WHAT'S BREWING?

The Hunt for October

For the 10th time in franchise history and sixth time over the last seven seasons, the Brewers have qualified for the postseason....the team has won the NL Central division in four of the last seven seasons, three of the last four and two in a row (2018, 2021, 2023 and 2024).

Missed It By That Much!

The Brewers were just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons, missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game.

Brewing Consistency

The Brewers and Dodgers are the only teams in the Major Leagues with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24)....this does not include 2020.

A Day Off

Willy Adames missed his first game of the season last night....he had started 156 consecutive games at shortstop dating back to last season, which is second in franchise history behind Robin Yount (207g, 1975-77).

Willy Do It?

Willy Adames has a franchise-record 32 HR as a shortstop this season, breaking his own record of 31 HR in 2022....Adames (109 RBI) needs just 4 RBI to tie Robin Yount (113 in 1982) for the most RBI as a shortstop in a season in franchise history.

Action Jackson

In his last 89 games, Jackson Chourio has hit .302 (100-for-331) with 16 HR and 61 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .361 OBP/.544 SLG/.905 OPS.

IN THE STANDINGS (176 days): The Brewers have spent the following number of days alone or tied at each position in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 162, **SECOND:** 13, **THIRD:** 1, **FOURTH:** 0, **FIFTH:** 0....the team is in first place, leading the Cubs by 10.0 games, Cardinals by 11.0 games, Reds by 14.5 games and Pirates by 16.0 games....the Brewers clinched a postseason berth and the NL Central on Sept. 18.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 44-31 at home, going 14-8-2 in series play....the team has had two season-high 6-game home winning streaks (5/29-6/10 and 6/15-6/28).

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 44-34 on the road, going 14-9-2 in series play....are 19-9 in their last 28 road games....the team has had two season-high 4-game road winning streaks (4/9-4/13 and 8/6-8/20).

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach....his only Major League managerial experience previously came in 2015 as interim manager of the Padres, replacing Bud Black in June (42-54)....he enjoyed a 25-year college head coaching career primarily at the University of Notre Dame (1988-94) and Arizona State University (1995-2009)....Murphy went 1,000-457-4 as a college coach and was on pace to be the winningest coach in NCAA history before he transitioned into the professional ranks.

COACHES: First base coach Quintin Berry (4th season), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach Connor Dawson (3rd season), assistant pitching coach Jim Henderson (3rd season/1st in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (6th season), third base coach Jason Lane (9th season/4th in current role), run prevention coordinator Walker McKinven (5th season/1st in current role) and hitting coach Ozzie Timmons (3rd season) all returned from the 2023 staff....**Rickie Weeks** (associate manager), **Daniel de Mondesert** (assistant coach), **Matt Erickson** (infield coach) and **Charlie Greene** (bullpen coach) are in their first seasons on the coaching staff, all Major League coaches for the first time.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 41 replay challenges this season, going 24-17....their last challenge (won) came on 9/15 at Arizona as an out call at first base involving Jackson Chourio stood.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: #48 - RHP COLIN REA [29g, 25gs, 12-5, 4.14]

REA AT A GLANCE: Colin Rea, 34, will be making his 30th appearance and 26th start of the season....Rea last pitched on Monday vs. Philadelphia and notched the first save of his professional career (2.2ip, 3h, Or, Qbb, 1k, 29 pitches)....he is 10-5 with a 4.41 ERA as a starter (138.2ip, 68er) and 2-0 with a 2.00 ERA in relief (18ip, 4er)....the team is 17-8 in his starts....he has a career-high 8 quality starts....opponents are batting .249 (152-for-610, 27hr)....he has 10+ wins for the first time....he also has career highs in innings pitched (156.2) and strikeouts (124)....Rea is signed through the 2024 season with a club option for 2025....name is pronounced "RAY."

CAREER: Is 26-19 with a 4.52 ERA and 1 save in 91 games/74 starts (435.2ip, 219er)....has pitched in the majors for San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Chicago-NL (2020) and Milwaukee (2021, '23-24)....is 22-18 with a 4.70 ERA as a starter (391ip, 204er) and 4-1 with a 3.02 ERA in relief (44.2ip, 15er)....Rea was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 First-Year Player Draft out of Indiana State University....he underwent "Tommy John" surgery on 11/11/16, causing him to miss the entire 2017 season.... Rea also pitched in Japan with the Fukuoka SoftBank Hawks in 2021 and 2022.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 9-7 with a 4.23 ERA in 30 games/25 starts (149ip, 70er)....is 7-3 with a 3.78 ERA in 15 games/13 starts this season (83.1ip, 35er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-8 with a 4.71 ERA in 41 games/31 starts (193ip, 101er)....is 5-2 with a 4.54 ERA in 14 games/12 starts this season (73.1ip, 37er).

CAREER vs. DIAMONDBACKS: Is 0-0 with a 7.20 ERA in 2 starts (10ip, 15h, 9r, 8er, 4bb, 6k, 2hr)....his first start came as a member of the Padres on 7/6/16 at Chase Field (4.2ip, 8h, 4r, 4er, 3bb-1bb, 4k, 1hr, 1hbp)....Padres won, 13-6....his other start came last season on 6/20 in Milwaukee (5.1ip, 7h, 5r, 4er, 1bb, 2k, 1hr)....Brewers won, 7-5.
