RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Chicago Cubs play the finale of a four-game weekend series today at Busch Stadium, concluding a six-game rivalry homestand (2-3) with Kansas City (0-2) and Chicago (2-1) leading into the All-Star Break ... St. Louis opens a six-game road trip through Atlanta (July 19-21) and Pittsburgh (July 22-24) on Friday.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals have won 50+ games before the All-Star break for the 15th time in franchise history ... St. Louis enters today in 2nd place in the NL Central, 3.5 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 2nd position in the NL Wild Card race ... The 3.5-game deficit is the closest the Cardinals have been to first place since April 18 when they were 3.0 games back and in 5th place (9-10 record) ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns MLB's 3rd-best record (35-21, .625).

I'LL HAVE ONE OF THOSE: A victory today would give the Cardinals their most wins before the break since the 2015 NL Central Champs began 56-33, and a winning season series over Chicago for the 16th time since 2000 and 5th time in the last seven seasons (2018, 2019, 2021, & 2022).

SUNDAY FUNDAY: The Cardinals have won 13 of their last 14 series finales (May 22-present), including seven straight Sundays since May 26 (vs. Cubs, at Phillies, vs. Rockies, at Cubs, vs. Giants, vs. Reds, at Washington) ... St. Louis boasts a league-leading 1.55 ERA over its seven-game Sunday winning streak.

GIMME A BREAK: The Cardinals 96th game today before the All-Star break today matches their 2nd-most in franchise history behind only the 1969 Cardinals who played 97 games from April 8-July 19 ... St. Louis was originally scheduled to play 97, but the May 8 game vs. the Mets was postponed to Aug. 5 due to rain ... According to MLB's Sarah Langs, Major League Baseball will have combined for 1,449 total games played by the end of today, most in any season before the All-Star break since the exhibition began in 1933.

GOLDY KNOCKS: Paul Goldschmidt is six hits away from becoming the 5th active Major Leaguer with 2,000 career hits with Freddie Freeman

(2,217), Jose Altuve (2,164), Joey Votto (2135), and Andrew McCutchen (2,116) ... Goldy would also become 18th player in history to reach the 2,000-hit milestone in a Cardinals uniform and first since Yadier Molina in 2020.

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT: Since June 17, Brendan Donovan ranks 3rd in Major League Baseball in hits (33) behind Phillies shortstop Trea Turner (34) and Rays catcher Yainer Diaz (34).

PASS THE BISCUITS MIRANDY: Alec Burleson's team-leading 52 RBI are the most by a Cardinals left-handed-hitting outfielder since Jim Edmonds (56 in 2004; 67 in 2003; & 59 in 2000) ... Since June 17, "Biscuit" leads Major League Baseball with 28 runs batted ahead of 2nd place Brandon Nimmo (27).

CENTRAL PERKS: St. Louis has won 17 of its last 22 divisional games since beginning the season 0-6 (all vs. Milwaukee).

BACK TO THE FUTURES: Springfield (AA) starting pitcher and Cardinals No. 2 prospect Quinn Matthews fanned two in a scoreless 6th inning in yesterday's MLB All-Stars Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas ... The 23-year-old worked around a base hit while striking out Ralphy Velazquez (looking) on an 86.2 mph slider and Luke Keaschall (swinging) on a 94.7 mph four-seam fastball ... Mathews was the only pitcher to strike out multiple batters without issuing a walk.

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals hold the 7th selection in tonight's 2024 MLB Draft, which will take place at the historic Cowtown Coliseum in Fort Worth, Texas ... It marks the Cardinals first time selecting in the top 10 since taking J.D. Drew with the 5th overall selection in 1998 ... St. Louis has only one selection tonight after forfeiting their 2nd round pick for the signing of free agent Sonny Gray ... Last season, the Cardinals drafted OF Chase Davis out of the University of Arizona with the 21st overall selection ... Day One of the MLB Draft, featuring the first 74 selections, begins at 6:00 PM CT on MLB Network ... Day Two on Monday includes rounds 3-10 beginning at 1:00 PM CT, with Day Three on Tuesday covering rounds 11-20.

