



The STARLAB at Central Michigan University is looking for a new postdoc to work on a new NSF funded project about uranium (U) geochemistry.

This research aims to characterize the burial mechanisms responsible for U sequestration in marine sediments. It is a collaboration with several other academic institutions in US and Europe.

The ideal candidate will have a Ph.D. in geochemistry or related disciplines and experience in using synchrotron-based absorption techniques like XANES and EXAFS.
