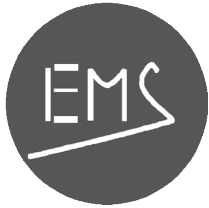

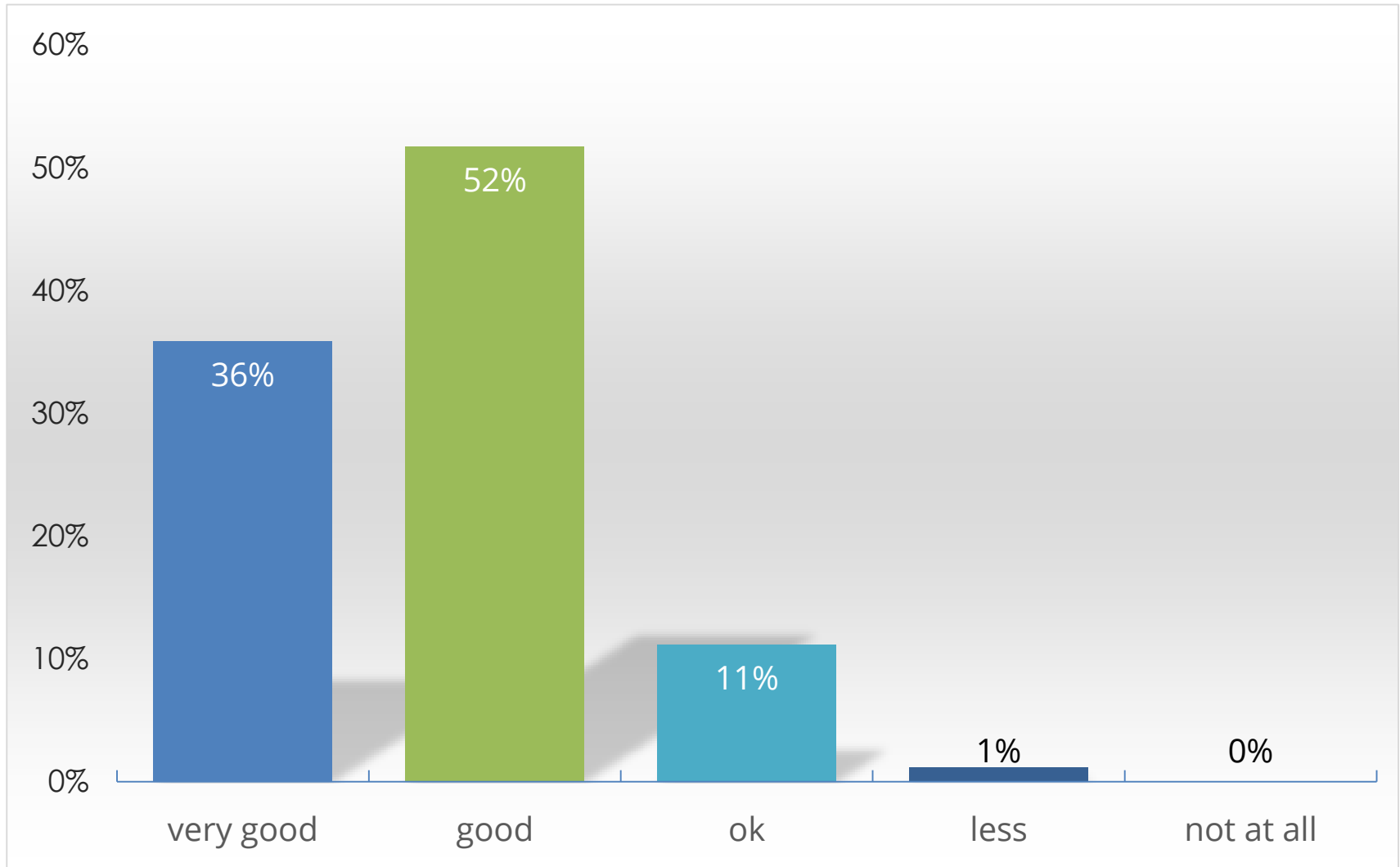

How did you like the event in general?



