THREE OUT-OF-CONTROL FIRE.
8 FIRES YESTERDAY.
DO NOT BURN.

>> Anne-Marie: FRUSTRATION OVER
HUMAN CAUSED FIRES IN NOVA
SCOTIA WITH THE PREMIER
ANNOUNCING A BAN ON ALL
ACTIVITIES IN THE PROVINCE'S
FORESTS.

>> IT IS JUST A TREMENDOUS,
TREMENDOUS OUTPOURING OF
EVERYONE LOOKING AFTER
EVERYBODY ELSE.

>> Anne-Marie: AS PEOPLE FORCED
OUT BY WILDFIRES IN NEW
BRUNSWICK ARE STARTING TO HEAD
HOME, THERE ARE NEW FIRE
CONCERNS IN ALBERTA AND
NORTHERN ONTARIO.

>> I THINK WE CAN WORK
COLLABORATIVELY.

>> DANIELLE SMITH WANTS A RESET
WITH THE PRIME MINISTER AS A

>> IT IS HOT, DRY AND THAT IS
PART OF THE STORY.

WE KNOW IN NOVA SCOTIA, IT HAS
BEEN, A NEW WILDFIRES IN THE
COMMUNITY OF BEDFORD ON THE
OUTSKIRTS OF HALIFAX, FORCED
RESIDENT TO STAY ON STANDBY.
THEY NEED TO BE ABLE TO LEAVE AT
SHORT NOTICE.

FOR THOUSANDS THEY ARE NOT SURE
THEY HAVE A HOME TO GO BACK TO.
WE KNOW 150 HOMES BURNT TO THE

GROUND IN SUNDAY'S SURPRISE
WILDFIRE OUTSIDE OF HALIFAX.

>> IT'S A SAD TIME BUT WE ARE
OK.

>> Anne-Marie: MOLLY FLED WITH
HER SON AFTER SEEING SMOKE JUST
BEHIND THEIR HOUSE.

THE SAID SHE HAD A FEELING HER
HOME MIGHT NOT BE THERE AND
SADLY SHE WAS RIGHT.

THE MUNICIPALITY SAID 50 OTHER
STRUCTURES ARE GONE.

MANY OTHER HOMES HAVE BEEN
DAMAGED.

FOR LATEST, WE WILL BRING IN
SALTWIRE'S KATE WALKER WHO IS IN
TANTALLON THIS MORNING.

KATE, I WANT TO START WITH THE
MESSAGE FROM THE PREMIER, WHICH
IS THE BAN OF ALL RECREATIONAL
ACTIVITIES IN FORESTS THROUGHOUT
THE PROVINCE.

>> YEAH, GOOD MORNING.

WE SAW A VERY ANGRY PREMIER
HOUSTON YESTERDAY AT THE UPDATE
IN THE AFTERNOON.

SAYING THAT ABSOLUTELY NO
ACTIVITY IS ALLOWED IN FORESTS
RIGHT NOW.

THEY ARE CLOSING PARKS.

NO ONE IS ALLOWED IN THE WOODS.
ACTIVITIES LIKE CAMPING,
FISHING.

WE HEARD THAT SIX ILLEGAL FIRES
WERE REPORTED AFTER THE FIRE
BAN.

SO THE PREMIER IS FRUSTRATED
THAT PEOPLE CONTINUE TO BURN
EVEN WHEN WE ARE IN A STATE OF
MERGE LIKE WE ARE.

>> Anne-Marie: TALK ABOUT THE
STATE OF EMERGENCY.

CAN YOU UPDATE US ON THE
SITUATION IN BEDFORD.

THE COMMUNITY IS JUST ON THE
OUTSKIRTS OF HALIFAX.

>> THAT'S RIGHT YOU WERE PIT
FELT LIKE THE EMERGENCY ALERTS
KEPT ROLLING IN.

