

### Frame 3. Business Rule Pattern: Execution Condition

<b>Name</b>	Execution Condition
<b>Domain</b>	Information Systems
<b>Purpose</b>	Establish the conditions allowed for a certain operation.
<b>Problem</b>	Stipulate the specific conditions of the operation.
<b>Consequence</b>	The specification of a requirement that describes a business rule which establishes the conditions of execution of a particular operation.
<b>Type</b>	Business Rule
<b>Solution</b>	<p><b>Template:</b> The &lt;operation&gt; should only be allowed if &lt;condition&gt;.</p> <p><b>Parameter:</b> &lt;operation&gt; name of the operation you wish to establish a condition for (1). &lt;condition&gt; description of the condition for execution of the operation (1..*).</p> <p><b>Parameter Examples:</b> &lt;operation&gt; reservation. &lt;condition&gt; there is enough stock, if there are enough places to meet it.</p> <p><b>Examples of Requirements Description:</b> - The reservation should only be allowed if there are enough vacancies to meet it.</p>