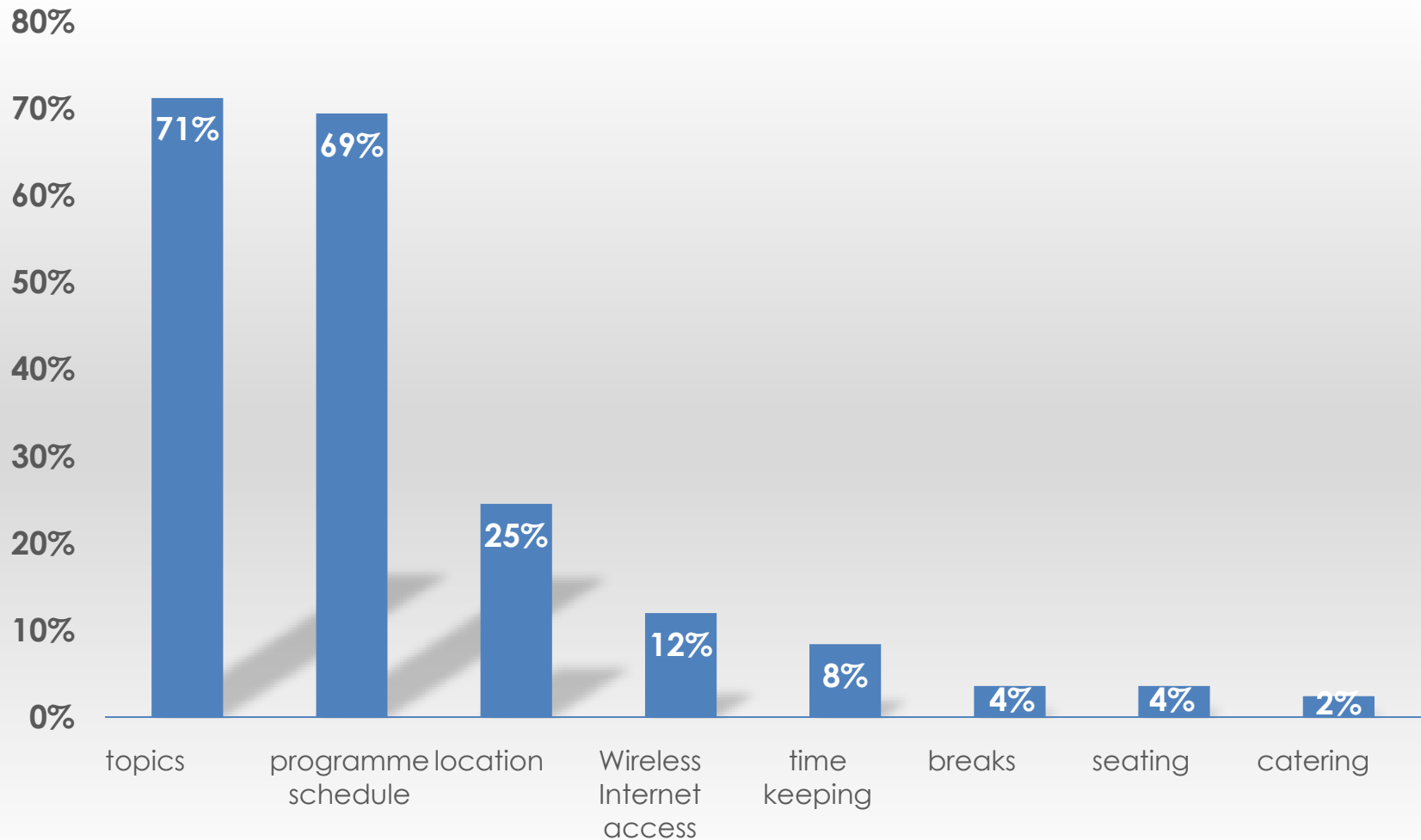


Please rate the general conditions of our event



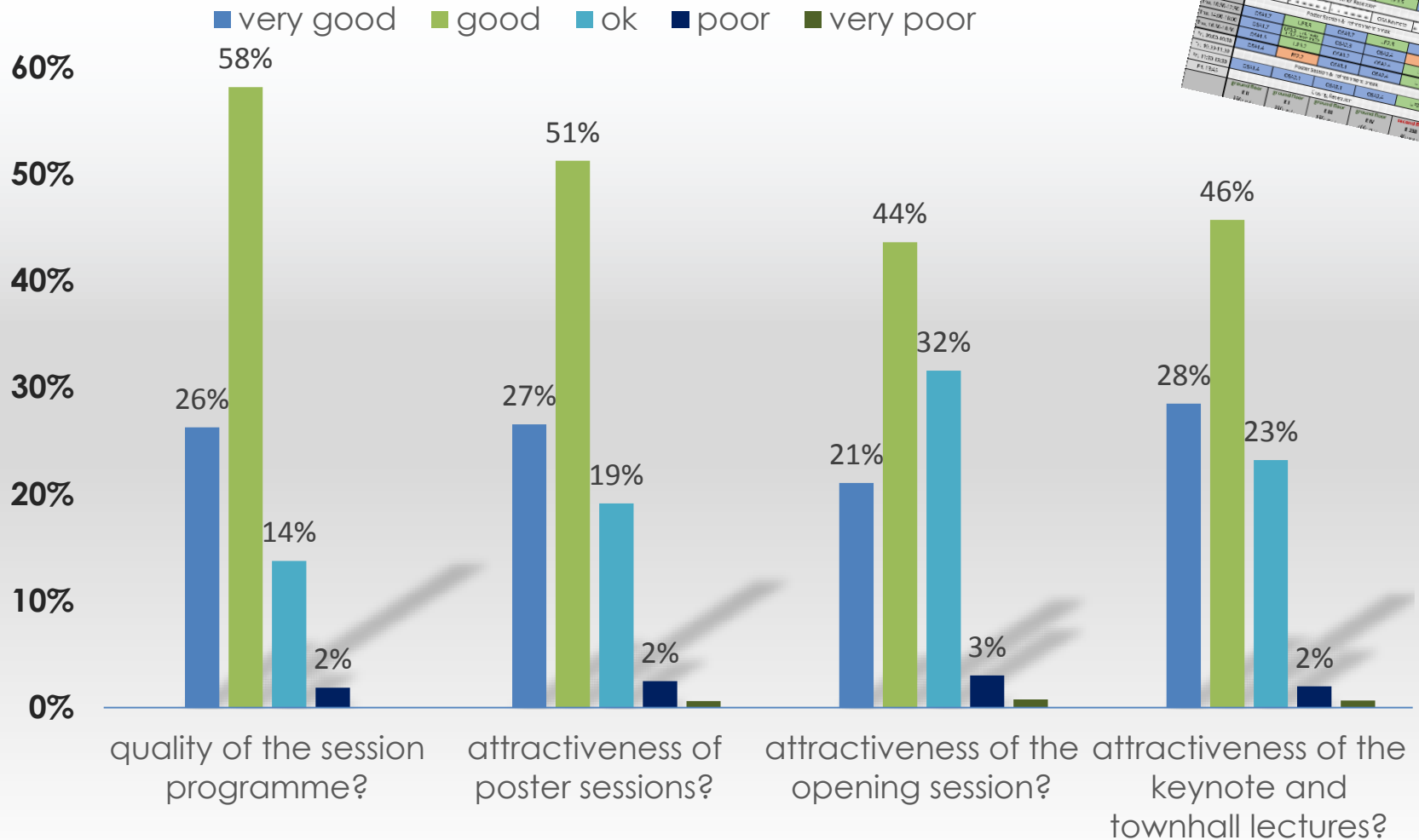


What is most relevant to you during the event? (two answers possible)



