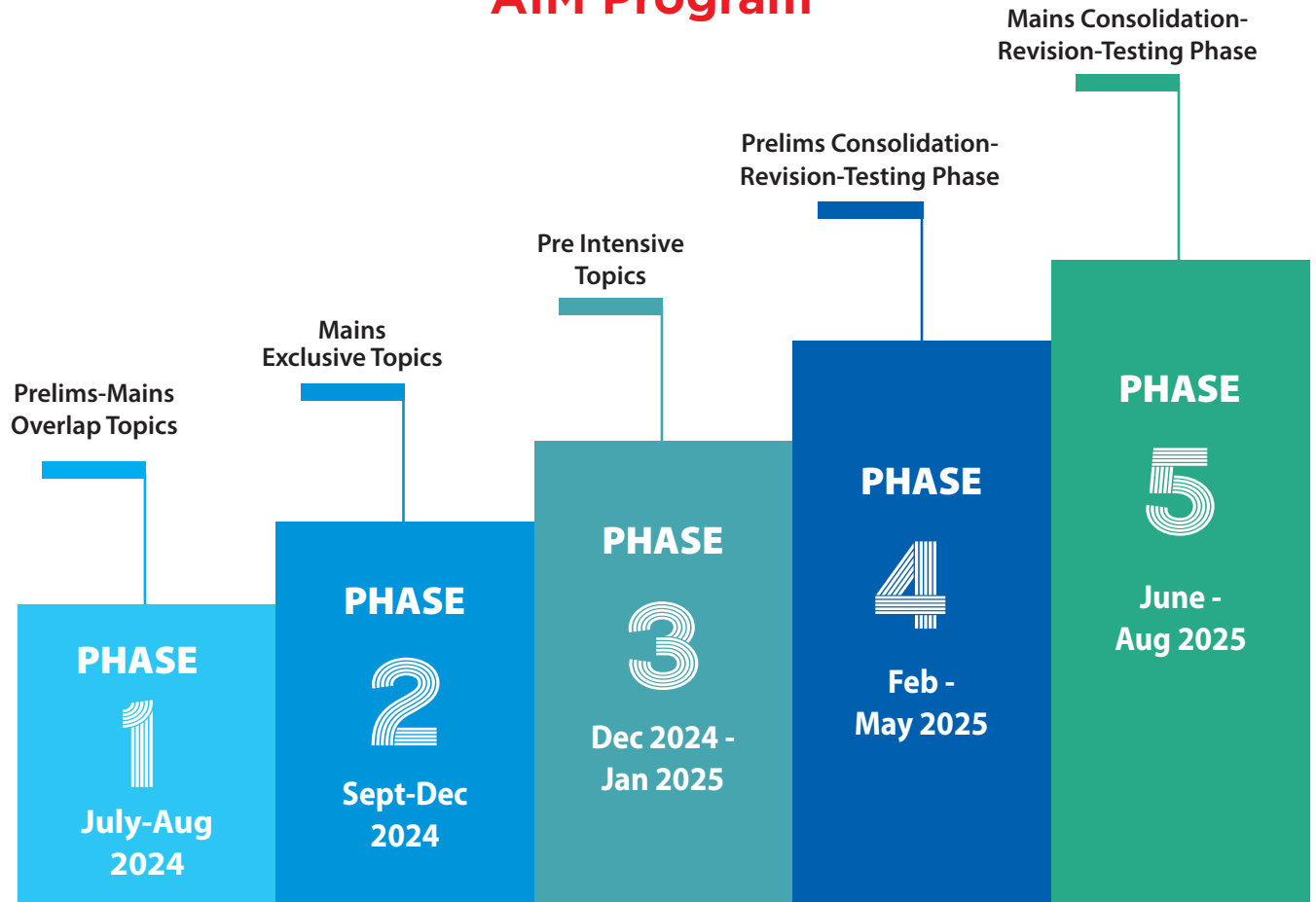

How Does A Mentor Help in AIM?

