3. PROBLEMS OF 21ST CENTURY ARE PROBLEMS WITHOUT PASSPORT

In March 2023, failure of Silicon Valley Bank (SVB) and Signature Bank of USA once again shook the economic stability of world. They considered to be of comparable extent to 2008 Financial Crisis. Although the banks failed due to strict monetary tightening by Federal Reserve of America, it affected the banking and startup ecosystem of India as well.

Spillover effect was seen in Sweden where Credit Swiss went bankrupt and countries such

as Japan and Singapore experienced ~~the~~ ripples in their economy. Present century problems are transboundary in nature. They defy the natural and geographical boundaries.

This is seen in the majority of 21st century problems that they are without the passport. Before we delve into further analysis of 21st century problems, first understand how the nature of problems has evolved and what are different factors contributing to same.

EVOLUTION OF PROBLEMS: LOCAL TO GLOBAL

21st century has seen major transformation compared to earlier world. Technology has become major driver of current century. It has integrated the whole world into a world wide web.

Globalization has binded the nations in a common thread. In contrast,

earlier economies were isolated, closed and protected in their own boundaries.

Apart, from this, 21st Century is facing some new threats that were not present earlier. And these problems by nature know no boundary. Challenge of climate change, challenge of climate induced disasters and are beyond the political boundary of a nation.

Further, the capability, capacity and scale at which the transactions are happening across the world also have amplified the issues of the present times. World trade ~~volume~~^{values} today have ballooned by almost 400 times from 1950 levels as per estimates by World Trade Organization (WTO). This increased magnitude naturally makes any issue proportionally bigger. and makes its effects felt across the globe in all dimensions.

Domain one: Shock winds in Economy

Economical blurring of boundary is most significant manifestation of passport less problem. Effect of monetary tightening by central banks of different countries during lockdown was witnessed by every nation. Similarly global supply chain has its global consequence.

Presently no one nation is producing everything. Thus disruption in one nation, affect every other economy.

As seen from the semiconductor crisis, faced in aftermath of Russia-Ukraine war. Further, the challenge of debt crisis is looming all over world economy. Many small economies are getting succumbed to it. Failure of nations to pay back their debt create a chain reaction.

Further, depletion of non renewable resources such as crude, natural gas is becoming a existential challenge for the whole world. They directly affect the nations where they are present and are main source of economy, But their direct impact is seen on dependent nations. Economic problems are global in nature.

Domain 2: Environment and geographical challenge

Recently COP 27 of United nation environment conference concluded, the forum is testament of common challenge of global warming faced by world collectively. Island nation 'Tuvalu' in western Pacific is at ~~ex~~ tipping point of subsidence.

Although, pollution and emissions, were historically contributed the most by developed, western nations but in climate vulnerability index, nations from Africa, Asia are at the top. This reflect

Challenge of river pollution is beyond geographical boundaries.

on same line, climate change has accentuated challenge faced due to droughts, floods, cyclones and tsunamis. These 21st

century problems required collective and holistic approach to deal with them.

Moving ahead let us look into issues in political governance and how it has a global effect.

Domain 3: Political and Governance challenge

Geopolitical interconnectedness has taken political stability of nation to a global level. Tension in one nation has consequences in different part of nations as well.

For example, India has around 18 million strong diaspora scattered across the globe. As much as they take influence of local problems global, they also influence local system. Instability in one nation such as Myanmar coup or Russia-Ukraine war have become a global problem. Negative consequences are extending beyond their geographical extent. Similarly,