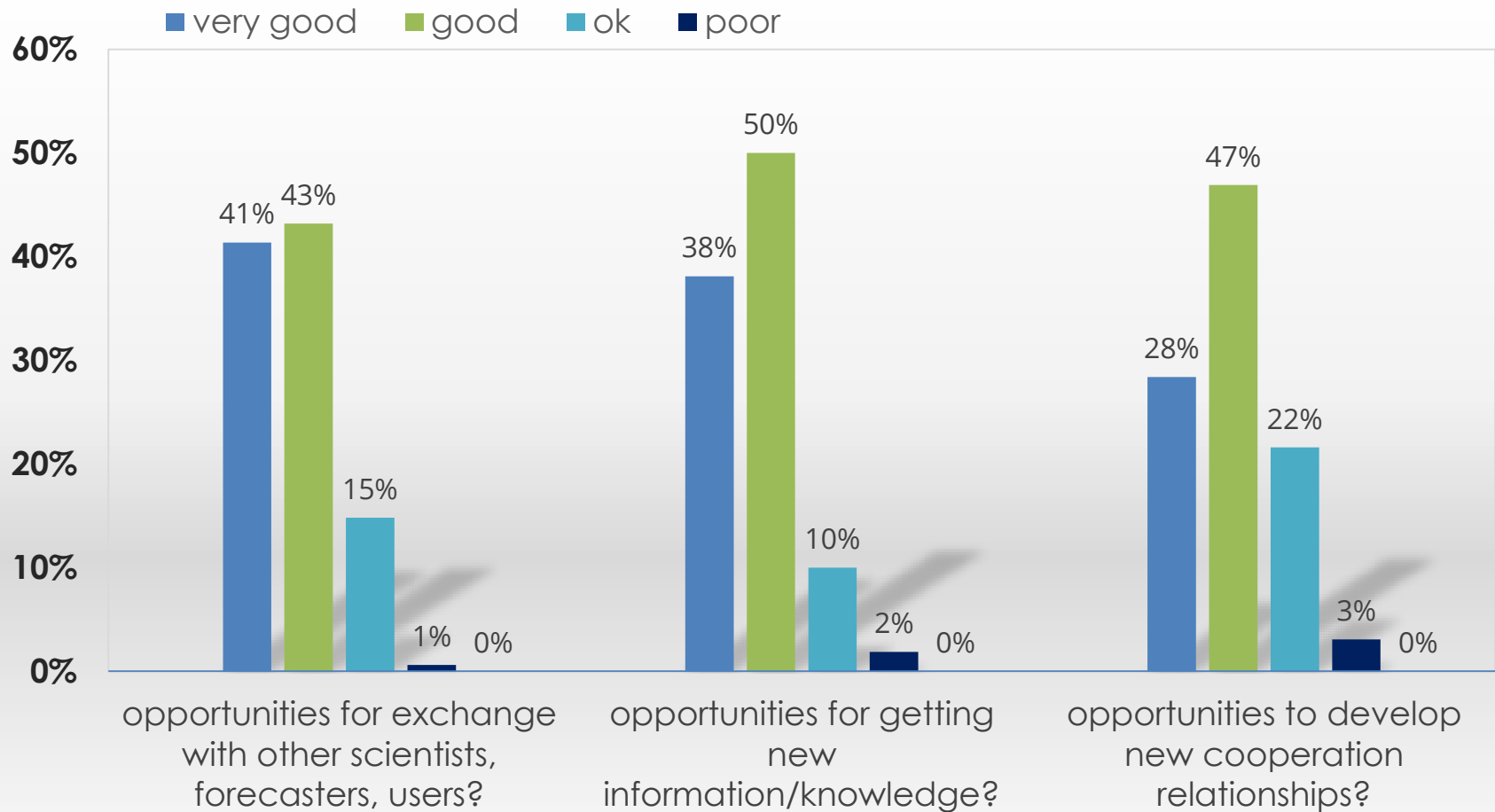


Rating the programme ...





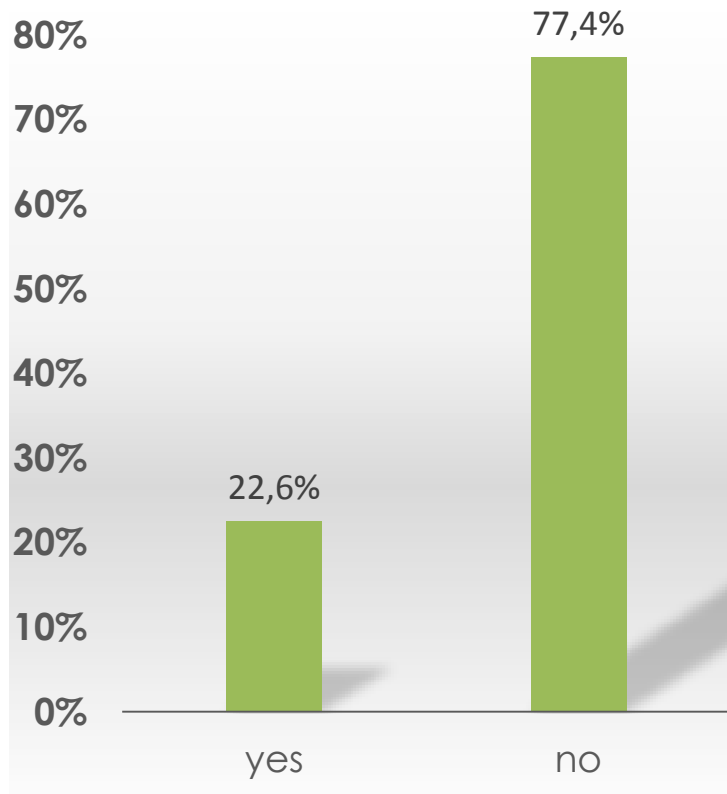
Collaboration & exchange: How do you rate the ...



