AT HOME: The Brewers are 43-29 at home, going 13-8-2 in series play.....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 44-34 on the road, going 14-9-2 in series play.....are 19-9 in their last 28 road games.....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing **Bud Black** in June (42-54).....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009).....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach **Ozzie Timmons** (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff.. Rickie Weeks (associate manager), Daniel de Mondesert (assistant coach), Matt Erickson (infield coach) and Charlie Greene (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 41 replay challenges this season, going 24-17.....their last challenge (won) came on 9/15 at Arizona as an out call at first base involving Jackson Chourio stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #47 - RHP FRANKIE MONTAS (27gs, 7-10, 4.49)

MONTAS AT A GLANCE: Frankie Montas, 31, will be making his 28th start of the season and ninth with the Brewers.....Montas last started last Thursday at San Francisco and earned a 3-0 win (6ip, 2h, 2bb, 8k, 102 pitches)... his teams are 12-15 in his starts (6-2 with Brewers)....he has 9 quality starts.. opponents are batting .239 (126-for-527, 18hr).....he was acquired from Cincinnati on July 30 in exchange for RHP Jakob Junis, OF Joey Wiemer and cash.....he went 4-8 with a 5.01 ERA in 19 starts with the Reds [93.1ip, 93h, 56r, 52er, 41bb, 78k, 14hr).....he was on the 15-day injured list from 4/22-5/6 with a right forearm contusion.....he is 3-2 with a 3.40 ERA in 8 starts with the Brewers (45ip, 33h, 20r, 17er, 18bb, 50k, 4hr).....Montas is signed through the 2024 season with a mutual option for 2025.....name is pronounced "MOHN-tahs."

LAST SEASON: Montas was limited to just a single game last season with the Yankees, coming in relief on 9/30 at Kansas City.....he missed nearly the entire season while recovering from Feb. 21 right shoulder surgery.

CAREER: Is 44-45 with a 4.01 ERA in 157 games/126 starts (732ip, 326er)....is in his ninth Major League season with Chicago-AL (2015), Oakland (2017-22), New York-AL [2022-23], Cincinnati [2024] and Milwaukee [2024].....he pitched in the postseason with the Athletics in 2020 and 2022.....he had his best season in 2021 as he finished sixth in American League Cy Young Award voting after going 13-9 with a 3.37 ERA in 32 starts.....Montas was originally signed as a non-drafted free agent with Boston on 12/14/09.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 0-1 with a 4.66 ERA in 4 starts (19.1ip. 10er).....is 0-1 with a 3.38 ERA in 3 starts this season (16ip. 6er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 25-20 with a 4.55 ERA in 79 games/64 starts [356ip, 180er].....is 6-4 with a 4.75 ERA in 16 starts this season [83.1ip, 44er].

CAREER vs. PHILLIES: Is 1-1 with a 5.06 ERA in 2 starts, both coming at Citizens Bank Park (10,2ip, 11h, 6r, 6er, 4bb, 11k, 2hr)......he took a 9-5 loss with the Athletics on 4/8/22 (Sip, 6h, 5r, 5er, 1bb, 6k, 1hr) and earned a 4-1 win on 4/3 this season with the Reds (5.2ip, 5h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 5k, 1hr).
