RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Washington Nationals play the opener of a four-game weekend series tonight at Nationals Park as the Redbirds continue their seven-game road trip through Pittsburgh (2-1) and the Nation's Capital ... The Redbirds celebrated yesterday's Independence Day with a Happy Flight to Washington after surviving the Pirates, 3-2, in 10 innings at PNC Park, coming away winners for the 12th time in their last 13 series finales.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 6.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 3rd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns MLB's 3rd-best record (30-17, .638).

PLUS/MINUS: The Cardinals (-37) and Rays (-52, 44-43) are the only Major League teams this season with winning records and negative run differentials ... St. Louis sports MLB's lowest average margin of victory (2.35), with Tampa Bay ranking 2nd-lowest (2.52).

ROYCROFT RECALLED: Prior to tonight's series opener, the Cardinals recalled RHP **Chris Roycroft** from Memphis (AAA) and optioned RHP **Jacob Bosiokovic** to Memphis ... This marks Roycroft's 5th stint with St. Louis this season (three recalls and two as 27th player addition), while Bosiokovic joins C **Nick Raposo** as Cardinals to have contract selected this season, but not make their MLB debuts before being optioned.

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT!: **Brendan Donovan** has reached base safely in 17 consecutive games since June 16 (.348/.403/.545, 23-66), tying **Randy Arozarena** for MLB's 2nd-longest active on-base safely streak behind the injured **Bryce Harper** (21) ... Donovan is riding a 10-game hitting streak against Washington, MLB's T-2nd longest active against the Nationals behind **Francisco Lindor** (11).

NATIONAL NEWS: Since relocating from Montreal and re-branding as the Nationals in 2005, the Cardinals .586 win pct. (68-48) against Natitude is the 2nd-highest in MLB among annual opponents behind the Dodgers (74-41, .643) ... St. Louis has won 10 of its last 15 regular season games in D.C. to sport the 4th-best win pct at Nationals Park among annual visitors (27-24, .529).

PASS THE BISCUITS MIRANDY: **Alec "Biscuits" Burleson** has driven in 17 runs since June 22, 2nd-most RBI in MLB behind **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** (19) ... Burleson has recorded 10 game-winning RBI to tie **Shohei Ohtani** for 2nd-most in the NL (**Alec Bohm** 11), most by a Cardinal before All-Star Break since **Yadier Molina** (10 in 2021), and most by Cardinals left-handed batter since **Rick Ankiel** (10 in 2008) ... **Albert Pujols** (15 in 2006) holds the Cardinals pre-All-Star GW RBI record.

SOUTHPAWS: The Cardinals are scheduled to face left-handed starting pitchers in five consecutive games (July 4-8) for the first time since six straight from July 5-11, 2008 vs. Cubs (**Ted Lilly & Sean Marshall**) and at Philadelphia (**Cole Hamels, J.A. Happ, & Jamie Moyer**) ... St. Louis is 13-10 against southpaw starters this season - *Elias*

SOME LIKE IT HOT: According to *Baseball Reference*, the two hottest first pitch temperatures in Washington D.C. between the Cardinals and Nationals have been 94° (10-0 loss on Aug. 31, 2012 at Nationals Park) and 93° (12-1 defeat on Aug. 4, 2007 at RFK Stadium) ... The Cards hottest first pitch temp this season has been 92° on June 24 at Busch, a 4-3 win over Atlanta.

WEB GEMS: Cardinals rookie CF **Michael Siani** and Washington rookie CF **Jacob Young** share the Major League lead in runs prevented (11), while Siani leads MLB outfielders in outs above average (13) while Young ranks 2nd (12). - *Baseball Savant*

EXTRA EXTRA: The Cardinals have played extra innings on consecutive days twice this season (June 17-18 at Miami & July 3-4 at Pittsburgh) ... St. Louis last played extras over three consecutive days from May 1-3, 2015 vs. Pittsburgh (3-0 record).

HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE: 62 of the Cards 86 games (72.1%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer, tying the Brewers & Cubs for most in MLB ... St. Louis is 37-25 in those games to lead MLB in wins & ranks 2nd in win pct. (.597) to Cleveland (35-20, .636).

THIS DATE IN CARDINALS HISTORY (July 5, 1961): First baseman **Bill White** doubles and hits a career high three home runs as St. Louis routs the Dodgers, 9-1, at Los Angeles Memorial Coliseum ... 25-year-old **Bob Gibson** allowed one run in his CG.

WASHINGTON CONNECTIONS

Alec Burleson made his MLB debut vs. the Nationals (Sept. 8, 2022 at Busch).