THE FIRE CREWS ARE STILL
DARKLING THE FIRE IN TANTALLON,
HOWEVER THERE WAS A NEW FIRE IN
BEDFORD, SO THE EVACUATION ORDER
WAS SENT OUT BECAUSE OF THE

CONCERN BUT ALSO CONCERN FOR AN AMMONIA LEAK.
IT WAS RESCINDED SO THE PEOPLE THAT LEFT WERE NOW ALLOWED TO GO BACK HOME.
HOWEVER, THEY ARE ON STANDBY AND TOLD TO BE READY TO LEAVE WITHIN 30 MINUTES IF THEY HAVE TO.
>> THIS IS MAJOR CENTRE, MAJOR CENTRE IN THE PROVINCE.
WHEN YOU RU THAT IS CLOSE -- WHEN YOU THAT CLOSE TO HALIFAX. HOW DOES THIS DISRUPT PEOPLE'S LIVES IN THE CITY.
>> EVERYONE IS IN A PANIC. I'M GETTING A LOT OF QUESTIONS, IS MY HOME GOWN -- GOING TO BE ANNOUNCED FOR AN EVACUATION ORDER NEXT.
THE MESSAGE FROM FIRE CREWS AND PROVINCIAL OFFICIALS IS JUST TO BE READY.
IF YOU LIVE NEAR THE AND TO TALL TANTALLON, BE ON ALERT. YOU NEVER KNOW BECAUSE THE FIRE IS SPREADING QUICKLY.
>> Anne-Marie: THAT MESSAGE WOULD BE MORE URGENT WHEN PEOPLE ARE SHOWING PICTURES OF PEOPLE'S HOUSES WHO ARE GONE. I CAN IMAGINE ON PEOPLE'S MINDS, WHAT DO I WANT TO BRING WITH ME IN CASE MY HOUSE ISN'T STANDING WHEN I COME BACK.
>> YEAH, ABSOLUTELY. WE SAW A LOT OF PHOTOS ON SOCIAL MEDIA YESTERDAY, JUST OF THE DEVASTATION. PEOPLE ARE FINALLY STARTING TO GET A LOOK OF WHAT WAS. SOP THEY ARE GOING HOME AND SEEING PHOTOS TO OF WHAT USED TO BE THEIR HOME AND NOW IS JUST GRASS. AND NOTHING ELSE. WHICH IS EXTREMELY DEVASTATING. THERE IS A LOT OF PEOPLE THAT DON'T KNOW THE STATE OF WHAT THEIR HOUSE LOOKS LIKE. THEY ARE WAITING AT FRIENDS AND FAMILY'S HOUSES. THEY DON'T KNOW WHAT THEY WILL RETURN TO. AS WE HEARD YESTERDAY, AT LEAST

151 HOME WERE DESTROYED.

>> Anne-Marie: THOSE PICTURES SHOW THE INTENSE HEAT OF THAT FIRE BECAUSE OF WHAT IS BURNT AND WHAT IS NOT LEFT IN THE IMAGE.

>> Anne-Marie: LINDSEY IS FOLLOWING IN THE REST OF NEWS.

>> Lindsey: WE WILL START WITH NEW BRUNSWICK.

PEOPLE IN SOUTHERN PART OF NEW BRUNSWICK ARE NOW ABLE TO GO HOME EVEN THOUGH THE FIRE THAT FORCED THEM OUT IS STILL BURNING OUT OF CONTROL.

>> RIGHT NOW WE ARE CONFIDENT ENOUGH THAT WE THINK IT'S GOING HOLD.

>> Lindsey: SO PEOPLE ARE TOLD THEY CAN GO BACK BUT MAY HAVE TO LEAVE AGAIN.

THE FIRE DESTROYED ONE HOME, FORCING ABOUT 300 PEOPLE OUT. THE FIRE HAS BECOME A COLLECTION OF HOTSPOT INSTEAD OF ONE BIG FIRE.

