RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Chicago Cubs kick off a four-game weekend series tonight at Busch Stadium on the nationally televised Apple TV+ ... The Cards and Cubs will play a split doubleheader tomorrow, and then wrap up the first half with Sunday's afternoon finale ... St. Louis began its homestand by dropping both games of a doubleheader to cross-state rival Kansas City on Wednesday.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 5.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 2nd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis and Philadelphia are tied for MLB's 3rd-best record (33-20, .623) ... After 92 games, the Redbirds 48-44 record is a nine-game improvement from last season (38-52) and matches their 90-game start in 2022 when they finished 93-69 and won the NL Central. PLUS/MINUS: St. Louis (-38) is the only MLB team with a winning record but a negative run differential.

HERRERA OPTIONED: The Cardinals announced today that they activated C Iván Herrera from the 10-Day Injured List and optioned him to Memphis (AAA) ... Herrera missed the last 19 games due to lower back tightness.

GIMME A BREAK: The Cardinals are scheduled to play 96 games this season before the All-Star break, tied for 2nd-most in franchise history behind only the 1969 Cardinals who played 97 games from April 8-July 19 ... St. Louis was originally scheduled to play 97, but the May 8 game vs. the Mets was postponed to Aug. 5 due to rain.

GOTTA GET DOWN ON FRIDAY: The Cardinals are 18-11 in series openers, which includes an 8-4 record and .667 win pct. on Friday that ranks as the 4th-best in MLB ... St. Louis has won its last four Friday matchups (vs. Rockies, at Cubs, vs. Reds, at Washington).

LOOKS LIKE I PICKED THE WRONG WEEK TO QUIT ...: Sixty-five of the Cardinals 92 games (70.7%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer, tying the Brewers for most in MLB ... St. Louis is 38-27 in those games, co-leading MLB in wins (Cleveland) & ranking 4th in win pct. (.585) ... The Cardinals have won eight of their last 11 one-run games since June 13.

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Since Willson Contreras signed with St. Louis 2023, his .382 batting average vs. the Cubs is the 4th-highest in MLB over the last two seasons behind Matt McLain (.438), Tyler O'Neill (.389), and Francisco Alvarez (.385).

PASS THE BISCUITS MIRANDY: Since June 22, Alec Burleson leads all of MLB with 23 RBI ahead of 2nd place Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (22) ... Overall this season, "Biscuit" leads St. Louis in RBI (48), go-ahead RBI (15), and game-wining RBI (10) ... The last Cardinal with 10+ game-winning RBI before the All-Star Break was Yadier Molina (10 in 2021), and last by left-handed batter with 10+ was Rick Ankiel (10 in 2008) ... Albert Pujols (15 in 2006) holds the Cardinals pre-All-Star GW RBI record.

HELSLEY RETURNS TO ALL-STAR GAME: Closer Ryan Helsley was selected by MLB to represent the Cardinals at the 2024 Major League All-Star Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Tex... With his 2nd career All-Star nod (2022 and 2024), Helsley:

- joins Hall of Famers Lee Smith (1991-93) and Bruce Sutter (1981, 1984) as Cardinals closers to make multiple All-Star games.
- is the first since Carlos Martinez (2015, 2017) who was developed by the Cardinals and became a two-time All-Star with St. Louis.
- is the 9th Cardinal and 2nd pitcher (Matt Morris, 2001-02) since 1965 who was drafted and developed by the Cardinals and made multiple All-Star games.

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (July 12, 1996): St. Louis matches a franchise record with seven home runs in a 13-3 victory over the Cubs at Wrigley Field, highlighted by a pair of homers by both Gary Gaetti and Ron Gant ... John Mabry, Ray Lankford, and Brian Jordan also chip in with long balls to match the club's previous record from May 7, 1940 against the Brooklyn Dodgers at Sportsman's Park (later matched on May 18, 2023 vs. the Los Angeles Dodgers at Busch III).

Star and member of the 2016 World Series Champions...originally signed as an international free agent with Chicago (July 2, 2009).

Sonny Gray was originally selected by the Cubs in the 27th round of the 2008 MLB Draft, but did not sign to attend Vanderbilt University.

Willson Contreras played parts of seven seasons

with the Cubs (2016-22)...was a three-time All-

Matt Carpenter (June 4, 2011 at Busch III), Tommy Edman (June 8, 2019 at Wrigley), and **Stubby** Clapp (June 18, 2001 at Busch II) made MLB debuts vs. the Cubs.

Ryan Loutos was born in nearby Elk Grove Village, III...graduated from Barrington (III.) High School... resides in Barrington.

Chris Rovcroft was born in nearby Elmhurst, III.. graduated from Willowbrook High School in Villa Park, Ill...played college baseball and basketball at Divison III Aurora (III.) University from 2016-19... pitched for the Joliet Slammers of the independent Frontier League (2021-22).

CHICAGO CUBS CONNECTIONS

Daniel Descalso played his final MLB season with the Cubs in 2019.

Nolan Gorman won the 2017 Under Armour High School All-America Game HR Derby at Wrigley Field.

As a compensation pick for the departure of John Lackey signing with Chicago in 2016, Dylan Carlson (No. 33) was selected by St. Louis in Comp. Round A of the first round of the 2016 MLB draft.

Dylan Carlson and Nick Madrigal were teammates at Elk Grove (Calif). High School, coached by Dylan's father, Jeff.

