**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals kick off a seven-game road trip through Pittsburgh (3G) and Washington D.C. (4G) with tonight's opener of a three-game series with the division-rival Pirates at PNC Park ... St. Louis will be celebrating Independence Day in Pittsburgh for the first time since 1996 at Three Rivers Stadium ... The Redbirds recently went 7-3 on their longest "home" stand of the season by sweeping San Francisco (3-0) between Alabama's Rickwood Field and Busch Stadium, then taking two-of-three from Atlanta and splitting with Cincinnati (2-2).

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 6.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 3rd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis leads the National League in wins (28) and win pct. (.636).

**AHOY MATEY:** Despite dropping seven of its last nine games here since Sept. 9, 2022, St. Louis leads all visiting teams with 112 wins all-time at PNC Park (2001-present), while their .577 win pct. ranks 3rd among annual Steel City visitors behind the Dodgers (.600) and Padres (.592) and is their 6th-highest road win pct. at an active road MLB ballpark.

**HAPPY BIRTHDAY O!!:** Cardinals manager **Oliver Marmol** celebrates his 38th birthday today and is the youngest active manager in Major League Baseball ... Marmol is 2-0 on his birthday, with the Cardinals gift-wrapping wins at Philadelphia (8-7) in 2022 and over the Yankees (5-1) in St. Louis last season ... Also celebrating birthdays today are **Sean Casey** (50), **José Canseco** (60), and former Cardinals **Brett Cecil** (38), **Joe Magrane** (60), and **So Taguchi** (55).

**NAIL BITERS:** Fifty-nine of the Cardinals 84 games (70.2%) this season have been decided by three runs or fewer, 2nd-most in Major League Baseball behind the Cubs (60).

- St. Louis is 35-24 (.593) in games decided by three runs or fewer (15-11 in 1-run; 10-8 in 2-run; & 10-5 in 3-run) ... Those 35 combined wins lead MLB & their .593 win pct. is 2nd-best to Cleveland (34-20, .630),
- The Cardinals sport MLB's lowest average margin of victory (2.38), with Tampa Bay ranking 2nd (2.50).

**CATCHING COMBOS:** The Cardinals (**Iván Herrera**-39, **Willson Contreras**-24, **Pedro Pagés**-20) and Pirates (**Yasmani Grandal**-30; **Henry Davis**-26; **Joey Bart**-20) are the only two Major League teams this season to have three players all start 20 or more games at catcher ... The last time this occurred for St. Louis was 2014 with **Yadier Molina** (106), **Tony Cruz** (35) & **A.J. Pierzynski** (20) ... For the first time in team history, every catcher to appear with St. Louis this season has been born outside of the continental United States (Panama & Venezuela). - *Orf*

**BO KNOWS?:** When reliever **Jacob Bosiokovic** (age 30-194) makes his MLB debut, he will become the oldest North American-born Cards pitcher to make an MLB debut since LHP **Kevin Ohme** (32-001) on April 14, 2003 at Milwaukee ... RHP **Stoney McGlynn** (34-117) holds the Cardinals record for oldest MLB debut as a Cardinals pitcher (Sept. 20, 2006 at Philly).

**NO JUNE SWOON:** St. Louis finished June with a 16-12 record (.571), sharing the NL lead in wins (4 teams) and marking its best June since the 2015 Cardinals went 18-8 en route to a 100-win season and the National League Central title.

**INFIELD CANNONS:** Rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** is averaging 93.5 mph on throws (top 5% of competitive throws), 2nd-fastest among MLB infielders (min. 200+ throws) to Pittsburgh's **Oneil Cruz** (95.0). - *Baseball Savant*

**HEL'S BELLS:** **Ryan Helsley** has converted a Cardinals record 30 consecutive save opportunities since April 1, MLB's longest active save streak since Milwaukee **Josh Hader** nailed down 32 straight (July 18, 2021 to June 5, 2022) ... With his next save before the All-Star Break, Helsley will pass **Lee Smith** (1993) for the franchise record and rank T-8th in MLB history before the break.

**BACK TO THE FUTURES:** RHP **Tink Hence** and LHP **Quinn Mathews** will be the Cardinals representatives in this year's SiriusXM All-Stars Futures Game in Texas ... Hence is the first two-time Cardinals pitcher to participate since RHP **Alex Reyes** (2015-16).

**Oliver Marmol** was originally selected by Pittsburgh in the 31st Rd. of the 2004 MLB draft, but did not sign.

**Miles Mikolas** spent one month as a Pirate during the 2013 offseason...traded by San Diego with **Jaff Decker** to Pittsburgh for **Alex Dickerson** (Nov. 25, 2013), then traded by Pittsburgh to the Rangers for **Chris McGuiness** (Dec. 30, 2013).

