Report Highlights

Arizona Empowerment Scholarship Account Program Fiscal Year 2024—Quarter 3 Report to Executive and Legislative Leadership

Key points:

- **Three-quarters of ESA students participate under universal eligibility**—74,996 students received an Empowerment Scholarship in Quarter 3 and were eligible in 1 of 11 eligibility categories.
 - 75 percent participated under *universal* eligibility
 - Nearly 18 percent were *students with a disability*, which is higher than the almost 14 percent in district public and charter schools
 - Slightly more than 7 percent participated in 1 of the other 9 eligibility categories
- **Increasing number of students are coming from public schools immediately prior to ESA participation**—In Quarter 3, 61.5 percent of ESA students in grades 1-12 attended public school immediately prior to enrolling in the ESA program this year. This is more than a 40 percentage-point increase over the number of ESA students in grades 1-12 who attended public school immediately prior to enrolling in the ESA program last year, in fiscal year 2023.
- **Majority of ESA students with a disability have autism**—In Quarter 3, over 6,700, or nearly 51 percent, of the 13,216 ESA students with a disability have an autism diagnosis.
- **Majority of ESA scholarships are between \$7,000 and \$8,000**—Nearly 53 percent of the 74,996 ESA students on the program in Quarter 3 had annual scholarships between \$7,000 and \$8,000.
- **The total annual scholarship awards for students enrolled in Quarter 3 was \$736,351,926.**
- **Nearly half a million items and services purchased by ESA families were processed by the ESA program in Quarter 3.**

Introduction

In accordance with Title 15, Chapter 19, Article 1 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, the Arizona Department of Education and the Empowerment Scholarship Account (ESA) program present this quarterly report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Director of the Joint Legislative Budget Committee, and the Director of the Governor's Office of Strategic Planning and Budgeting. This report reflects data and information from Quarter 3 of fiscal year 2024, covering January 1, 2024 to March 31, 2024. As stipulated in Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §15-2406, this report includes the following:

1. The number of qualified students disaggregated by:

(a) Eligibility category

(b) For qualified students who are eligible pursuant to section 15-2401.01, the number of qualified students who attended a public school in this state in the school year immediately preceding the first year of each qualified student's enrollment in the Arizona empowerment scholarship account program

³ Table 4 captures the school districts and charter schools that students attended immediately prior to enrolling in the ESA program. However, this information is only reported from fiscal year 2017 through fiscal year 2024—Quarter 3. It does not cover the period from fiscal years 2011 through 2016, when the ESA program was first implemented. In fiscal year 2017, the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) implemented a new student information system (SIS). Because of the risks of relying on student level data from 8 fiscal years earlier that were migrated from another SIS, we chose only to report on data beginning in fiscal year 2017 for the purposes of this report.

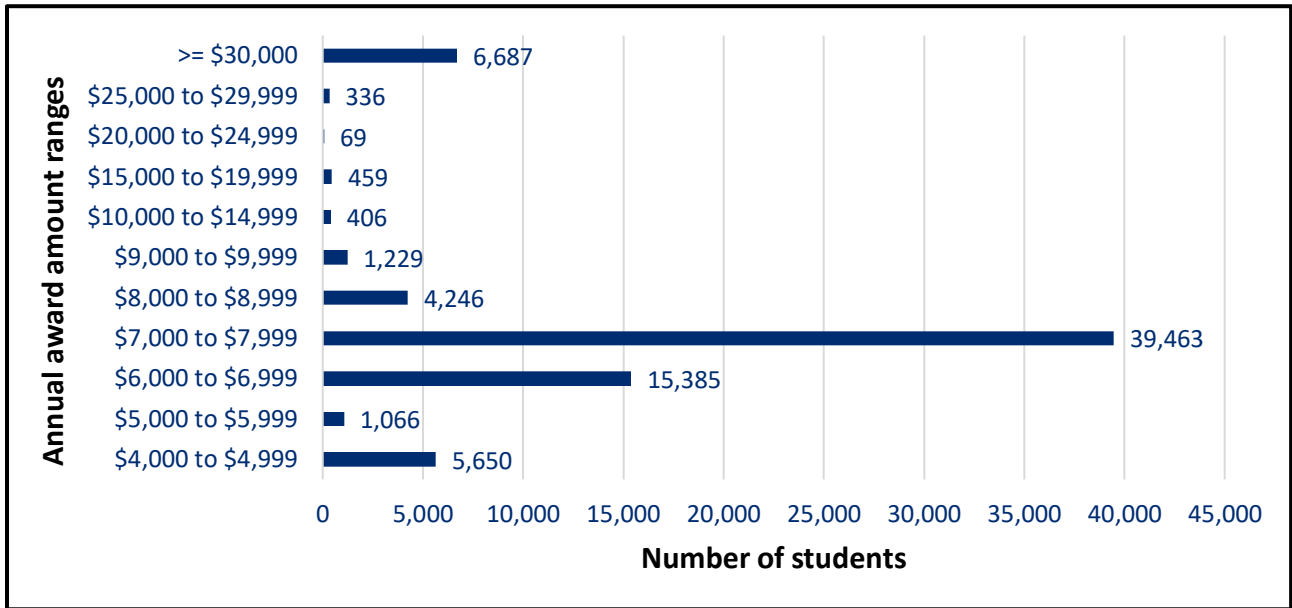

When ESA Holders spend their ESA funds through these 3 options, ClassWallet currently only captures data on an order level. For this reason, Marketplace spending, which can be captured on an item level, is separated from spending through the other options.
