of series this season.

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT!: **Brendan Donovan** has reached base safely in 20 consecutive games since June 16 (.329/.391/.494, 26-79), MLB's 2nd-longest active on-base safely streak behind the injured **Bryce Harper** (21).

THE NOLANS & NATITUDE: In the current three-game series in Washington, **Nolan Arenado** and **Nolan Gorman** are batting a combined .600 (15-for-25) with four doubles, four runs scored, two walks, and seven RBI.

NATIONAL NEWS: Since relocating from Montreal to the Nation's Capital and re-branding as the Nationals in 2005, the Cardinals .588 win pct. (70-49) against Natitude is the 2nd-highest in MLB among annual opponents behind the Dodgers (74-41, .643) ... St. Louis has won 12 of its last 18 regular season games in D.C. to sport the 4th-best win pct at Nationals Park among annual visitors (29-25, .537).

LOOKS LIKE I PICKED THE WRONG WEEK TO QUIT...: Sixty-three of the Cardinals 89 games (70.9%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer, 2nd in MLB to the Brewers (64) ... St. Louis is 38-25 in those games to lead MLB in wins & ranks 2nd in win pct. (.603) to Cleveland (37-21, .638) ... The Cardinals have won eight of their last 11 one-run games since June 13.

SOUTHPAWS: Today ends a stretch of St. Louis facing left-handed starting pitchers in five consecutive games since July 3 (**Martín Pérez**, **Patrick Corbin**, **MacKenzie Gore**, **DJ Herz**, and **Mitchell Parker**), longest since six straight from July 5-11, 2008 vs. Cubs (**Ted Lilly** & **Sean Marshall**), at Philadelphia (**Cole Hamels**, **J.A. Happ**, & **Jamie Moyer**), and at Pittsburgh (**Zach Duke**). ... St. Louis is 15-11 in games against southpaw starters this season - *Elias*

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (July 8, 1962): With the help of **Stan Musial's** three home runs in consecutive at-bats, the Cardinals defeat the Mets at the Polo Grounds, 15-1 ... At the age of 41, "The Man" is still the oldest Major Leaguer ever to hit three homers in a single game.

Alec Burleson made his MLB debut vs. the Nationals (Sept. 8, 2022 at Busch).

Ildemaro Vargas was signed by St. Louis as an international free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2008-14).

Juan Ypez played parts of two seasons in St. Louis (2022-23)...traded to the Cardinals organization from Atlanta in exchange for **Matt Adams** and cash (May 20, 2017).

Jordan Weems's father, **Rick Weems**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 15th round of 1980...was a minor league catcher in the Cards organization (1980-82).

Nationals Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 1995.

Lane Thomas played in 84 games over parts of three seasons for St. Louis (2019-21)...traded to Washington for **Jon Lester** (July 30, 2021).

Dave Martinez made his MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 15, 1986) while with the Chicago Cubs.

Nationals bench coach **Miguel Cairo** played parts of four seasons in St. Louis (2001-03, '07).

Jacob Barnes pitched in 13 games for St. Louis in 2023. Bally Sports Midwest broadcaster **Alexa Datt** was born in Durwood, Md...graduated from the University of Maryland...previously worked at NBC Sports Mid-Atlantic.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** made his MLB debut vs. Montreal (Apr. 18, 1985 at Busch II).

Paul Goldschmidt was born in Wilmington, Del. Nationals broadcaster **Bob Carpenter** worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals in radio and TV before joining Washington...graduated from McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister, **Judy Carpenter-Barada**, previously was Cards Director of Major League Admin.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** played college baseball at the Univ. of Virginia (1978-80).

Nationals Social Media Marketing Dir. **Matt Turer** previously worked for the Springfield Cardinals (AA).

Nationals broadcaster **Charlie Slowes** worked three years at KMOX in St. Louis (1984-86).

Nationals Communications Manager **Daniel Kurish** was born in St. Louis.

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 19th start of the season and his 169th career (197th appearance).
- Will be facing the Nationals for the 1st time this season and the 9th time career (8th career start vs. Washington). It's his 6th career appearance at Nationals Park.
- Is 3-2 with a 4.427 ERA over his last nine starts (5/18-present) with a 0.99 WHIP; was 3-4 with a 5.77 ERA with a 1.42 WHIP in his first nine starts (3/28-5/12).
- Since May 18, ranks T-5th among National League pitchers with a 0.99 WHIP.
- Five of six five wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, has a winning record on the road (32-28) and losing mark at Busch Stadium (24-26).
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in only one of his 18 starts (101 on May 1 at Detroit).
- In his 158 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 64-33 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings (6-5 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-38 when he works 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 47-5 (.902 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 62-14 in those 76 games). He's just 9-50 (.153) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 25-57).
- His loss vs. Milwaukee (April 20, 2024) was his first ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Made his 77th career start at Busch Stadium III on June 27, passing **Michael Wacha** and tying **Jaime Garcia** for 4th in stadium history. **Kyle Lohse** is 3rd with 78.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 5th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018.

LAST TIME OUT

Held the Pirates to 2 runs over his 6.0 IP, but left with a no-decision as game went to extra innings. Became the 1st Cardinals pitcher to surpass the 100 IP mark in 2024.

- Is 24-26 in his 78 games (77 starts) at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal (St. Louis is 43-35).
- Ranks among Busch Stadium III rankings in starts (77, T-4th), innings pitched (468.1, 7th), ERA (3.56, 6th), quality starts (43, 6th), and wins (24, 8th).
- Made his 77th career start at Busch Stadium III on June 27, passing **Michael Wacha** and tying **Jaime Garcia** for 4th in stadium history. **Kyle Lohse** is 3rd with 78.

CAREER

- St. Louis is 87-72 (.547) in his 159 career outings (158 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only **Clayton Kershaw** (67.6%) with the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.5%.
- Is in his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (933.2), wins (56), strikeouts (683) and games started (158) for St. Louis; trailing only **Lance Lynn** in all categories.