Lars Nootbaar and Shota Imanaga were teammates on Gold Medal winning Team Japan in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

Patrick Wisdom played in 32 games for St. Louis during 2018 debut season...originally selected by the Cardinals in the Supp. 1st round (No. the 2012 MLB Draft, as compensation for Octavio Dotel signing with Detroit...traded by St. Louis to Texas for Drew Robinson (Dec. 11, 2018).

Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Fame outfielder **Jim Edmonds** played part of 2008 with the Cubs.

Tommy Edman and Nico Hoerner were college teammates at Stanford University in 2016.

Cardinals VP/General Manager Michael Girsch is a Chicago native...graduated from the University of Notre Dame and the University of Chicago.

Cubs Bullpen Coach Darren Holmes pitched in five games for the Cardinals in 2000

Marquee Sports Network Analyst Dexter Fowler played four seasons in St. Louis (2017-20).

Chip Caray served as the Cubs play-by-play announcer for seven seasons (1998-2004) on WGN...his grandfather, **Harry Caray**, spent the final 16 years of his career broadcasting Cubs games (1982-97).

Cubs Scouting VP Dan Kantrovitz previously was Cardinals Scouting Director (2012-14)...2001 Cards 25th Rd. draft pick from Brown Univ...took first job in MLB as the Cardinals Scouting Coord.

- Makes his 17th start of the season tonight, and 13th career start against the Chicago Cubs - 2nd as a member of the Cardinals.
- Is working on 6 days rest; Is 16-13, 3.54 ERA in 50 career starts on 6+ days rest.
- Is trying to post 10 wins pre-All-Star break for the 3rd time in his career (10 in 2014 & 2015 with OAK), and become the 1st Cardinal to do so since 2018 (Miles Mikolas, 10).
- Among active pitchers with 10+ starts, Gray has the lowest career WHIP (0.89), the 5th-lowest career ERA (2.76) & the 2nd-lowest opponent BA (.178) against the Cubs.
- Limited the Cubs to just one hit (Bellinger 4th inning single) over 5.0 scoreless innings in a 4-3 win at Busch Stadium in ESPN Sunday Night game on 5/26 that had a 2 hour 33 minute delayed start due to weather. Paul Goldschmidt hit a pair of 2-run HR's in the win
- Retired the first 20 batters faced in his 6/23 start vs. SF, the 2nd most consecutive batters retired to begin a start during his career (4/6/15 vs. TEX 21 batters).
- Opened the season on the Injured List and made his first start on April 9 at Philadelphia, 12 games into the season. Since April 9, is T-5th in Major Leagues with nine wins and 7th with 115 strikeouts.
- His 115 strikeouts over his first 16 starts with the Cardinals organization are the most in franchise history. Is the 9th pitcher in Cardinals history overall to record 100+ strikeouts in his first 14 starts of any season. **Bob Gibson** leads with four such seasons (1965, 1966, 1969, 1970).
- Despite missing first 11 games of season, his 115 strikeouts prior to the All-Star break are most by Cardinals pitcher since Carlos Martinez fanned 128 in 2017 (18 starts).
- Has a 56.5 strikeout % on his Sweeper pitch (fanning 61 in 108 plate appearances), is the top MLB's K% of any pitch (minimum 100 plate appearances); Kyle Gibson's 43.4 K pct. on his Sweeper is ranked 4th in all of MLB.
- Is 6-3 with a 1.90 ERA (52.0 IP) and .167 Opp. BA with two home runs allowed at Busch Stadium this year. Tied for 3rd in home wins (6) and ranks 4th in opponent BA (.167) at home among MLB pitchers.
- Has yielded eight home runs this season in 92.2 innings pitched after an MLB-low eight homers allowed over 184.0 innings pitched among 2023 qualifiers.
- Is a perfect 4-0, 2.19 ERA (24.2 IP/6 ER) in four Interleague starts this season; **Michael Wacha** (7-0) in 2023 with SD Padres was last with 1.000 interleague win pct. & 5+ wins.
- Recorded a decision in his first 12 starts to start his Cardinals career, 7th Cardinals pitcher in the organization since 1901 to hit the 12 mark and first since Kip Wells (2007)
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - Elias
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his
 first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); Has 16 career double-digit strikeout games, two this year.
- Only Jaime Garcia (0.46 in 2011) had a lower Home ERA over his 1st five home starts to begin a season at Busch Stadium III than Gray (0.93). Garcia had 0.81 ERA through his 1st six home starts

LAST TIME OUT

 Took just his 2nd no-decision of the season, as Cardinals rallied from early 5-0 deficit to win 7-6 in 11 innings at Washington last Friday. Was nicked for 5+ runs in consecutive starts for just the 2nd time this season.

- Limited the Cubs to just one hit (Bellinger single) over 5.0 scoreless innings in a 4-3 win at Busch Stadium in ESPN Sunday Night game on 5/26 that had a 2 hour 33 minute delayed start due to weather. Paul Goldschmidt hit a pair of 2-run HR's in the win.
- Faced the Cubs nine times while a member of the division rival Cincinnati Reds and was 4-2 with a 3.06 ERA (50.0 innings) and 68 strikeouts.
- Recorded 11 strikeouts in 12-7 win against the Cubs, coming during the COVID-19 shortened season, July 29, 2020 at Great American Ballpark. Reds won 12-7 as Gray departed after 6.2 innings with a 9-0 lead before the bullpen made it interesting.
