

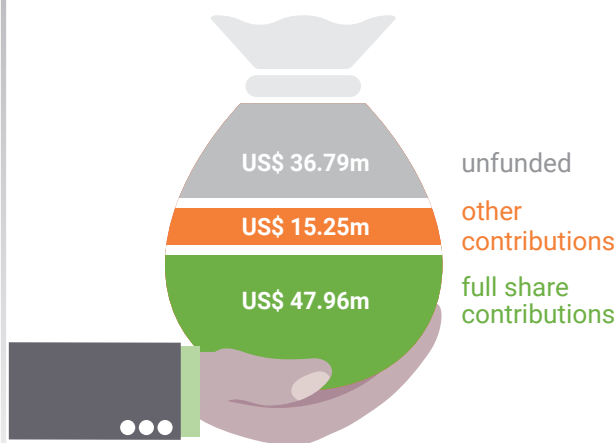

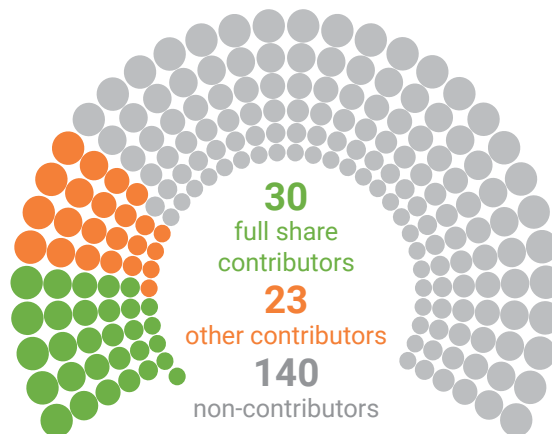

The Environment Fund provides for the science work on the state of global environment, including through publications like, **UN-REDD's, Raising Ambition, Accelerating Action: Towards Enhanced NDCs for Forests**. It highlights a significant gap in forest protection within current **Nationally Determined Contributions, (NDCs)**, which outline plans to mitigate and adapt to climate change. This report reveals that NDC pledges from 2017-2023 fall short of the global goal to halt and reverse deforestation by 2030.