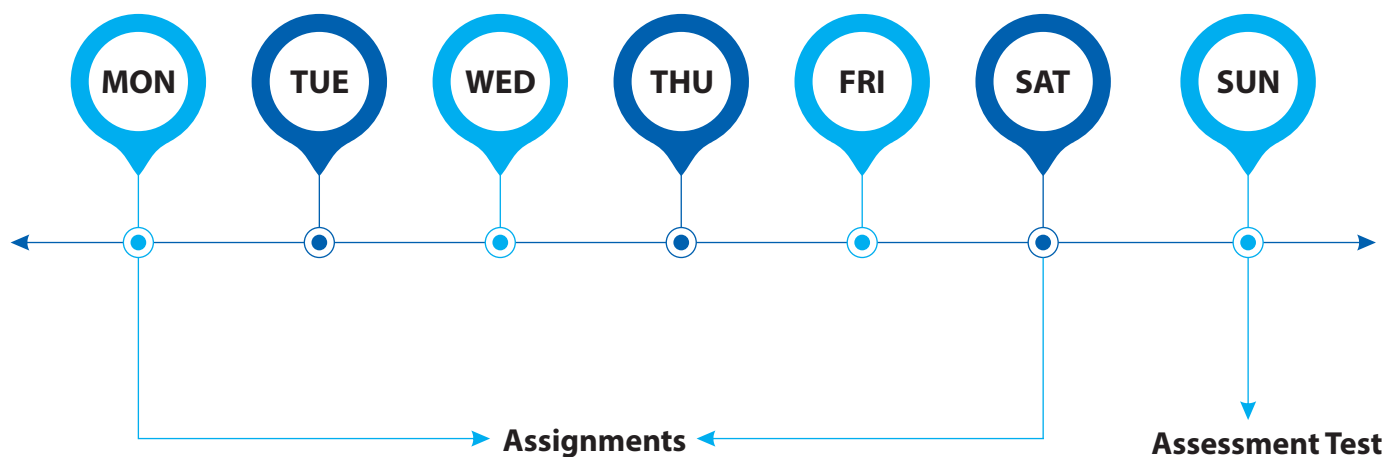
- 1** Smart and limited **source finalization** for