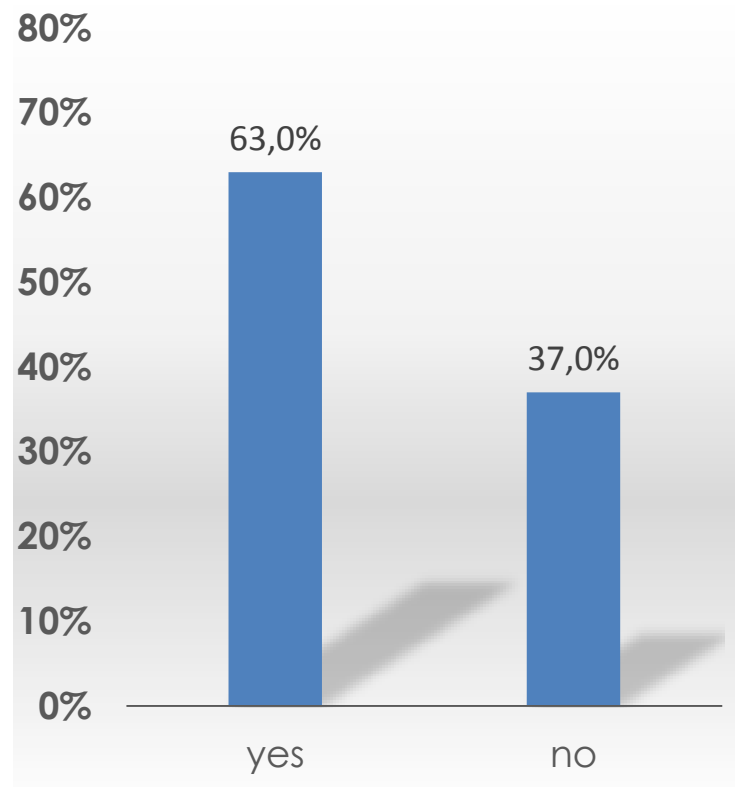


Participants' preference for future programmes

Would you support having more poster presentations to decrease the number of parallel sessions?

