

Young people today are facing the consequences of major crises over the past decades, as well as the impacts of global transformations including the shifting demographics and a high-inflation low-growth economic outlook. It is in this context that the Recommendation of the Council on Creating Better Opportunities for Young People was adopted at the 2022 OECD Ministerial Council Meeting. The Recommendation promotes a government-wide strategy to improve youth measures and outcomes in all relevant policy areas including employment, entrepreneurship, education, health and social policies, as well as civic engagement and public governance.

APPROACH

The OECD Youth Policy Toolkit is a guide for policy makers and youth stakeholders. It includes good practice examples from OECD member countries on creating better opportunities for young people. Good practices are collected through a call for proposal and desk research, and are selected by the OECD Secretariat based on a set of criteria. Young people are consulted throughout the elaboration of the Toolkit to ensure that the Toolkit responds to their unique challenges and needs.

The OECD Youth Policy Toolkit will take the form of a user-friendly website, and a handbook bringing together goodpractice examples in a freely downloadable document. The Toolkit will be launched at the end of 2024.
