Willy Adames hit 2 HR last night to break his own franchise record for HR (32) in a season as a shortstop (had 31 in 2022).....Adames (107 RBI) needs just 6 RBI to tie Robin Yount for the most RBI by a Brewer in a season as a shortstop (Yount had 113 in 1982).

Action Jackson In his last 83 games, Jackson Chourio has hit .307 (95-for-309) with 15 HR and 56 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .368 OBP/.544 SLG/.911 OPS.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 42-29 at home, going 13-8-2 in series play... had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 44-33 on the road, going 14-9-2 in series play, including this series.....are 19-8 in their last 27 road games with a current 3-game winning streak.....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing Bud Black in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff... Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 40 replay challenges this season, going 23-17.....their last challenge (lost) came on 9/10 at San Francisco as an out call at home plate involving Joey Ortiz stood.

TODAY'S STARTER: #37 - LHP DL HALL (8g, 6gs, 1-1, 4.01)

HALL AT A GLANCE: DL Hall, who turns 26 on Thursday, makes his ninth appearance and seventh start of the season.....Hall last pitched on Tuesday at San Francisco in relief (1.2ip, Oh, Or, 1bb, 1k, 18 pitches).....he has thrown 12.2 consecutive scoreless innings.....the team is 4-2 in his starts.....opponents are batting .271 (35-for-129, 5hr).....he is in his fourth stint with the team (Opening Day-4/20, 8/11, 8/30 and 9/1-current).....Hall was acquired from Baltimore, along with INF Joey Ortiz and a 2024 Competitive Balance Round A selection, in exchange for RHP Corbin Burnes on Feb. 1.....he entered the year as the fifth-best prospect in the organization according to Baseball America.....the initials "DL" stand for Dayton Lane.

INJURY REPORT: Hall began the season in the starting rotation before landing on the 15-day injured list on April 21 with a left knee sprain.....he was sent to Class-A Wisconsin on rehab assignment on May 19 and to Triple-A Nashville on May 23.....he was transferred to the 60-day IL on June 8 after aggravating the injury with Nashville.....he began another rehab assignment with Nashville on June 13 that ended after he was struck in the left forearm on a batted ball on July 9.....he began a third rehab assignment with Nashville on July 21.

LAST SEASON: Hall appeared in 18 games with Baltimore, all in relief, and went 3-0 with a 3.26 ERA during two stints (4/29 and 8/26-end of season).....he made his postseason debut in the 2023 American League Division Series against Texas and struck out 6 of the 12 batters he faced over 3.1 scoreless innings during 2 relief appearances.

CAREER: Is 5-2 with a 4.19 ERA and 1 save in 37 games/7 starts (66.2ip, 31er).....is in his third Major League season with Baltimore (2022-23) and Milwaukee (2024).....has gone 1-2 with a 5.68 ERA as a starter (31.2ip, 20er) and 4-0 with a 2.83 ERA in relief (35ip, 11er).....Hall was selected by Baltimore in the first round (21st overall) of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of Valdosta (GA) High School.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 0-1 with a 2.57 ERA in 3 games/2 starts, all coming this season (14ip, 4er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 2-1 with a 4.62 ERA in 19 games/5 starts (39ip, 20er).....is 1-0 with a 5.03 ERA in 5 games/4 starts this season (19.2ip, 11er).

CAREER vs. DIAMONDBACKS: Hall made his only appearance against Arizona in relief with the Orioles on 9/2/23 at Chase Field (1.1ip, Oh, Or, 1bb, 3k).
