### NORTH CAROLINA STATE CONSTITUTION

We, the people of the State of North Carolina, granful to Almighty God, the Sovereign Rake of Notions, for the preservation of the American Union and the existence of our civil, publical and fullgrown before, and acknowledging our dependence upon Him for the continuance of them blessings to us and our posterity, do, for the sone cortain security thereof and for the better government of this Soties, coding and establish this Continuition.

## DECLARATION OF RIGHTS

That the great, general, and essential principles of liberty and five government may be ecosphised and established, and that the relations of this State to the Union and government of the Union States and those of the people of this State to the rest of the American people may be defined and affirmed, we do declare that:

Section 1. The equality and rights of persons.

We hold it to be self-reduced that all persons are created equal, that they are endersoid by their Creater with certain indivasible rights; that among those are life, liberty, the enjoyment of the frain of their own labor, and the parents of happens.

Sec. 2. Severalizaty of the people.

All political power is vented in and derived from the people; all government of right originates from the people, in founded upon their will only, and in instituted which for the good of the whole.

Sec. A. Beternal government of the State.

The people of the State have the inhomot, sole, and exclusive right of regulating the intensal government and polecy thereof, and of altering or abolishing their Constitution and from of prevenues whenever it may be securacy to their refer and hoppiness; but every such right staff the exercised in prevance of the and consistently with the Constitution of the United States.

See, 4. Socrosion probibilists.

This State shalf ever results a member of the American Union, the people thereof are part of the American states, then it is only the one of this State to secretic, and all attention, from whatever source or upon whatever protest, to disactive this Union or to server this Nation, shall be emissed with the whole power of the State.

Every citizen of this State overs paramount allegizates to the Constitution and government of the United States, and no law or ordinance of the State in contravention or indocussion thereof can have any binding force.

Sec. 6. Separation of powers.

The legislative, executive, and supreme judicial powers of the State government shall be forever aparatus and distinct flows each other.

Sec. 7. Suspending laws,
All power of suspending laws or the execution of laws by any patherity, without the consent
of the representations of the people, is injurious to their rights and shall not be exercised.
