**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals and Washington Nationals play the second of a four-game weekend series today at Nationals Park as the Redbirds continue their seven-game road trip through Pittsburgh (2-1) and the Nation's Capital (1-0) ... The Cardinals erased an early fiverun deficit to rally and come from behind in last night's 7-6 win in 11 innings, the club's 3rd consecutive extra-inning affair.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 5.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 3rd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns MLB's 3rd-best record (31-17, .646) and a season-best 5.0 games above .500 for the first time since the final day of the 2022 regular season (93-69 record).

GETTIN' DOWN ON FRIDAY: According to Stats Perform, last night was the first time in Major League Baseball history that included six four-hit games (Nolan Arenado, Luis Garcia Jr., Manny Machado, Jose Miranda, Brian Reynolds, & Michael A. Taylor), five multiple-homer efforts (Will Smith-3, Colt Keith, Rowdy Tellez, Trea Turner, & Reynolds) and grand slams from five different players (Carlos Correa, Rhys Hoskins, Alek Thomas, Reynolds, & Tellez).

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE: St. Louis (-36, 46-41) is the only Major League team with winning record and negative run differential, while Cincinnati is the lone MLB with a losing record and positive run differential (+20, 42-46) ... St. Louis sports MLB's lowest average margin of victory (2.32), with Tampa Bay ranking 2nd-lowest (2.52).

CAPITAL COMEBACK CARDS: Last night was the 3rd time St. Louis has overcome a 5+ run deficit and won in our Nation's Capital, following June 19, 2023 (down 5-0 after two innings in 8-6 win) and Game 5 of the 2012 NLDS on Oct. 12, 2012 (losing 6-0 after 3 innings in 9-7 win);

Bench Coach **Daniel Descalso** went 3-for-5 with a homer, double, and recorded the game-tying 2-run single.

FOUR SCORE & SEVEN RUNS AGO: The Cardinals scored in each of the final four innings (8-11) of last night's extra-inning comeback win for only the third time in the last 14 seasons ... The two prior instances were June 25, 2012 (innings 7-10) in an 8-7 win at Miami and Oct. 27, 2011 in Game 6 of the 2011 World Series (innings 8-11) in the dramatic 10-9 victory over Texas (Bench Coach Daniel Descalso was 2-for-2 with a run scored). - Elias

EXTRA EXTRA EXTRA: The Cardinals have played extra innings over three consecutive days (July 3-5) for only the 9th time in franchise history and first since their weekend of walkoffs over the Pirates from May 1-3, 2015. - Elias

- The 2021 San Diego Padres are last MLB team to play extras four days in a row (May 26-29).
- The Cardinals have never played four extra-inning games in a row over four consecutive days, but have played extras in five games over a four-day stretch from July 7-10, 1987 (G2 July 7 DH, G2 of July 8, July 9, & July 10) - all 4 walkoffs).
- From July 7-19, 1987, seven of 11 Cardinals games went into extra innings ... Ricky Horton was the July 19 starting pitcher (6.1 IP) vs. Padres & winner pitcher (0.2 IP) on July 9 vs. the Giants when Willie McGee scored with winning run in the 10th.

LOOKS LIKE I PICKED THE WRONG WEEK TO QUIT...: Sixty-three of the Cardinals 87 games (72.4%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer, tying the Brewers for most in MLB ... St. Louis is 38-25 in those games to lead MLB in wins & ranks 2nd in win pct. (.603) to Cleveland (35-21, .625) ... The Cardinals have won eight of their last 11 one-run games (June 13-present).

