Cardinals All-Time Doubleheader Record vs. Cubs (Since 1892): 61-63-108 (233-237-6 record) in 238 single-admission or split doubleheaders

RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs continue their four-game weekend series with a split doublehead-

er today at Busch Stadium ... The Redbirds have dropped the first three games of the homestand against the Royals (0-2) and Cubs, losing three in a row for the first time since a seven-game skid from May 5-11.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 5.0 games behind Milwaukee, and tied with Mets for the 2nd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis and Philadelphia are tied for MLB's 3rd-best record (33-21, .611) ... St. Louis (-42) is the only MLB team with a winning record but a negative run differential.

LEAHY ADDED: The Cardinals have appointed RHP Kyle Leahy from Memphis (AAA) as the 27th player for both games of today's doubleheader ... In 17 games with St. Louis this season, Leahy is 1-1 with a 4.13 ERA (28.1 IP) and 18 strikeouts, ranking 8th among qualified MLB rookie relievers in both WHIP (1.09) and baserunners/9 IP (9.85).

GOLDY KNOCKS: Paul Goldschmidt has driven in a run in his last four games (July 8-present), his longest RBI streak since a five-game streak during his MVP season from July 16-29, 2022 ... Goldy's career 1,159 RBI since 2011 ranks 2nd among active Major Leaguers behind Freddie Freeman (1,202 since 2010).

GIMME A BREAK: The Cardinals are scheduled to play 96 games this season before the All-Star break, tied for 2nd-most in franchise history behind only the 1969 Cardinals who played 97 games from April 8-July 19 ... St. Louis was originally scheduled to play 97, but the May 8 game vs. the Mets was postponed to Aug. 5 due to rain.

HAPPY BIRTHDAY YADI: Happy 42nd birthday to former Cardinals All-Star and World Series Champion catcher Yadier Molina ... Also celebrating today include Cardinals Minor League Hitting Instructor and former All-Star Ryan Ludwick (46), Cody Bellinger (29), DJ LeMahieu (36), Shin-Soo Choo (42), former NBA Slam Dunk champion Anthony "Spud" Webb (61), sports journalist Tony Kornheiser (76), and actors Richard "Cheech" Marin (78), and Harrison Ford (82).

BRONCO: Lance Lynn is eight strikeouts away from becoming the 6th active pitcher to reach the 2,000-strikeout threshold, joining Justin Verlander (3,393), Max Scherzer (3,378), Clayton Kershaw (2,944), Chris Sale (2,316), and Gerrit Cole (2,163)

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals hold the 7th selection in the 2024 MLB Draft, which will take place at the historic Cowtown Coliseum in Fort Worth, Texas ... It marks the Cardinals first time selecting in the top 10 since taking J.D. Drew with the 5th overall selection in 1998 ... St. Louis will only have one selection on Day one after forfeiting their 2nd round pick for the signing of free-agent Sonny Gray ... Last season, the Cardinals drafted OF Chase Davis out of the University of Arizona with the 21st overall selection ... Day One of the MLB Draft, featuring the first 74 selections, begins at 6:00 PM CT on MLB Network ... Day Two on Monday will include rounds 3-10 beginning at 1:00 PM CT with Day Three to follow on Tuesday covering rounds 11-20.

BACK TO THE FUTURES: Springfield (AA) starting pitchers Tink Hence and Quinn Matthews are the Cardinals representatives in today's SiriusXM All-Stars Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, televised at 3 p.m. CT on MLB Network ... Hence will forgo pitching in today's exhibition as he prepares for the second half of the season.

## CHICAGO CUBS CONNECTIONS

Willson Contreras played parts of seven seasons with the Cubs (2016-22)...was a three-time All-Star and member of the 2016 World Series Champions...originally signed as an international free agent with Chicago (July 2, 2009).

**Sonny Gray** was originally selected by the Cubs in the 27th round of the 2008 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Vanderbilt University

Matt Carpenter (June 4, 2011 at Busch III), Tommy Edman (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley), and Stubby Clapp (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Cubs.

