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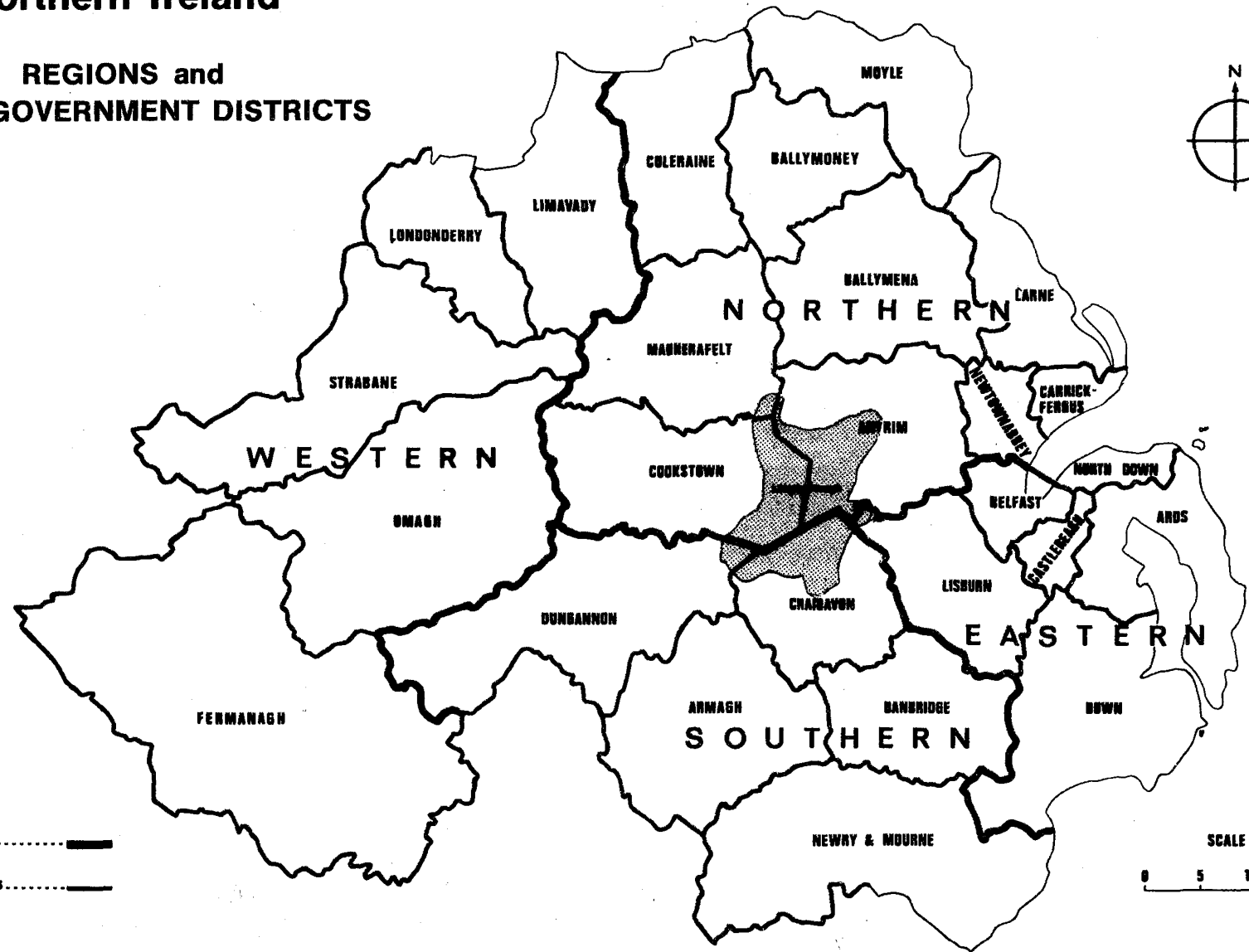

REGISTRAR GENERAL'S FOREWORD

INTRODUCTION

This is the preliminary report on the seventh census of the population of Northern Ireland, taken at midnight on 5 April 1981. The figures contained in it are provisional and relate to the population and number of private households for each local government district. They have been compiled from the enumerators' record books, population summaries and from the completed census forms and are subject to revision when the returns are examined further for the later and more detailed census reports.

Censuses were also taken on the same date in other parts of the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland. Previous censuses in Northern Ireland were taken in 1926, 1937, 1951, 1961, 1966 (interim) and 1971. The 1981 Census continues the decennial pattern of full censuses.

On this occasion considerable effort had been put into streamlining census forms as well as the range of questions. The 1981 census form contained 22 questions which was 6 fewer than in the 1971 census although the basic questions remained much the same. Among the topics omitted this time were usual address 5 years ago, qualifications at ordinary level, hours per week worked, occupation one year ago and details on fertility. On the other hand the 1981 census form contained additional sub-sections about household amenities.