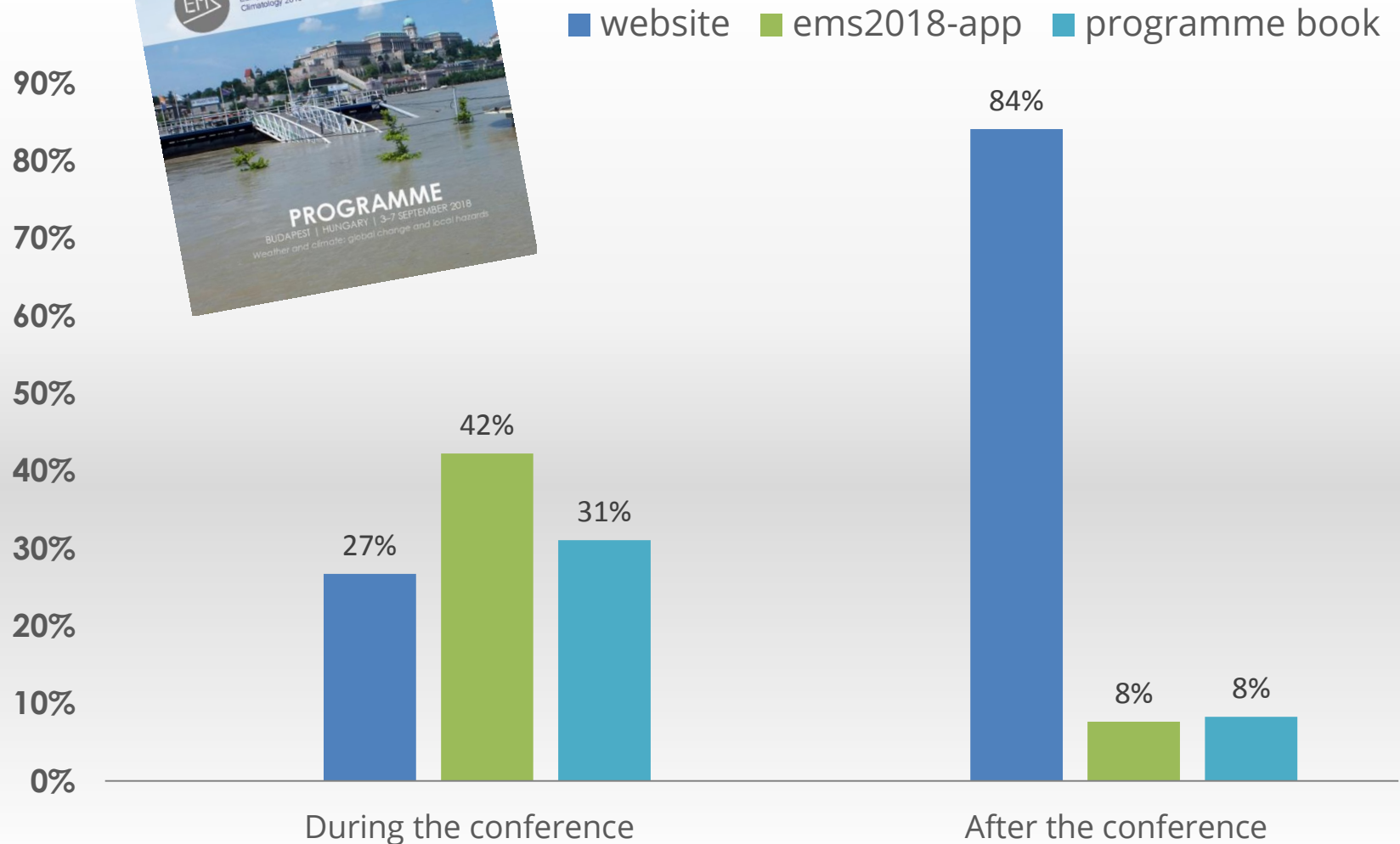


Would you prefer avoiding sessions on Friday afternoon?