THEY ARE KEEPING A CLOSE EYE ON THE FIRE AND WATER BOMBERS REMAIN ON STANDBY.

A NEW WILDFIRES IN NORTHERN ALBERTA HAS BECOME A TOP PRIORITY FOR CREWS IN THE PROVINCE.

>>> WE KNOW THE WILDFIRES WAS DETECTED ON SUNDAY AND I BELIEVE IT WAS REPORTED NOT LONG AFTER TO BE 300 HECTARES IN SIZE AND NOW IT IS 3,000.

>> Lindsey: THIS WILDFIRE NEAR FORT CHIP WIN PUT PEOPLE ON EVACUATION ALERT.

PEOPLE ARE BEING TOLD BE READY TO GO AND COULD BE OUT FOR 7 DAY.

IN NORTHERN ONTARIO, THE WAWA 3 WILDFIRE IS SPREADING CAUSING CONCERN FOR COMMUNITIES INCLUDING HORSEPAIN.

THIS IS HAPPENING AS THE FIRE CALLED WAWA2 PURPOSES WEST OF WHITE RIVER.

THE SIOUX LOOKOUT FIRE IS ALSO

CONSIDERED OUT OF CONTROL IN ONTARIO AND THAT IS IN THE NORTHWEST.

>>> IN OTHER NEWS, PRIME MINISTER JUSTIN TRUDEAU AND ALBERTA PREMIER DANIELLE SMITH ARE KEEPING THEIR COMMENTS FRIENDLY FOR NOW AFTER MONDAY'S ELECTION.

>> I WOULD THEREFORE RESET OUR RELATION -- I WOULD LOVE TO RESET OUR RELATIONSHIP.

>> Prime Minister Trudeau: WE WILL CONTINUE TO WORK ON GROWING ECONOMY, FIGHTING CLIMATE CHANGE AND SUPPORTING ALBERTANS INTO THE FUTURE.

>> Lindsey: THE FRIENDLY TONE MAY NOT LAST TOO LONG WITH DANIELLE SMITH VOWING TO FIGHT OTTAWA'S POLICY ON CLIMATE AND ENERGY.

SPEAKING WITH CTV'S POWERPLAY, AFTER HER VICTORYING TO SMITH DID NOT RULE OUT INVOKING ALBERTA'S SOVEREIGNTY ACT OR SEEKING A SUPREME COURT CHALLENGE TO PUSH BACK AGAINST OTTAWA.

FEDERAL NATURAL RESOURCES MINISTER JOHN WILKINSON SAYS THE ALBERTA ELECTION WILL NOT CHANGE THE GOVERNMENT'S GOALS ON EMISSIONS.

>>> JAYS PITCHER ANTHONY BASS APOLOGIZED FOR SHARING IS AND ANTI-LGBTQ2S+ VIDEO ON INSTAGRAM.

>> I MADE A POST THAT WAS HURTFUL TO THE PRIDE COMMUNITY, WHICH INCLUDES FRIENDS OF MINE AND CLOSE FAMILY MEMBERS OF MINE AND I AM TRULY SORRY FOR THAT.

>> Lindsey: THE VIDEO ENCOURAGING PEOPLE TOMBOY COTT COMPANIES THAT SUPPORT PRIDE. LIKE TARGET.

THE POST CAUSED BACKLASH FROM THE LGBTQ2S+ COMMUNITY AND FANS. DURING THE APOLOGY, HE SAID HE WILL USE THE TEAM'S RESOURCES TO BETTER EDUCATE HIMSELF.

HE SPOKE BRIEFLY BEFORE LAST NIGHT'S GAME FM THE JAYS MANAGER

SAID THAT BASS' ACTIONS ARE NOT REFLECTION OF THE TEAM'S VIEWS. THE JAYS WILL HOLD PRIDE WEEKEND ON JULY 9th, 10th. SARA SMOOK STARTED A NEW CHAPTER IN HER LIFE.