syllabus keywords.

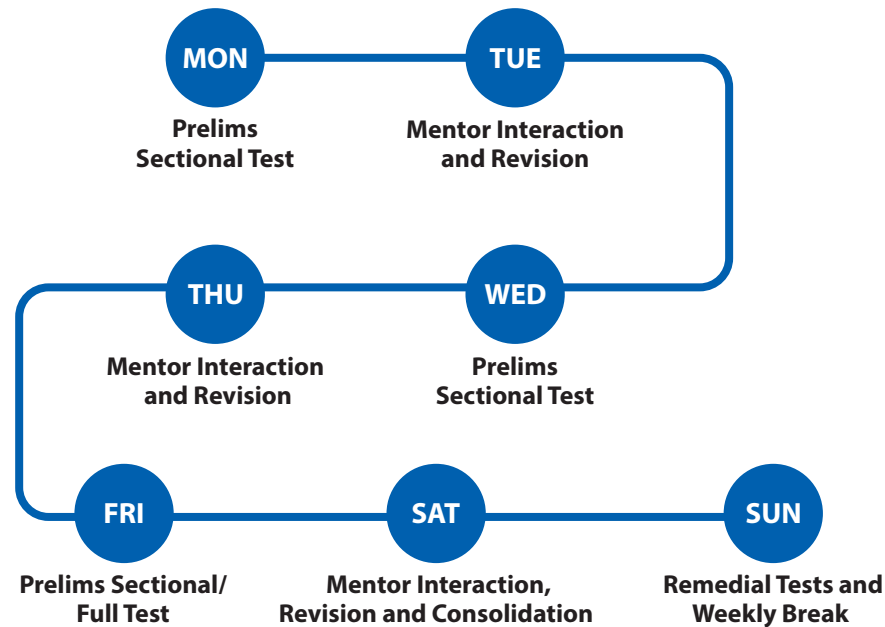

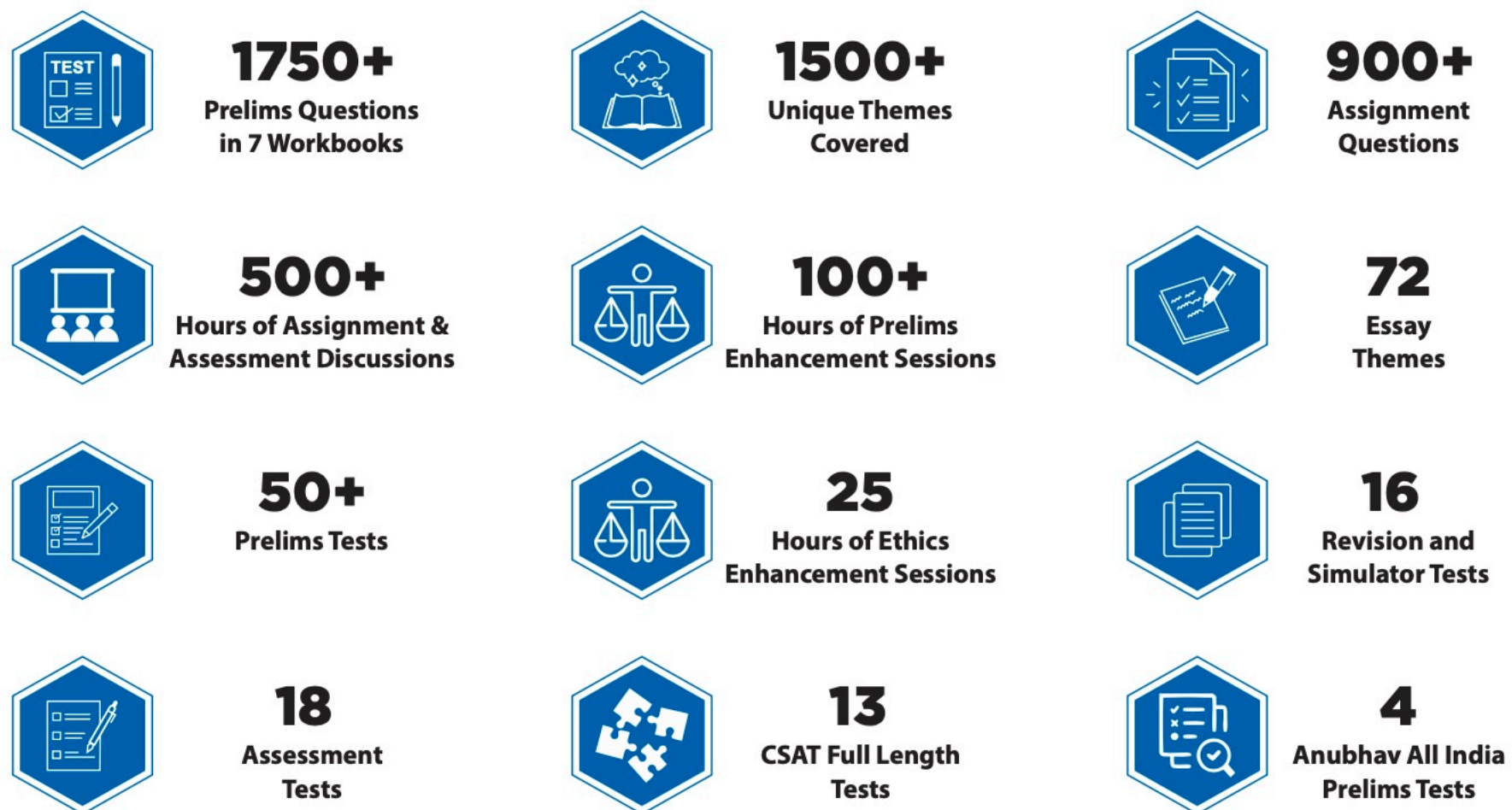
