She is the Group Leader of the Microbes & Cancer Group at Instituto de Investigação e Inovação em Saúde, Universidade do Porto (i3S) and Institute of Molecular Pathology and Immunology of the University of Porto (Ipatimup), and an Assistant Professor at the Department of Pathology at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Porto.

Her research has been dedicated to studying the pathogenesis of *Helicobacter pylori* infection, namely the epidemiology and clinical relevance *of H. pylori* virulence factors, and the interaction between bacterial virulence factors and human genetic susceptibility to gastric cancer. More recently, she has been exploring the relationship between the gastric microbiome and gastric carcinogenesis.

She has published more than 110 peer-reviewed papers and nine book chapters, and her work has been cited over 5.700 times. She has coordinated and participated in research projects funded by Foundation for Science and Technology, Agency for Innovation, Ministry of Health, Gulbenkian Foundation, European Commission, and Worldwide Cancer Research.