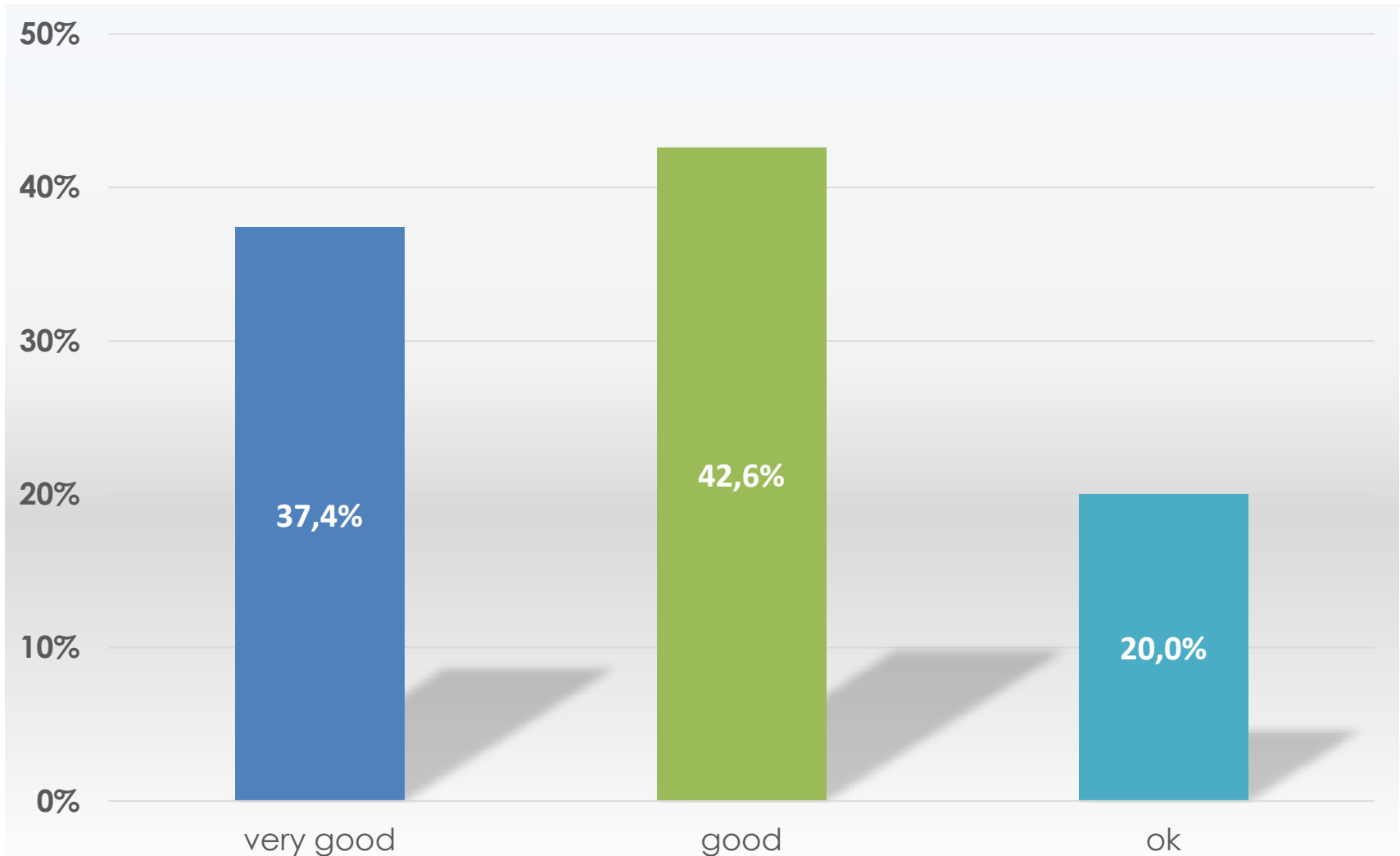


Which is your preferred tool to access information on the session programme?

nothing really!

