- Survey Modes: SMS/Text to Web
- Sample Size: n991 statewide; CD1 n211, CD2 n249, CD3 n297, CD4 n234
- Marginal Error Rate: $\pm 3\%$ statewide; $\pm 6\%$ in CD2, CD3, CD4; $\pm 7\%$ CD1; Confidence Level 95%
- Survey Dates: Saturday 8/3 - Monday 8/5
- Post-stratified on Age, Gender, Race, Party, Congressional District, and Media Market, with General Election turnout weights applied to balance these factors. Due to weighting and rounded calculations, not all responses may total exactly n991.
