Georgina Hold, Professor of Gut Health at St George and Sutherland Clinical School, UNSW, Australia is an internationally recognised expert on the role of the gut microbiota in GI disease with a specific interest in IBD. She has published >100 peer reviewed articles and accumulated >8200 cites in the last 5 years. Her group was the first to identify an over-representation of epsilon Proteobacteria (non-pylori *Helicobacter* and emerging *Campylobacter*) in UC and was one of the first to use next generation sequencing to interrogate the gut microbiota in treatment naive de-novo presenting paediatric IBD. In 2014 she was awarded a Fulbright Scholarship and was appointed as Professor of Gut Health in 2017 heading up the IBD Research Program within the Microbiome Research Centre, UNSW.
