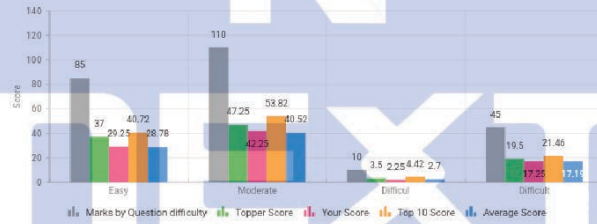

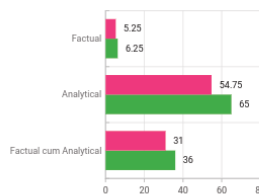

Marks by question type



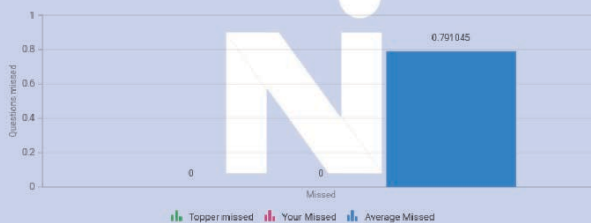
