Cell Phone Policy



The Florida Department of Education (FLDOE) Statute 1006.07 (2)(f) has deemed cell phone use inappropriate during instructional time.



During Class: The personal use of cell phones during class is prohibited to minimize distractions and maintain focus on learning. Students are required to keep their phones turned off or on silent and stored away in the phone organizer provided by the teacher for the entire class period.



Instructional Use: Students may use their phones for instructional purposes, such as accessing educational apps or using them as calculators or research tools when guided by the teacher.



Designated Time and Place: Students are allowed to use their phones during lunch breaks, before and after school. No phones in the bathroom or hallway during class time.

Cell Phones

- All cell phones should be placed in the hanging pocket pouch upon entering the classroom.
- 1) Verbal Warning: encourage student to place the phone in the appropriate area.
 - 2) Student-teacher conference and parent contact (phone communication or email).
 - 3) Referral to the Dean

1. Attendance Rules: 5/10/15 Day absences

- 1 Tardy = Warning from teacher
- 2 Tardy = Warning from teacher
- 3 Tardy = referral, conference with dean
- 4th and 5th tardy= Referral, Lunch Detention
- 6th Tardy=Period of ISS
- 7th Tardy= Period of ISS
- 8th Tardy=ISS 1 Day
- 9th Tardy ISS 1 Day, 10 days loss of driving
- 10th Tardy ISS 2 Day/Loss of Privileges

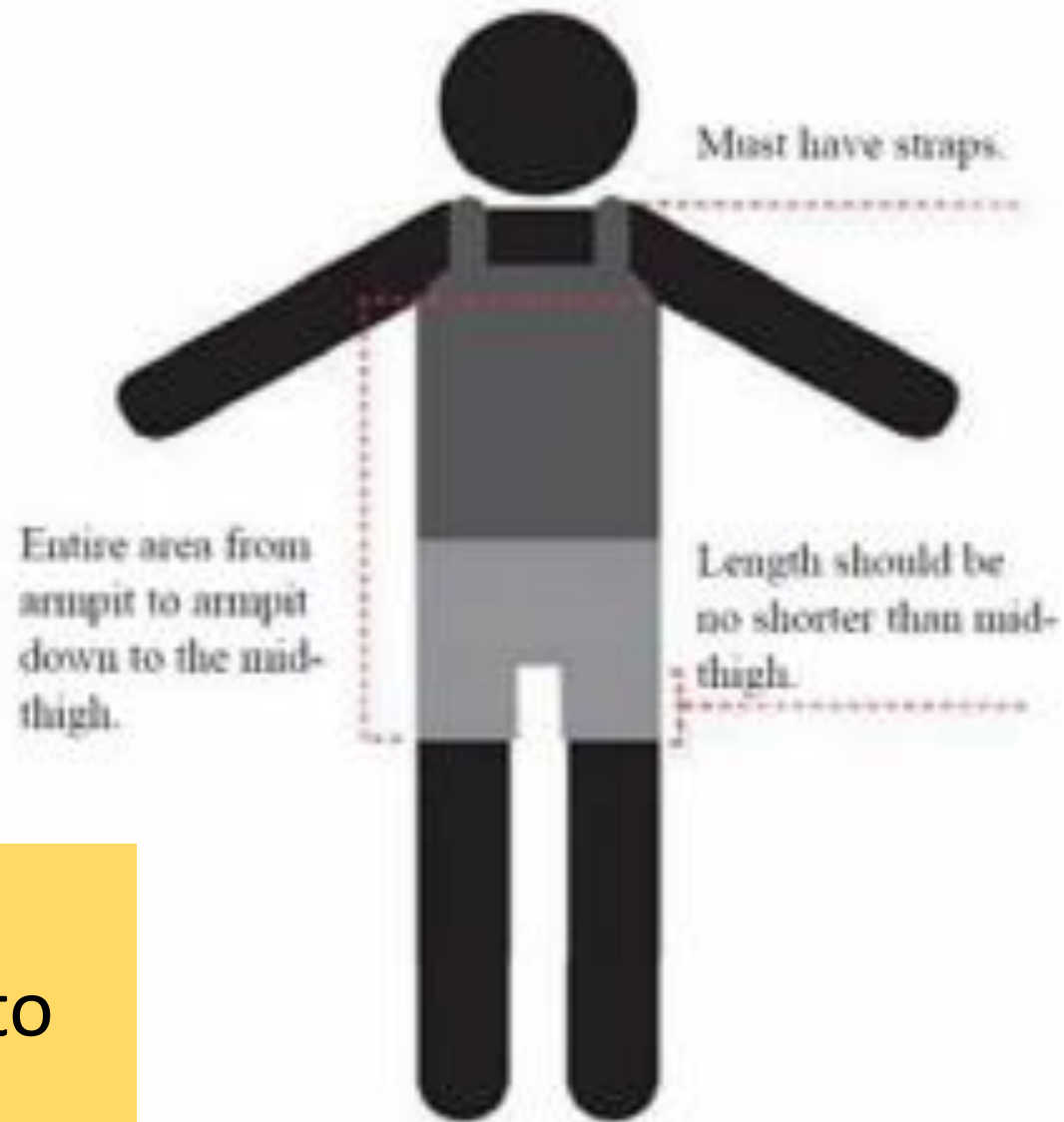
15 or more Absences or Level 3 or Level 4

By accessing FortifyFL, students can provide a description of the threat, share pics and videos and optionally submit their contact information.

Anonymous or Non-Anonymous

You decide whether you want to include your name and contact information.

Submitting a tip is quick and easy using our mobile app or website.

Include Photos and Video

You can also include photos or video with your tip report.

QUICKLY SEND TO AUTHORITIES

FortifyFL automatically routes your tip report to the appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials.



Your School Officials

The tip report goes to your local school officials when submitted.

Local Law Enforcement

Your local police department or sheriff office receive copies of your tips automatically.

State-Level Officials

State-level officials also have access to your tips to make sure proper steps are taken.

FortifyFL is a suspicious activity reporting tool that allows you to instantly relay information to appropriate law enforcement agencies and school officials. FortifyFL was created and funded by the 2018 Florida Legislature as part of the Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School Public Safety Act.

Learning Objective: What to report on FortifyFL. How to make a report on FortifyFL. Penalty for making false reports on FortifyFL.

If you see something say something. With FortifyFL you can submit tips about potential crimes or threats which are sent directly to law enforcement and designated school personnel (principal, deans, APs, and YRDs).

- How:

- You can submit a tip from any computer at your school.
- You can submit a tip via your phone or tablet.

- Download App

- Go to Get FortifyFL.com
- Download FortifyFL on an Android or Apple by going to the App Store or Google Play

- **What Information to provide in the tip:**

- Tip must have actionable information.
- Actionable information means who did what, where is it going to take place (location).
- The more details given improve the chances the tip can be investigated and resolved.

FAKE TIPS WILL BE INVESTIGATED BY LAW ENFORCEMENT AND COULD HAVE SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES.

FortifyFL is to be used for serious tips only. Florida Statute 943.082 states that if, following an investigation, it is determined that a person knowingly submitted a false tip through FortifyFL, the IP address of the device on which the tip was submitted will be provided to law enforcement agencies for further investigation, and the reporting party may be subject to criminal penalties under F.S. 837.05. In all other circumstances, unless the reporting party has chosen to disclose his or her identity, the report will remain anonymous.