ORGANISATION

The 1981 census was organised on broadly similar lines to the 1971 census. The country was again divided into small areas termed enumeration districts. This time there were about 3,000 such districts as compared with 2,200 in 1971. Each district contained on average about 170 households. About 2,900 enumerators were responsible for the distribution and collection of forms in these districts.

The enumeration districts were grouped into census districts, each containing on average about 30 enumeration districts. A census officer was appointed to each census district to assist in the recruitment and training of enumerators and to oversee their work. In some cases they had responsibility for the enumeration of certain communal establishments within their district. In all 100 census officers were appointed.

The third tier of the field organisation consisted of supervisors who were appointed to work from their own homes. Each supervisor was responsible for recruiting, training and overseeing the work of about 17 census officers.

Altogether therefore there were about 3,000 field staff who were recruited by Census Office through the Employment Service Offices of the Department of Manpower Services and by means of advertising in the local press.

TAKING THE CENSUS

The success of a population census depends greatly on the attitude of the general public and their response to the burden of form filling. Particular thanks for their willing and understanding co-operation are due to householders and all others responsible for the completion of forms. Thanks are also due to the BBC, ITV, Downtown Radio and the Press for their invaluable assistance in publicising and arousing interest in the census and also to Post Offices, business firms, local authorities, public services, schools and others for displaying census posters on their premises.

The part played by field staff was of course vital and special mention and thanks are due to them for their devotion in the performance of their duties, often under very difficult circumstances. A campaign of non co-operation, which included the public burning of census forms, was conducted in some areas. In some instances there was deplorable intimidation of enumerators culminating in the murder of one of our enumerators while collecting census forms, in Londonderry. This crime met with widespread public revulsion and condemnation.

Arising from difficulties in the field, special arrangements had to be devised to ensure that forms which had been collected from the public by field staff were in the custody of the Census Office as quickly as possible. The public were also asked to co-operate by sending in forms which had remained uncollected. Once again the response was excellent in that initially many forms were received by post in the Census Office from households whose enumerators had been unable to collect the completed forms. In due course, as the result of further approaches, the number of households enumerated rose to 455,279. This represents 98.7% of the estimated total number of households.

THE FUTURE PROGRAMME

As indicated, the figures in this report are provisional. The main census reports will be based on a carefully edited computer analysis of the data obtained from the census forms. The task of processing the results is well advanced and it is planned to publish the Belfast report, which is the first of the detailed reports, towards the

end of this year. It will contain figures on area, population, age, marital status, religion, economic activity and housing. It will be followed by a Summary report in early 1983 giving similar information for each Northern Ireland local government district. The remaining detailed reports on the particular topics of economic activity, housing, workplace, migration, education and religion will be published as soon as possible thereafter.

1981 CENSUS PRELIMINARY RESULTS

The figures, which are provisional, are based on the actual population present and enumerated in Northern Ireland on Census night including civilians and Service personnel enumerated on land, in vessels, on inland waters or in ports or at anchorages and persons on ships on coastwise voyages to Northern Ireland.

As indicated under the COVERAGE heading below, the figures represent 98.7% of the total estimated number of households. In order to be as informative as possible, additional columns have been incorporated in the tables to indicate the estimated population effect for households not included in the enumeration, which represent 1.3% of estimated total households.

The figures show that the population of Northern Ireland as enumerated at midnight on 5 April 1981 totalled 1,490,228 comprising 730,174 males and 760,054 females. This figure however does not take account of the effect of the non-returns on the population figures, estimated at 19,664. In the 1971 Census the total enumerated population was 1,536,065.

COVERAGE

Results from any population census will inevitably contain some inaccuracies arising from:

- (a) Failure to identify all the living accommodation in an enumeration district.
- (b) Incorrect classification of accommodation as vacant or occupants absent.
- (c) Failure to identify all the households in a building.
- (d) Failure to make contact with some households.
- (e) Misunderstanding of the form by the form-filler.

However, the Northern Ireland 1981 Census had additional factors. As a result of difficulties which arose during the enumeration stages of the exercise forms for many households remained undelivered or uncollected at the final collection date of 9 April 1981. Although the bulk of the returns had been received in the Census Office by the end of April 1981, returns for approximately 65,000 households remained outstanding. As a result of further publicity and postal contact, this number had reduced to about 20,000 households by the end of 1981. While at that stage it would have been possible to issue a preliminary report on the basis of what then amounted to a 96% coverage it was considered that a further effort to make the Census as comprehensive and reliable as possible should be made. Consequently further letters were sent to outstanding households explaining to them the importance of making returns, and emphasising that it was in their own interests that they should do so. These letters yielded an excellent response and as a result the number of households enumerated rose to 455,279, which represents 98.7% of the estimated total number of households.

NATURAL INCREASE AND INTERCENSAL MOVEMENT

The figures for natural increase, ie excess of births over deaths, are obtained from the annual statistics of births and deaths published in the Registrar General's Annual Reports. The natural increase of the population for each intercensal period since birth and death registration commenced in 1864 is shown in Table 'A' together with the actual variations in population for each period and the net loss by migration for 1871-1971.