Ildemaro Vargas was signed by St. Louis as an international free agent (June 26, 2008) and played seven seasons in the Cardinals minor league organization (2008-14).

Juan Ypez played parts of two seasons in St. Louis (2022-23)...traded to the Cardinals organization from Atlanta in exchange for Matt Adams and cash (May 20, 2017).

Nationals Quality Control Coordinator **Bill Mueller** served as assistant hitting coach and first base coach for parts for four seasons (2015-18).

Jordan Weems's father, **Rick Weems**, was drafted by St. Louis in the 15th round of 1980...was a minor league catcher in the Cards organization (1980-82).

Paul Goldschmidt was born in Wilmington, Del.

Lane Thomas played in 84 games over parts of three seasons for St. Louis (2019-21)...traded to Washington for **Jon Lester** (July 30, 2021).

Dave Martinez made his MLB debut vs. St. Louis (June 15, 1986) while with the Chicago Cubs.

Drew Millas played three seasons at Missouri State University in Springfield, Mo.

Nationals bench coach **Miguel Cairo** played parts of four seasons in St. Louis (2001-03, '07).

Jacob Barnes pitched in 13 games for St. Louis in 2023.

Bally Sports Midwest broadcaster **Alexa Datt** was born in Durwood, Md...graduated from the University of Maryland...previously worked at NBC Sports Mid-Atlantic.

Nationals Hitting Coach **Darnell Coles** played in 63 games for the Cardinals in 1995.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Vince Coleman** made his MLB debut vs. Montreal (Apr. 18, 1985 at Busch II).

Nationals broadcaster **Bob Carpenter** worked 10 seasons with the Cardinals on both radio and television before joining Washington...graduated from nearby McBride (Mo.) High School...his sister, **Judy Carpenter-Barada**, previously served as Cardinals Director of Major League Admin.

Cardinals broadcaster **Ricky Horton** played college baseball at the Univ. of Virginia (1978-80).

Nationals broadcaster **Charlie Slowes** worked three years at KMOX in St. Louis (1984-86).

Nationals Communications Manager **Daniel Kurish** was born in St. Louis.

- Makes his 16th start of the season tonight, and eighth career start against the Nationals. Is 2-0 in his two career starts at Nationals Park with the Yankees (2016) and Reds (2021).
- Retired the first 20 batters in his start vs. SF (6/23), the second longest start of his career in which he did not allow a hit (4/6/15 vs. TEX - 21 batters).
- Opened the season on the Injured List and made his first start on April 9 at Philadelphia, 12 games into the season. Since April 9, is tied for the Major League lead with nine wins and T-4th with 109 strikeouts.
- His 109 strikeouts over his first 15 starts with the Cardinals organization is the most in franchise history. Is the 9th pitcher in Cardinals history overall to record 100+ strikeouts in his first 14 starts of any season. **Bob Gibson** leads with four such seasons (1965, 1966, 1969, 1970).
- Has struck out 100 or more batters in nine seasons of his career since 2014.
- Has a 58.3% strikeout % on his Sweeper pitch (fanning 60 in 103 plate appearances), tied for MLB's 4th-highest K% of any pitch (minimum 50 plate appearances).
- Is 6-3 with a 1.90 ERA (52.0 IP) and .167 Opp. BA with two home runs allowed at Busch Stadium this year. Tied for 2nd in home wins and 3rd in opponent BA (.167) at home among MLB pitchers.
- Yielded seven home runs this season in 87.2 innings pitched after an MLB-low eight homers allowed over 184.0 innings pitched (among 2023 qualifiers).
- Recorded a decision in his first 12 starts to start his Cardinals career, 7th Cardinals pitcher in the organization since 1901 to hit the 12 mark and first since **Kip Wells** (2007).
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); Has 16 career double-digit strikeout games, two this year.
- Only **Jaime Garcia** (0.46 in 2011) had a lower Home ERA over his 1st five home starts to begin a season at Busch Stadium III than Gray (0.93). Garcia had 0.81 ERA through his 1st six home starts

LAST TIME OUT

- Had his shortest start as a member of the Cardinals organization with 4.1 innings while tossing 92 pitches. Allowed a season-high six runs (3 ER) on seven hits with eight strikeouts. Departed trailing 3-1 before the Reds completed a six-run 5th inning en route to an 9-4 win.

- Selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- Ranks 12th among active pitchers with 107 career wins. Is joined by teammates **Lance Lynn** (139, 6th) and **Kyle Gibson** (109, 10th) in the top-20.
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn** & **Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season. Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).
- His 3.45 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,612 strikeouts rank 16th.
