Endorsement of JoburgpediA Pilot

Further to our meeting on the 5th of February 2013, we confirm that the Johannesburg Heritage Foundation endorses the concept of "JoburgpediA", a project that aims to improve coverage of City of Johannesburg heritage sites through the use of QR codes.

We will permit Wikimedia South Africa to produce QR code images that can be included in JHF blue plaques, including text of "JoburgpediA". The QR codes will allow visitors to scan them with Smartphones, and read further about the sites on Wikipedia, as a local arm of the global QRPedia project. The inclusion of QRcodes is subject to consultation and approval by the JHF. Costs for the addition of QR code into plaques to be borne by Wikimedia South Africa.

The Johannesburg Heritage Foundation undertakes to provide basic data including, but not limited to, low resolution images and site information of non sensitive nature, for use in creating and supplementing Wikipedia article pages about sites which are being recognised as of heritage significance by means of a blue plaque.