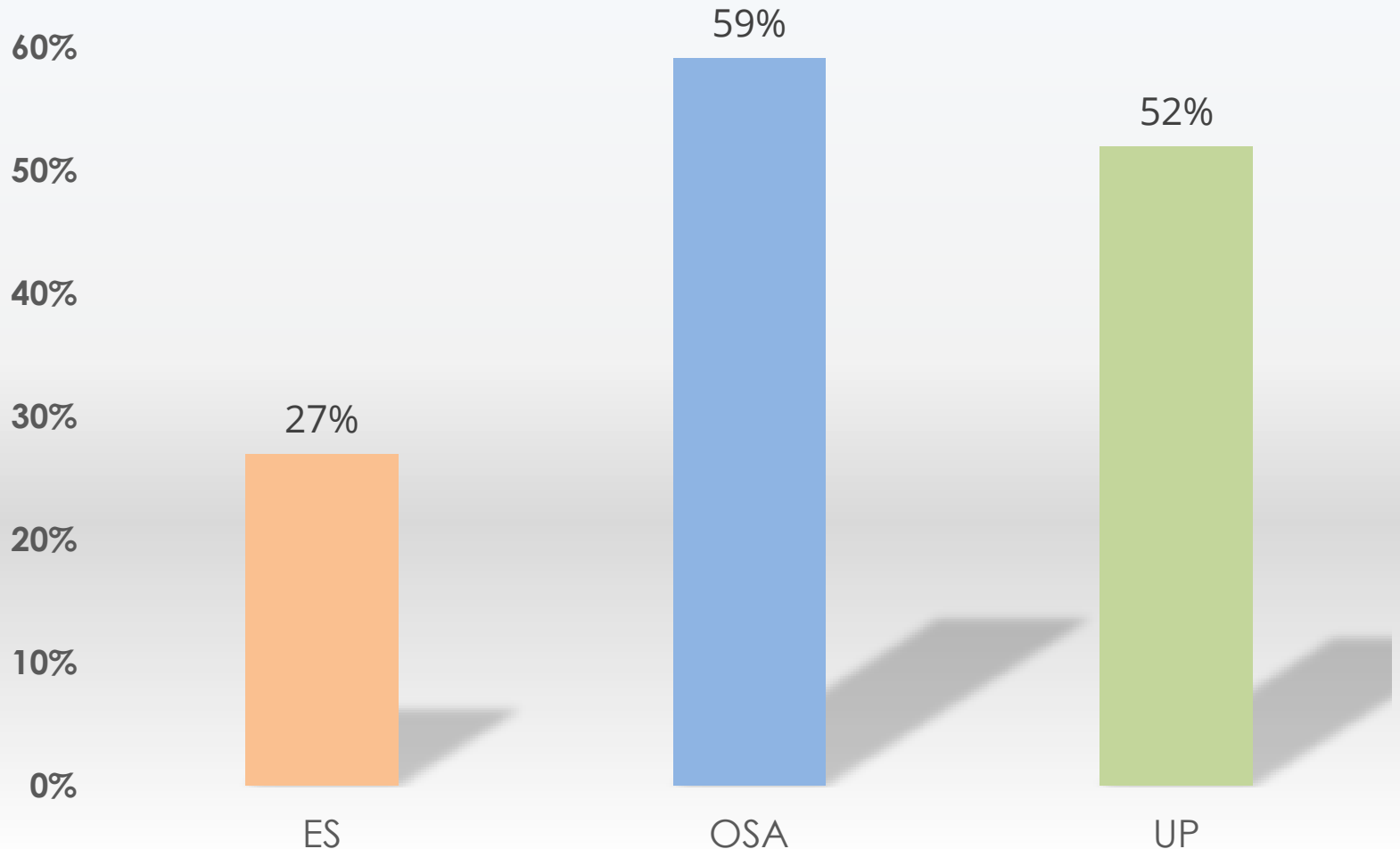
Great Conference, thank you! My only suggestions are: see if it is possible to end the conference on Thursday, rather than Friday

Which of the EMS Programme Streams are most relevant for you?