SOUTHPAWS: The Cardinals are scheduled to face left-handed starting pitchers in five consecutive games (July 4-8) for the first time since six straight from July 5-11, 2008 vs. Cubs (Ted Lilly & Sean Marshall), at Philadelphia (Cole Hamels, J.A. Happ, & **Jamie Moyer**), and at Pittsburgh (**Zach Duke**). ... St. Louis is 14-10 against southpaw starters this season - *Elias* 

BRONCO: Lance Lynn is 10 strikeouts away from becoming the 6th active pitcher to reach the 2,000-strikeout threshold, joining Justin Verlander (3,393), Max Scherzer (3,378), Clayton Kershaw (2,944), Chris Sale (2,316), and Gerrit Cole (2,163) ... In his last start on June 30, Lynn struck out Cincinnati's Noelvi Marte for his 1,000th strikeout in a Cardinals uniform, becoming the 6th pitcher in franchise history to do so with Bob Gibson (3,117), Adam Wainwright (2,202), Dizzy Dean (1,095), Chris **Carpenter** (1,085), and **Bob Forsch** (1,079).

Alec Burleson made his MLB debut vs. the Nationals (Sept. 8, 2022 at Busch).

Ildemaro Vargas was signed by St. Louis as an international free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2008-14).

Juan Yepez played parts of two seasons in St. Louis (2022-23)...traded to the Cardinals organization from Atlanta in exchange for Matt Adams and cash (May 20, 2017).

Jordan Weems's father, Rick Weems, was drafted by St. Louis in the 15th round of 1980...was a minor league catcher in the Cards organization (1980-82).

Nationals Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 1995.

Lane Thomas played in 84 games over parts of three seasons for St. Louis (2019-21)...traded to Washington for Jon Lester (July 30, 2021).

MLB Ranks: Unearned Runs Allowed (13, 1st)

- Makes his 18th start of the season and the 335th of his career (359th appearance).
   Has not faced the Nationals since April 11, 2017, a span of 2,643 days. Only faced the Nationals as a member of the Cardinals organization.
- Needs 10 strikeouts for 2,000 career. Would be the 6th active pitcher to record 2,000 strikeouts joining Justin Verlander, Max Scherzer, Clayton Kershaw, Chris Sale and Gerrit Cole.
- Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout as a member of the Cardinals in his last start vs.
   CIN (6/30), caught Noelvi Marte looking in the 2nd inning to become the 6th pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.
- Threw his first scoreless start of 6.0 innings or more of the season in the 2-0 win over Cincinnati, longest scoreless outing since 7.0 vs. MIL (8/17/23). The win moved him to 9-1 career against the Reds at Busch Stadium.
- Has not suffered a losing decision since his start vs. CIN, coming at Great American Ball Park on Memorial Day (5/27) in a day game after Sunday Night Baseball.
- Threw 6.2 innings vs. ATL (6/24), his 2nd-longest start of the season (4/16 at OAK, 7.0 IP) and did not walk a batter for two straight starts, first time since July 29-Aug. 3, 2022.
- The Cardinals are 10-7 in his starts, with wins in five of his last seven outings since 5/21.
- Struck out five batters vs. PIT (6/13) passing 2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** (1997-2005) for 6th all-time in franchise history with 987.
- Has thrown 4-Seam Fastballs for 618 of his 1,424 total pitches (43.3%) this season.
- In the Baseball Savant database (2008-present), Lynn has thrown the 2nd-most fast-balls (27,760) of any MLB pitcher behind Jon Lester (32,520).
- . St. Louis has played extra innings in five of his 17 starts this year
- · Ranks 1st among NL starters with 10 no-decisions in his 17 starts.
- Ranks 1st in MLB with 15 batters faced with the bases loaded, and leads MLB pitchers with 10 strikeouts.
- Has pitched 6.0 innings or more in just four of his 16 starts (all quality).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout in National League play on May 10 at Milwaukee after fanning Brice Turang (swinging) to lead off the 1st inning.

- Threw 6.0 scoreless innings of two-hit ball with a walk and six strikeouts in a 2-0 win over Cincinnati. Improved to 9-1 on his career vs. CIN at Busch Stadium.
- Struck out his 1.000th batter as a member of the Cardinals (6th all-time).