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 20th start of the season and his 170th career (198th appearance).
- Is facing the Cubs for the 3rd time this season (1-0, 2.92 ERA) and for the 22nd time in his career. Today is his 20th career start vs. the Cubs, matching his career high against any opponent (also Pirates).
- Is 4-2 with a 3.81 ERA over his last 10 starts (5/18-present) with a 0.98 WHIP; was 3-4 with a 5.77 ERA with a 1.42 WHIP in his first nine starts (3/28-5/12).
- Since May 18, ranks T-8th among MLB pitchers with a 0.98 WHIP.
- Six (T-1st NL) of his seven wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, he has winning road record (33-28), but is just 24-26 at Busch Stadium; has logged Quality Starts in each of his last seven road games, the majors longest such streak this season (the Cubs **Justin Steele** is T-2nd with six straight).
- . Has thrown over 100 pitches in only one of his 19 starts (101 on May 1 at Detroit).
- In his 159 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 65-33 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings (7-5 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-38 when he works 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 47-5 (.902 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 62-14 in those 76 games). He's just 10-50 (.166) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 26-57).
- His loss vs. Milwaukee (April 20, 2024) was his first ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Made his 77th career start at Busch Stadium III on June 27, passing Michael Wacha and tying Jaime Garcia for 4th in stadium history. Kyle Lohse is 3rd with 78.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 5th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018.

• Posted MLB-best 7th-straight road Quality Start, blanking the Nationals on Mon. (7/8) in D.C. over his 6.1 IP. The Cardinals enjoyed their largest margin of victory in the 6-0 win.

- Is 24-26 in his 78 games (77 starts) at Busch Stadium as a Cardinal (St. Louis is 43-35).
- Ranks among Busch Stadium III rankings in starts (77, T-4th), innings pitched (468.1, 7th), ERA (3.56, 6th), quality starts (43, 6th), and wins (24, 8th).
- Made his 77th career start at Busch Stadium III on June 27, passing Michael Wacha and tying Jaime Garcia for 4th in stadium history. Kyle Lohse is 3rd with 78.

#### CAREER

- St. Louis is 88-72 (.550) in his 160 career outings (159 starts) since joining the organization (2018-present).
- Since joining St. Louis in 2018, Mikolas trails only Clayton Kershaw (67.6%) with the 2nd-highest percentage of first pitch strikes in MLB with 67.5%.
- Is in his 7th season (was injured in 2020) with the Cardinals in 2024. Is currently ranked 2nd among active Cardinals pitchers in career innings pitched (940.0), wins (57), strikeouts (686) and games started (159) for St. Louis; trailing only Lance Lynn

- Makes his 20th career start (22nd appearance) vs. the Cubs. The 20 starts will match his most against any opponent (also Pirates).
- Pitched 6.0 innings in a no decision in his first start vs. the Cubs at Busch Stadium on May 25 as the Cardinals scored four runs in the 8th inning for a 7-6 win.
- Went 6.1 IP on 6/16/24 at Wrigley Field, gaining a 2-1 as Pedro Pages' 2-run HR was difference in the Father's Day win for St. Louis.
- Has not allowed a home run over his last six appearances (30.1 IP) vs. the Cubs. Last was by Zack McKinstry (8/24/22; 7th inning at Wrigley Field).
- St. Louis has won 13 of this 19 career starts vs. Chicago as a member of the Cardinals, with Miles posting a 1.98 ERA (81.2 IP/18 ER) in the 12 games won.
- Held the Cubs to three runs or less in 16 of 19 career starts since 2018, most in MLB with Luis Castillo (14), Brandon Woodruff (13) and Jack Flaherty (12) trailing.