There have been significant changes in the population in the intercensal period between 1971 and 1981. The number of births registered (274,786) during the period shows a decrease of 56,409 compared with the number of births registered in the two 5 year intercensal periods between 1961 and 1971 while the number of deaths registered (167,232) in the same comparative periods shows an increase of 9,599. The excess of births over deaths (107,554) in the intercensal period 1971 to 1981 when placed against the total enumerated population at those respective dates suggest a net outward migration of around 150,000 or an average of 15,000 persons per year over the period. If the estimated population effect of the non-response (almost 20,000) for 1981 is taken into account the net outward migration would be of the order of 130,000 or 13,000 persons per year. This compares with about 60,000 or 6,000 persons per year between 1961 and 1971 and about 90,000 or 9,000 persons per year between 1951 and 1961.

The latest available Government estimate in June 1980 indicated a net outward migration of around 10,000 persons per year. The variation reflects the great difficulty, common to other countries, of obtaining reliable information about migration. In the case of Northern Ireland the difficulty is greater because of the existence of a land border with the Republic of Ireland, where population movement cannot be effectively monitored. It is therefore inevitable that in estimating population, differences of the above nature occur.

Table 'B' below shows the natural increase, ie excess of births over deaths, for each local government district in Northern Ireland, between 1971 and 1981, as well as the total population (enumerated, and estimated) at the end of the period. It reveals that the population of the Belfast local government district continues to decline. In 1971 it was 416,679. At the Census date it was enumerated at 297,862, but the estimated effect of the non-response is 7,900. Taking the latter into account the reduction over the period is of the order of 111,000. Belfast, as in other cities of the United Kingdom, and indeed Europe, has suffered from the problem of inner city decline, although perhaps in a more pronounced way between 1971 and 1981. Factors such as the effects of the troubles, high outward migration, and redevelopment are likely to have been the major influences in the population reduction. It is also relevant to note that Belfast has had a relatively low natural increase in population (4,959), as compared for example with 14,037 for Londonderry, over the period.

The decline in the Belfast population is counterbalanced to some extent by gains in surrounding areas. The most significant gains occur in Lisburn, North Down, Antrim, Ards and Newtownabbey which taking account of the population effect of non-enumerated households show gains of the order of 13,000, 13,000, 12,000, 11,000 and 5,000 respectively. Castlereagh, with a drop of around 3,000 is the only other district showing a significant decrease.

SEXES

At the 1981 Census there were 730,174 males and 760,054 females enumerated. This represents a female/male ratio of 1,041 females per 1,000 males in the enumerated population for Northern Ireland as a whole compared with the ratio of 1,035 at the 1971 Census and 1,051 at the 1966 Census.

TOWNS

The 1971 Preliminary Report contained population information on towns and villages consisting of clusters of 50 or more houses which were located in the administrative rural areas and which had no legally defined boundaries. Similar information is not included in this Report, but will be made available in the more detailed Summary Report to be published in due course following completion of the main processing of results.

In 1971 towns with legally defined boundaries could be identified as such because of their relationship to local government administrative areas. With the introduction of the existing local government districts on 1 October 1973 under the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland) 1972, towns with legally defined boundaries disappeared. However, it is proposed that information for towns will be available in the published Summary Report. This will be achieved by the combination of grid squares.

PRIVATE HOUSEHOLDS

The 1981 figure for enumerated private households is 455,279. The estimated number of households not enumerated is 6,126. Table 3 shows the overall Northern Ireland position by each local government district and Table 5 gives similar information to ward level. On the enumerated figures, the number of households had increased by 27,845 in the intercensal period 1971 to 1981. The estimated number of households not reflected in the enumerated figures is 6,126. The main increases occur in North Down, Lisburn, Ards, Antrim, Newtownabbey, which taking into account the estimate of non-enumerated households, show increases of the order of 5,600, 5,300, 4,400, 4,000 and 3,900 respectively. All other local government districts, except Belfast show an increase in the actual number of households as enumerated.

TABLES 1-5

These tables provide details of the Northern Ireland population from 1821 to 1981 (Table 1), and the population for 1971 and 1981, by local government districts and wards (Tables 2 and 4). They also provide details of private households for 1971 and 1981 by local government districts and wards (Tables 3 and 5).

In addition they contain estimates of non-enumerated households and their effect on the population figures. It should be noted that the estimate for a particular unit (eg the Northern Ireland total) may not equal the sum of the estimates of component sub-units (eg local government districts). For Northern Ireland the estimate is based on the overall enumeration and for the district the enumeration for the district. As both average household sizes and the proportion of non-enumerated households vary from district to district, the total achieved by aggregating districts will not necessarily be the same as the total at Northern Ireland level. In calculating the average household size the population of major communal establishments and institutions has been excluded.

The explanation in the preceding paragraph also applies to the estimated population figures shown in tables B and E (see pages x and xii respectively).
