RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and Washington Nationals play the third game of a four-game wraparound weekend series today at Nationals Park as the Redbirds continue their seven-game road trip through Pittsburgh (2-1) and the Nation's Capital (1-1) ... St. Louis and Washington combined for 20 runs scored in yesterday's 14-6 loss for the Cardinals highest combined output in a game this season.

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in 2nd place in the National League Central, 5.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 3rd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis owns MLB's 3rd-best record (31-18, .633).

WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE: St. Louis (-44, 46-42) is the only Major League team with winning record and negative run differential, while Cincinnati is the lone MLB with a losing record and positive run differential (+18, 42-47) ... St. Louis sports MLB's lowest average margin of victory (2.32), with Tampa Bay ranking 2nd-lowest (2.52).

SUNDAY FUNDAY: The Cardinals have won six straight Sunday games since May 26 (vs. Cubs, at Phillies, vs. Rockies, at Cubs, vs. Giants, vs. Reds), matching Minnesota (6-1) over that timespan ... St. Louis boasts a league-leading 1.31 ERA in their last six Sunday wins.

LOOKS LIKE I PICKED THE WRONG WEEK TO QUIT...: Sixty-three of the Cardinals 88 games (72.4%) have been decided by 3 runs or fewer, 2nd in MLB to the Brewers (64) ... St. Louis is 38-25 in those games to lead MLB in wins & ranks 2nd in win pct. (.603) to Cleveland (36-21, .632) ... The Cardinals have won eight of their last 11 one-run games (June 13-present).

SOUTHPAWS: St. Louis is scheduled to face left-handed starting pitch-

ers in five consecutive games from July 3-7 (Martín Pérez, Patrick Corbin, MacKenzie Gore, DJ Herz, and Mitchell Parker) for the first time since six straight from July 5-11, 2008 vs. Cubs (Ted Lilly & Sean Marshall), at Philadelphia (Cole Hamels, J.A. Happ, & Jamie Moyer), and at Pittsburgh (Zach Duke). ... St. Louis is 14-11 in games against southpaw starters this

WEB GEMS: Cardinals rookie CF **Michael Siani** and Washington rookie CF **Jacob Young** share the Major League lead in runs prevented (11), while Siani leads MLB outfielders in outs above average (13) and Young ranks 2nd (12) ... Siani also boasts a .979 zone rating in center field, which currently is MLB's single-season highest among outfielders since 1987.

SOME LIKE IT HOT: According to *Baseball Reference*, yesterday's 97° first pitch temp. was the hottest on record for a Cardinals-Nationals game in Washington D.C (2005-present) and tied for MLB's 2nd-hottest game this season behind 100° on June 24 between the Royals & Marlins in Kansas City ... The Cardinals played MLB's hottest game last season (July 27), hosting the Cubs & losing 10-3 in a game that was 99° at first pitch (**Miles Mikolas** ejected after 14 pitches for hitting **Ian Happ**).

HEL'S BELLS: Reigning NL Reliever of the Month Ryan Helsley nailed down a Cardinals record 31 straight save opportunities from April 1-July 2, MLB's longest save streak since Milwaukee's Josh Hader (32 straight from July 18, 2021-June 5, 2022) ... Helsley has converted a team-record 31 saves prior to All-Star break, T-8th most in MLB single-season history before the break and most since Seattle's Edwin Diaz (36 in 2018).

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT!: Brendan Donovan has reached base safely in 19 consecutive games since June 16 (.333/.390/.507, 25-75, 6 BB, 1 HBP), tying **Randy Arozarena** for MLB's 2nd-longest active on-base safely streak behind the injured **Bryce Harper** (21).

PASS THE BISCUITS MIRANDY: Alec "Biscuits" Burleson has driven in 17 runs since June 22, 2nd-most RBI in MLB behind Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (21) ... Overall this season, Burly is tied with Shohei Ohtani for the NL's 2nd-most game-winning RBI (10) behind Alec Bohm (11), which is most by any Cardinal before the All-Star Break since Yadier Molina (10 in 2021), and most by Cardinals left-handed batter since Rick Ankiel (10 in 2008) ... Albert Pujols (15 in 2006) holds the Cardinals pre-All-Star GW RBI record.

Nationals bench coach Miguel Cairo played parts of four seasons in St. Louis (2001-03, '07).

Jacob Barnes pitched in 13 games for St. Louis in 2023.

- Held his opposition to two earned runs or fewer in 9-of-15 starts, 2nd behind Sonny Gray (10) for the most by a Cardinal.
- Logged 6.0+ innings pitched in each of his first seven starts to begin the season (April
 1-May 6), longest by a Cardinal to begin a season since 2017 (Mike Leake 11 & Michael Wacha 7). Streak was snapped in his 5/22 start vs. BAL (4.0 IP).
- Posted career-highs for innings pitched (38.0) and strikeouts (29) in the month of April.
 Tied his most starts with six (also 2021 w/TEX). The 38.0 innings were the 3rd-most for Gibson in any calendar month, most recently tossing 39.1 with the Twins in 2018.
- St. Louis area resident and University of Missouri Baseball alum signed with the Cardinals as a free agent last November. Is one of three free-agent starters (Sonny Gray & Lance Lynn) that the Cardinals signed last off-season.
- Pitching for his fifth Major League team: Twins (2013-19), Rangers (2020-21), Phillies (2021-22), Orioles (2023) and Cardinals (2024).
