THE THIRTEEN ESSAYS in this volume consist primarily of revised papers that were originally read at the Ancient Historiography Seminar of the Canadian Society of Biblical Studies, and they investigate challenging texts of Chronicles, examine central themes, and consider enticing future prospects for Chronicles study.

The volume includes chapters by scholars Shannon E. Baines, Ehud Ben Zvi, Mark J. Boda, Keith Bodner, Paul S. Evans, Louis Jonker, Gary N. Knoppers, Christine Mitchell, Peter J. Sabo, Steven J. Schweitzer, and John W. Wright.

The essays represent various perspectives, methodologies, and conclusions regarding the Chronicler's work, and this volume is an essential read for scholars and students of Chronicles as well as thought-provoking for all who study ancient Israelite historiography and biblical literature in general.
