RECENT REDBIRDS: The St. Louis Cardinals and division-rival Pirates play the second game of a three-game series tonight at PNC Park as the Cardinals continue their seven-game road trip through Pittsburgh (1-0) and Washington D.C. (4G) ... Last night's win moved St. Louis to 4.0 games above .500 for the first time since the final day of the 2022 regular season (93-69 record).

FLIGHT PATTERN: The Cardinals enter today in second place in the National League Central, 6.0 games behind first place Milwaukee, and in the 2nd position in the NL Wild Card race ... Since Mother's Day (May 12), St. Louis (29-16, .644) co-leads MLB with Cleveland (29-14) in wins and trails only the Guardians in win pct. (.674).

RRRRRRRRRR YOU FREE JULY 4TH?: The Cardinals and Pirates face off on July 4 for the first time since 2016, while St. Louis celebrates Independence Day in Pittsburgh for the first time since 1996 at Three Rivers Stadium, coinciding with **Tony La Russa**'s first season with St. Louis and **Jim Leyland**'s final with the Pirates.

HEL'S BELLS: Closer **Ryan Helsley** was voted National League Reliever of the month of June today, his 2nd career award (March/April 2024) ... Helsley is the first multi-winner in Cardinals history following **Ryan Franklin** (August 2009) and **Jason Isringhausen** (May 2006). Helsley has:

- Converted all of his MLB-leading 12 saves in June, T-2nd most by a Cardinal in any month behind Lee Smith's 15 saves in June 1993.
- Nailed down a Cardinals record 31 consecutive save opportunities since April 1, MLB's longest active save streak since Milwaukee Josh Hader (32 straight from July 18, 2021 to June 5, 2022).
- Recorded a team-record 31 saves prior to All-Star break, T-8th in MLB single-season history & most since Seattle's Edwin Diaz (36 in 2018).

BIG BOOTY BOUNTY: Last night's grand slam by **Nolan Gorman** was the 6th hit by the Cardinals in PNC Park history (2001-present), surpassing the Cubs & Brewers for most by a visiting team ... St. Louis also leads visiting teams with 203 homers here (195 games), including 34 by **Albert Pujols** (35 career HR are most by a visiting player). #JimmyTGone

AHOY MATEY: St. Louis leads visiting teams with 113 wins all-time at PNC Park (2001-present), while their .579 win pct. ranks 3rd among annual Steel City visitors behind the Dodgers (.600) and Padres (.592).

DONNY, YOU'RE OUT OF YOUR ELEMENT!: Among those with 100+ career AB vs. Pittsburgh, **Brendan Donovan's** lifetime .356 batting average vs. the Buccos (26-101) is 12th all-time & 3rd among Cardinals to **Peanuts Lowrey** (.361) & **Albert Pujols** (.360).

- Donovan has reached base safely in 15 consecutive games since June 16 (.379/.429/.586, 22-58), tied for MLB's 4th-longest active on-base safely streak.
- Since June 5, Donny ranks 4th in the NL in batting .347 (33-95) & shares the NL lead in hits (33) w/ Christian Yelich & CJ Abrams.

HIGH BLOOD PRESSURE: Sixty of the Cardinals 85 games (70.6%) this season have been decided by three runs or fewer, tied with the Brewers for 2nd-most in Major League Baseball behind the Cubs (61).

- St. Louis is 36-24 (.600) in those games to lead MLB in wins and rank 2nd in win pct. (.600) to Cleveland (35-20, .636).
- The Cardinals sport MLB's lowest average margin of victory (2.39), with Tampa Bay ranking 2nd (2.54).

BO KNOWS?: When reliever **Jacob Bosiokovic** (age 30-195) makes his MLB debut, he will become the oldest North American-born Cards pitcher to make an MLB debut since LHP **Kevin Ohme** (age 32-001) on April 14, 2003 at Milwaukee ... RHP **Stoney McGlynn** (age 34-117) holds the franchise record for oldest MLB debut as a Cardinals pitcher (Sept. 20, 2006 at Philly) ... RHP **Albert Pujols** (age 42-119) is the oldest in franchise history to make his pitching debut (May 15, 2022 vs. Giants).

- The Cardinals' Opening Day starter for 2024 makes his team-leading 18th start of the season and his 168th career (196th appearance).
- Has faced the Pirates more than any other team in Major League Baseball, making his 23rd appearance and 19th start.
- Threw a season-high 7.0 scoreless IP for a no decision vs. PIT (6/11) opposite rookie Paul Skenes as the Cardinals lost 2-1. Retired the first 17 batters and did not allow a hit until Brian Reynolds led off the 7th inning with a tripled off the centerfield wall.
- Is 3-2 with a 4.44 ERA over his last eight starts (5/18-present) with a 1.01 WHIP; was 3-4 with a 5.77 ERA with a 1.42 WHIP in his first nine starts (3/28-5/12).
- Since May 18, ranks 10th among Naitonal League pitchers with a 1.01 WHIP.
- Five of six five wins this season have come on the road. Since joining St. Louis in 2018, has a winning record on the road (32-28) and losing mark at Busch Stadium (24-26).
- Has thrown over 100 pitches in only one of his 17 starts (101 on May 1 at Detroit).
- In his 157 starts as a member of the Cardinals, St. Louis is 64-32 when Miles throws 6.0 or more innings (6-4 this season), while the Cardinals are 23-38 when he works 5.2 innings or fewer.
- Mikolas is an amazing 47-5 (.902 win pct) as a Cardinal when receiving 3 or more runs in support (Cardinals 62-14 in those 76 games). He's just 9-49 (.155) when receiving 2 runs or fewer (Cardinals 25-56).
- His loss vs. Milwaukee (April 20, 2024) was his first ever as a Cardinal when receiving 4+ runs of support in 70 such starts dating to 2018.
- Made his 77th career start at Busch Stadium III on June 27, passing Michael Wacha
 and tying Jaime Garcia for 4th in stadium history. Kyle Lohse is 3rd with 78.
- Hasn't committed an error since August 2, 2018 vs. COL. Is the only MLB pitcher with 100+ total chances and zero errors since Aug 3, 2018. Ranks 5th among Major League pitchers in fielding pct. (.989) since 2018.