**Michael Siani's** younger brother, **Sammy Siani**, was selected by Pittsburgh with the 37th overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft and is an outfielder for Altoona (AA) in the Pirates organization.

**Nolan Arenado** (2009) and **Paul Skenes** (2020) are graduates of El Toro High School in Lake Forest, Calif.

**David Bednar** was teammates of **Miles Mikolas**, **Paul Goldschmidt**, and **Nolan Arenado** on Team USA in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.

**Turner Ward** played parts of three seasons (1997-99) with Pittsburgh...managed two seasons in the Pirates minor league organization for the 2006 GCL Pirates and 2007 State College Spikes (SS).

**Willson Contreras** (June 17, 2016 at Wrigley Field), **Sonny Gray** (July 10, 2013 at PNC Park), **Andre Pallante** (April 10, 2022 at Busch), **Nolan Gorman** (May 20, 2022 at PNC Park), **Matthew Liberatore** (May 21, 2022 at PNC Park), and **Drew Rom** (Aug. 21, 2023 at PNC Park) made their MLB debuts vs. the Pirates.

**Marco Gonzales** pitched parts of three seasons in St. Louis (2014-15, '17)...was selected by the Cardinals in the 1st round (#19) of 2013 MLB Draft...2014 Cardinals Minor League Pitcher of the Year...traded to Seattle for **Tyler O'Neill** (July 21, 2017).

2024 Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Morris** pitched two seasons in Pittsburgh (2007-08).

**Riley O'Brien's** great uncle, **Eddie O'Brien** played for Pittsburgh as an infielder and also made five pitching appearances (1953, 1955-58).

**Derek Shelton** was born in Carbondale, Ill...caught four seasons (1989-92) at Southern Illinois University.

**Johan Oviedo** signed as an international free agent with the Cardinals on July 2, 2016...pitched parts of three seasons with St. Louis (2020-22)...traded to Pittsburgh with **Malcom Nunez** for **José Quintana** and **Chris Stratton** (Aug. 2, 2022).

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Julián Javier** signed with Pittsburgh as an amateur free agent in 1956...played parts of five seasons in the Pirates minor league organization (1956-60)...traded by Pittsburgh with **Ed Bauta** to St. Louis for **Dick Gray** and **Vinegar Bend Mizell** (May 28, 1960).

- Making his 16th start of the season and as a member of the Cardinals (310th career).
- Went 12 days between starts in June due Bereavement leave (June 16-18), lower back soreness (June 19), and a postponement due to rain (June 25).
- Held his opposition to three runs or fewer in five of his last six starts dating back to May 22, posting a 2-1 record with 3.03 ERA (32.2 IP) with 34 strikeouts.
- Held his opposition to two earned runs or fewer in 9-of-15 starts, 2nd behind Sonny Gray (10) for the most by a Cardinal.
- Logged 6.0+ innings pitched in each of his first seven starts to begin the season (April 1-May 6), longest by a Cardinal to begin a season since 2017 (**Mike Leake** - 11 & **Michael Wacha** - 7). Streak was snapped in his 5/22 start vs. BAL (4.0 IP).
- Posted career-highs for innings pitched (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April. Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings were the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month, most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (**Sonny Gray** & **Lance Lynn**) that the Cardinals signed last off-season.
- Pitching for his fifth Major League team: Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).

LAST TIME OUT

- Allowed four runs with a season-high five walks over 4.0 innings in the Cardinals 6-2 loss the Braves in Game 1 of last Wednesday's doubleheader vs. the Braves.
- Snapped a four-game winning streak while his first losing decision since April 13 at Arizona (12 start span).

- Since 2013, leads active Major League Baseball pitchers in grounded into double plays (215). Has allowed 213 career home runs over that period for comparison.
- Durable starting pitcher has made 29 or more starts in eight of the last 10 seasons, the most by any MLB pitcher.
- Has worked 150+ IP (minors/majors combined) in 10-straight (2013-23) professional seasons, excluding the COVID shortened 2020 season.
- Has not allowed an earned run with **Pedro Pagés** catching behind the plate in his two starts (11.0 IP).
- Owns career marks of 109-103, one of 14 active pitchers with 100 or more wins. Ranks 10th among active pitchers with 109 wins.
- Has posted eight 10-win seasons since his MLB debut in 2013, tied for 4th-most among over that period trailing only **Max Scherzer** (10), **Gerrit Cole** (9) & **Clayton Kershaw** (9).
- Is one of four pitchers since 2014 to record 100 or more strikeouts in 9-of-10 seasons with **Jacob deGrom**, **Clayton Kershaw** and **Max Scherzer**.

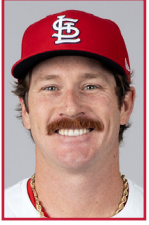
- Making his 5th career start against the Pirates and his first as a member of the Cardinals.
