

Francis Mégraud

Dr Francis Mégraud is Emeritus Professor of Bacteriology at the University of Bordeaux since September 2018, He was Head of the Laboratory of Bacteriology at Hospital Pellegrin, Bordeaux, France until 2017 and he is Member of the INSERM U1053. He was Head of the INSERM U853 from 2004 to 2015.

He created the National Reference Center for Campylobacters & Helicobacters in France in 1993 which he headed until 2017 and is one of the founding members and current Secretary of the European Helicobacter & Microbiota Study Group. He has been involved in the EHMSG yearly Workshops since 1988.

His interest for Campylobacters & *Helicobacter pylori* dates back to the early days after the discovery of these bacteria. He has been involved in epidemiological studies and clinical trials of *H. pylori* eradication. His main current interests are the role of *H. pylori* in gastric cancer and antimicrobial resistance.
