>> Reporter: YEAH JAMIE, THAT  
SHELTER YOU'RE TALKING ABOUT IS  
BEHIND ME ON THE NORTH SIDE OF  
DUNDAS JUST EAST OF DIXIE ROAD.  
IT'S A HOTEL CONVERTED TO A  
SHELTER AND WE COVERED THE STORY  
BACK IN NOVEMBER WHERE THE  
SHELTER WAS AT CAPACITY THEN AND  
A MAN CLAIMING REFUGEE STATUS  
HERE IN CANADA DIED IN ONE OF  
THE TENTS, MANY TENTS THAT ARE  
ON THAT PROPERTY RIGHT NOW.  
NO FOUL PLAY, AND THIS PAST  
SUNDAY, A WOMAN DIED ON THAT  
SAME PROPERTY.

THERE'S AN AUTOPSY BEING  
CONDUCTED ON HER REMAINS AND  
THEN THEY'LL GET AN OFFICIAL

CAUSE OF DEATH FOR HER AS WELL.  
THAT MAKES TWO PEOPLE WHO HAVE  
PASSED AWAY ON THIS PROPERTY OF  
THIS HOMELESS SHELTER WITHIN THE  
LAST THREE MONTHS.

THE SHELTER IS TAKING IN AS MANY  
PEOPLE AS THEY CAN.

THERE'S JUST NO MORE ROOM FOR  
THEM.

WE'VE HEARD THE SAME THINGS IN  
THE CITY OF TORONTO WITH MAYOR  
CHOW, MAYOR BROWN IN BRAMPTON

GIVE MONEY TO HAVE SHELTERS

OF THE TENTS AND THERE'S NOT  
EVEN AN AIR MATTRESS ON THE  
GROUND, THE FLOOR, IT'S JUST A  
TENT.

IF THEY'RE LUCKY THEY HAVE A  
BLANKET WITH A JACKET DONATED TO  
THEM: IT'S NOT AN EASY TIME FOR  
ANY OF THE PEOPLE AND THEY DO,  
THE MAYORS THAT IS NEED HELP  
FROM THE FEDS TO PROVIDE FUNDS  
AND MAYOR CHOW SPOKE WITH ME  
ABOUT THAT THE OTHER DAY AND ARE  
STILL HOPEFUL FOR HELP FROM THE  
FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO GET  
SHELTER FOR PEOPLE WHO ARRIVE  
HERE AND LIVE HERE.

IT'S A HUGE PROBLEM AND DEALT  
WITH BUT THEY DO NEED MORE HELP  
TO DEAL WITH IT.

HERE'S REACTION FROM EARLIER ON,  
LET'S LISTENMENT OF LISTEN.

>> THERE ARE MANY PEOPLE WITH A  
HEART FOR HUMAN BEINGS, AND  
TODAY WE ARE APPEALING TO ALL IN  
CANADA.

LET US PRESENT TO THE WORLD THE

NO ONE LEAVES THEIR COUNTRY TO

>> I WAS TASKED TODAY TO SPEAK ABOUT THE MOOD IN OUR COMMUNITY, AND AS I PAUSED THERE I WAS LOOKING AT THE MOOD IN MY OWN HEART.

IT IS GRIEF, IT IS ANGER, IT IS DESPAIR, IT IS QUESTIONING, A LOT OF QUESTIONS.

WHEN IS THIS GOING TO BE A PRIORITY?

IN AFRICA WE SAY A MAN WALK NAKED ON THE STREETS SO YOU CAN GET MY ATTENTION.

WE FEEL WE HAVE DONE THAT ALREADY.

SINCE FOR SOME OF US, AT LEAST SINCE MAY WE HAVE BEEN TALKING ABOUT THE SAME THING.

THE CITY HAS OPENED AN ADDITIONAL WARMER CENTRE AS TEMPERATURES PLUNGE.

THE WARMER CENTRE IS OPEN TO THOSE LOOKING TO ESCAPE THE COLD.

THE FOUR OTHERS ALSO REMAIN OPEN.

THOSE ARE LOCATED AT 75 ELIZABETH STREET, 12 HOMES AVENUE, AND 136 SPADINA ROAD.

THE CENTRES ARE OPEN WHEN TEMPERATURES REACH -5° AND/OR WHEN ENVIRONMENT CANADA ISSUES A WINTER WEATHER EVENT WARNING.

HOMELESSNESS AROUND HERE AND YOU  
KNOW, AND YOU SEE A BIT OF STUFF  
LIKE THAT.

>> WORRIED FOR YOUR OWN  
SECURITY?

>> ME PERSONALLY, NO, BUT I CAN  
SEE PEOPLE BEING.

