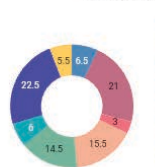

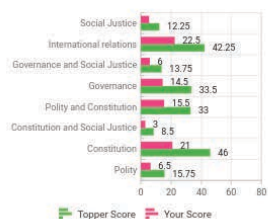

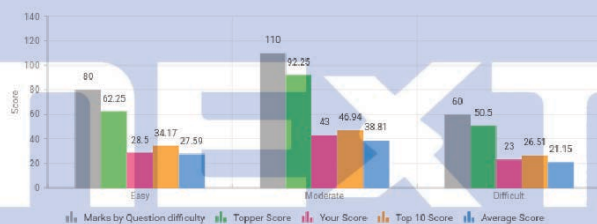

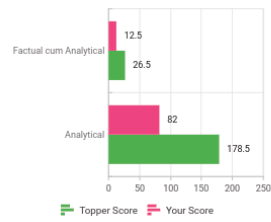
My performance based on question difficulty

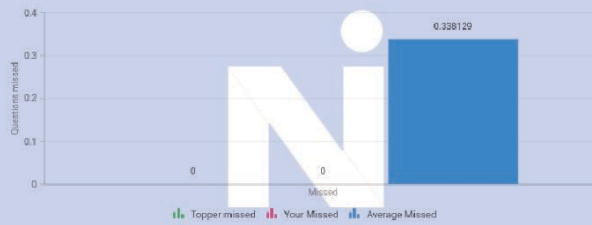
