





20 May 2022 as a World Day of UNESCO???

We are exploring possibilities (together with the OIML) with the UNESCO Secretariat for a proclamation of 20 May as World Metrology Day by UNESCO. Feasibility of the proposal will be discussed at the UNESCO IBSP meeting in November 2019.

ROADMAP
World Metrology Day: 20 May proclaimed by the UNESCO General Conference as World Day

Date	Action
31 July 2019	BIPM and OIML submitted the WMD proposal to the UNESCO International Basic Sciences Programme (IBSP)
28 November 2019	Session of the UNESCO IBSP (advice/opinion of the Scientific Board on WMD proposal). BIPM and OIML will be invited to attend the session.
	Assuming we are successful
December 2019 –	Exploring co-sponsorship of the proposal by the BIPM and OIML from their respective members.
February 2020	Has to be taken forward by (at least a few) Member States of both organizations
February 2020	Proposal on WMD: 20 May is submitted by the UNESCO Member States to the next session of UNESCO Executive Board to be held in April 2020 (or to the later sessions in October 2020 or April 2021).
	UNESCO Executive Board asks UNESCO Secretariat to conduct a feasibility study to ensure the proposal is realistic and supported.
April 2020	UNESCO Executive Board adopts the <u>Decision</u> recommending the General Conference to decide to proclaim at its 41st session 20 May of every year as WMD.
November 2021	The <u>Resolution</u> proclaiming 20 May of every year as WMD is adopted at the 41st session of the UNESCO General Conference.
20 May 2022	Celebration of WMD as World Day of UNESCO