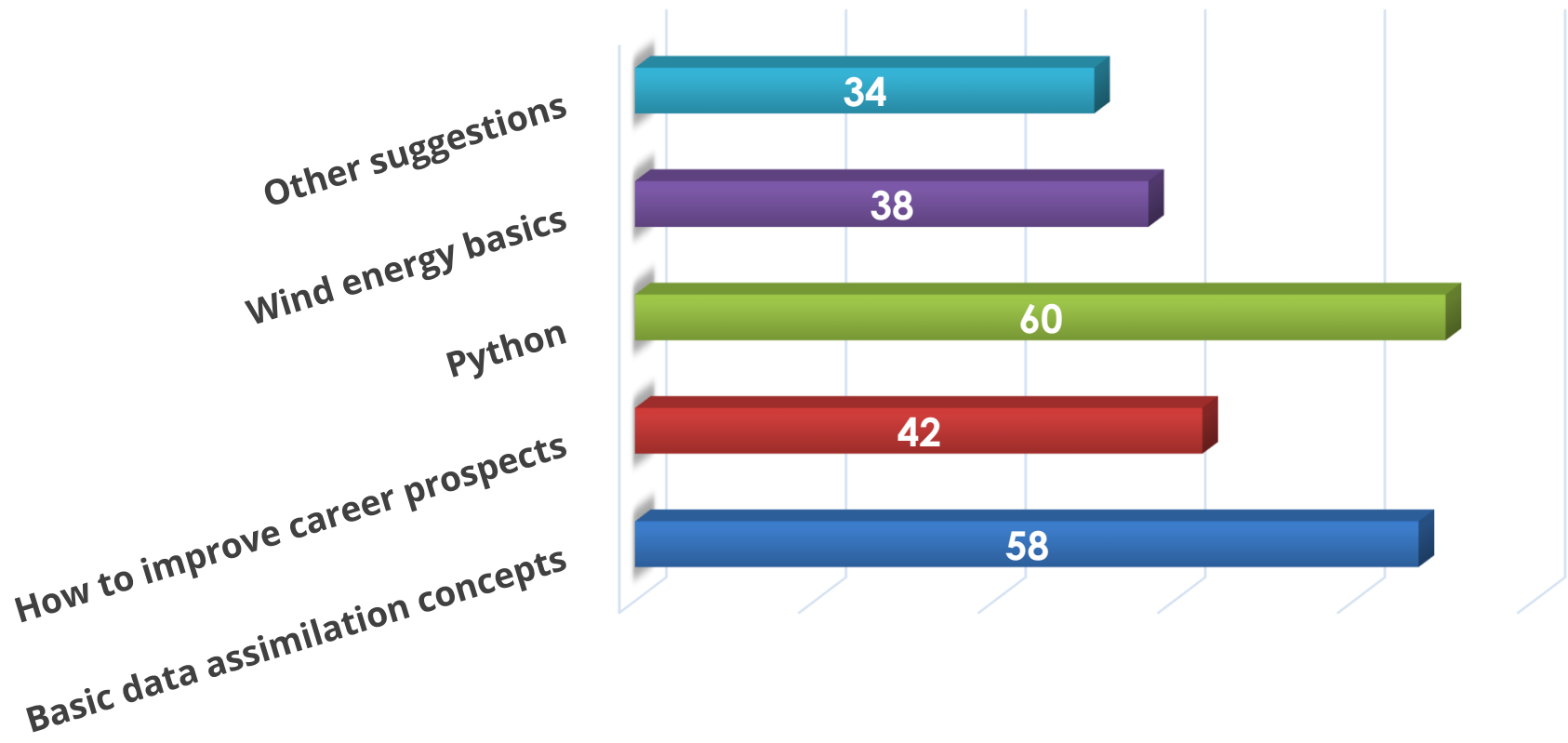

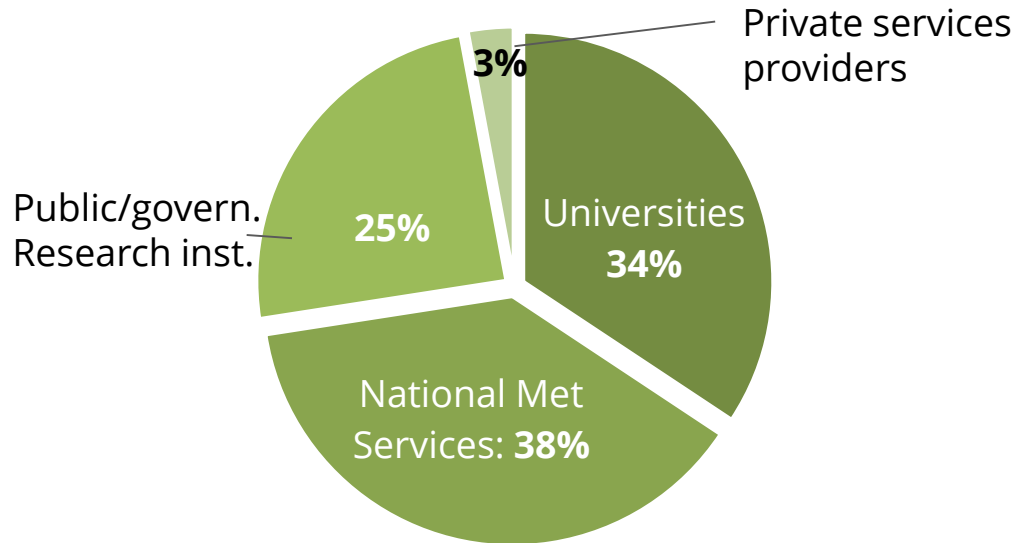

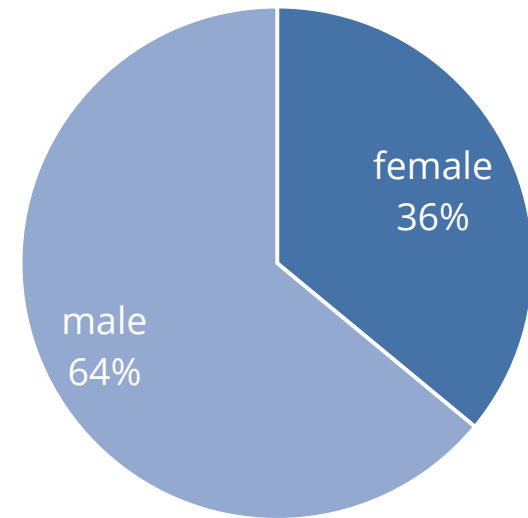


EMS2018 Attendance
