32 Operational Purchases and Sales of Gas

- (a) Transporter may purchase and/or sell gas at locations on Transporter's system for operational purposes. Transporter may purchase and/or sell gas to the extent necessary to:
 - (i) manage imbalance quantities pursuant to Part 1 §§ 12.3, 12.6, 12.11, and 12.12 of General Terms and Conditions;
 - (ii) maintain system pressure and line pack;
 - (iii) perform other operational functions of Transporter in connection with transportation, storage, and other similar services; and
 - (iv) otherwise protect the operational integrity of its system.
- (b) (i) Transporter shall announce its intention to purchase or sell gas via a Non-critical Notice on the Informational Postings section of Transporter's website. Included in such posting shall be:
 - (1) the quantities of gas to be purchased and/or sold;
 - (2) the effective date and term of the purchase and/or sale;
 - (3) location of sale or purchase; and
 - (4) any additional terms or information as may be required by Transporter;
 - (ii) Prospective bidders shall submit a written bid via email to an email address provided in the Non-critical Notice, with such bid(s) containing the following information:
 - (1) bidder's legal name and the name, title, address, and phone number of individual authorized to purchase gas;
 - (2) bidder's price;
 - (3) any conditions on the prospective bidder's offer to sell and/or purchase gas; and
 - (4) the bid proposal must address all criteria listed in Transporter's posting.
 - (iii) Transporter shall determine, in its sole discretion, the best offer(s) based on the posted criteria in Section 12.8(b)(i) herein.
 - (iv) Transporter reserves its right, in its sole discretion to:
 - (1) withdraw its postings;
 - (2) reject all bids; and
 - (3) reject any bids which are not complete, which contain modifications to the terms of the posting, or which contain terms that are operationally unacceptable.
 - (v) Any operational purchases and/or sales will be made on an unbundled basis and a separate transportation service agreement shall be required to deliver gas to or receive gas from the respective location of purchase or location of sale.

(c) By March 1 of each year, Transporter will file a report with the Commission describing purchase and sales transactions conducted pursuant to this section in the preceding calendar year, if the preceding calendar year had such purchases and/or sales. The report will include the source of the operational gas purchased or sold, the date of such purchases/sales, volumes, the purchase/sale price, the costs and revenues from such purchases/sales and the disposition of the associated costs and revenues for all types of operational purchases and sales.
