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the last year under the auspices of the general editor of the journal. The publication followed very similar patterns to the study of amphorae contents (both known, or still to be identified), papers published in early 2013, mentioned above, and the most explicit concerning paleocontents analysis, which discussed various production areas and typological characteristics of the amphorae. In numerous characteristics and conclusions, it was stressed the importance of the amphorae that had been rich in methodological innovation, such as the use of archaeometry, which can identify the presence of organic residues, and the use of the so-called turned section. Although the results were not always shared by all the authors, they were generally accepted.

At the end of the conference, the general editor of the journal, Ignazio Sanna, organized a round-table discussion, in which the main topics of the conference were discussed, difficulties and problems were evaluated, new research perspectives were discussed, and recommendations for the future discussed. The discussion was focused on the areas in which more research is needed, at the end of the event, in the field of amphorae studies, conferences, and in order to continue the exchange and debate, other publications will be discussed in the coming years.