As a compensation pick for the departure of **John** Lackey signing with Chicago in 2016, Dylan Carlson (No. 33) was selected by St. Louis in Comp. Round A of the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

Lars Nootbaar and Shota Imanaga were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Patrick Wisdom played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. 52) of the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for **Octavio Dotel** signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for **Drew Robinson** (Dec. 11, 2018).

Chip Caray served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Cardinals VP/General Manager Michael Girsch is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder  $\boldsymbol{\mathsf{Jim}}\;\boldsymbol{\mathsf{Edmonds}}$  played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Tommy Edman and Nico Hoerner were college teammates at Stanford University in 2016.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field.

Cubs Bullpen Coach Darren Holmes pitched in five games for the Cardinals in 2000. Marquee Sports Network Analyst Dexter Fowler

played four seasons in St. Louis (2017-20)

Cubs Scouting VP **Dan Kantrovitz** previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...took first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coord.

### TODAY'S GAME

MLB Ranks: Unearned Runs Allowed (13, 1st)

- Makes his 19th start of the season and the 336th of his career (360th appearance).
- Needs eight strikeouts for 2,000 career. Would be the 6th active pitcher to record 2,000 strikeouts joining Justin Verlander, Max Scherzer, Clayton Kershaw, Chris Sale, and Covrit Colo.
- Would become the 5th pitcher in Major League history to record career strikeout #2,000 with the Cardinals, joining Andy Benes (2002), Bob Gibson (1969), Dazzy Vance (1934), Adam Wainwright (2021). Elias Sports Bureau
- After earning a win in his first four decisions vs. the Cubs (5 starts), has not earned a
  win against them since Sept. 27, 2013, the night the Cardinals clinched the N.L. Central
  with a 7-0 win at Busch Stadium.
- Has gone 3,940 days since his last win against the Cubs, the longest stretch between two wins against the Cubs by any member of the Cardinals, passing Murry Dickson who held the previous record at 3,522 days (9/21/1946-5/13/1956). - Elias Sports Bureau
- Recorded his 1,000th career strikeout as a member of the Cardinals vs. CIN (6/30), caught Noelvi Marte looking in the 2nd inning to become the 6th pitcher in franchise history to reach the mark.
- Suffered his first losing decision in his last start (7/6 at WSH) since Memorial Day (5/27 at CIN) in a day game after Sunday Night Baseball.
- Has not suffered a loss at Busch Stadium since July 4, 2017 vs. MIA (5-2). Has posted a 6-0 record and 3.23 ERA in 17 starts at Busch since (Cardinals are 12-5).
- The Cardinals are 10-8 in his starts, with wins in five of his last seven outings since 5/21.
- Struck out five batters vs. PIT (6/13) passing 2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** (1997-2005) for 6th all-time in franchise history with 987.
- Has thrown 4-Seam Fastballs for 717 of his 1,585 total pitches (45.2%) this season.
- In the Baseball Savant database (2008-present), Lynn has thrown the 2nd-most fast-balls (27,904) of any MLB pitcher behind Jon Lester (32,520).
- St. Louis has played extra innings in five of his 18 starts this year
- Ranks T-1st among NL starters (Austin Gomber) with 10 no-decisions in his 18 starts.
- Leads MLB with 15 batters faced with the bases loaded, and leads MLB pitchers with 10 strikeouts.
- Has pitched 6.0 innings or more in just four of his 16 starts (all quality).
- Recorded his 1,000th strikeout in National League play on May 10 at Milwaukee after fanning Brice Turang (swinging) to lead off the 1st inning.

## LAST TIME OUT

Surrendered a career-high in runs (11) and earned runs (10) as the Cardinals lost 14-6
tossing his shortest outing of the season (2.2 IP) and since July 1, 2018 at CHI w/MIN
in an 11-10 loss at Wrigley Field, lasting just five outs.