>> POLICE HAVE NOT RELEASED  
SUSPECT INFORMATION.

POLICE ARE SEARCHING FOR THREE  
SUSPECTS AFTER A MAN WAS STABBED  
DURING A ROBBERY IN MISSISSAUGA  
EARLY THIS MORNING.

IT HAPPENED SHORTLY BEFORE  
1:00 A.M. NEAR DIXIE AND DUNDAS,  
A MAN SUFFERED STAB WOUNDS TO  
THE FACE AND LOWER BACK WHEN TWO  
MEN AND A WOMAN APPROACHED HIM  
DEMANDING HE TURN OVER HIS  
BELONGINGS.

THE INJURIES ARE CONSIDERED  
NON-LIFE-THREATENING.

RANDOM SHOOTINGS LED TORONTO  
POLICE TO HAMILTON TODAY.

OFFICERS ALONG WITH THE CANINE  
UNIT WERE SCOURING A VALLEY PARK  
IN STONEY CREEK AS PART OF THE  
INVESTIGATION.

A STOLEN VEHICLE CONNECTED TO  
THE SHOOTINGS WAS ALSO FOUND IN  
HAMILTON.

SEARCH FOR THE SUSPECT IN LAST

WEEKEND'S RANDOM SHOOTINGS THAT LEFT A MAN DEAD AND A 16-YEAR-OLD BOY WITH SERIOUS INJURIES.

THE VICTIMS WERE SHOT WITHIN 24 HOURS OF EACH OTHER AT A BUS STOP.

POLICE BELIEVE THE SHOOTINGS ARE CONNECTED AND SAID THEY HAVE THE HALLMARKS OF GANG ACTIVITY.

LYNX ADVISED PASSENGERS WITH FUTURE BOOKINGS TO CONTACT THAT ARE CREDIT CARD COMPANY TO SECURE REFUNDS.

>> TAKE THE FLIGHT TO LAX AND COME BACK AIR CANADA AND CAME THIS MORNING, DID THE CHECK IN, ALL THAT, READY TO BOARD ASK THEN THEY CANCELED THE FLIGHT ON US.

>> PRETTY UNFORTUNATE BECAUSE WE'VE ALREADY UP FRONT PAID \$600 TO FLY WITH AMERICAN AIRWAYS BACK TO TORONTO IN LIKE FIVE DAYS, AND NOW, LIKE WE HAVE NO WAY OF GETTING THERE.

>> LOOKING AT JET BLUE, FLYING INTO BUFFALO.

HOPEFULLY SENDS A MESSAGE TO THE CANADIAN AIRLINES THAT BE COMPETITIVE OTHERWISE PASSENGERS MOVE.

YOU TAKE CARE OF ME, I TAKE CARE OF YOU.

YOU DON'T TAKE CARE OF ME, I DON'T TAKE CARE OF YOU.

>> WESTJET WILL OFFER DISCOUNTED FARES FOR STRANDED PASSENGERS ON WESTJET ROUTES PREVIOUSLY SERVED

BY LYNX.

ALL ELIGIBLE ECONOMY FARES WILL RECEIVE A 25% DISCOUNT THROUGH OCTOBER 26TH AS LONG AS THE BOOKING IS MADE BY NEXT WEEK. FOR FLIGHTS FROM OUTSIDE CANADA, WESTJET WILL CAP FARES AT \$250 PLUS TAXES UNTIL FEBRUARY 29TH. AN AIRLINE INDUSTRY EXPERT SAYS PART OF THE REASON SO MANY LOW COST CARRIERS FOLDED IS THE HIGH PRICE OF FLYING IN CANADA.

>> MANY WHO HAVE TRAVELED IN ASIA OR EUROPE WILL BE FAMILIAR WITH THOSE REALLY ENTICING FARES, LIKE THE ONE POUND FARE FROM LONDON TO BELFAST OR THE FLIGHT I TOOK ABOUT TEN DAYS AGO WHICH WAS 23 CANADIAN DOLLARS. YOU KNOW, IN AN ENVIRONMENT IN CANADA WHERE THE AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT FEE ALONE IS UPWARDS OF 40 AND \$45 EVERY TIME YOU SET FOOT IN A CANADIAN AIRPORT, THOSE TYPES OF STIMULATIVE ULTRALOW FARES AREN'T VISIBLE.

>> LYNX WAS UNABLE TO OVERCOME PRESSURES ASSOCIATED WITH INFLATION, FUEL COSTS, EXCHANGE RATES, COST OF CAPITAL, REGULATORY COSTS, AND COMPETITION IN THE CANADIAN MARKET.
