



2023 Okta for Good Impact Report Fact Sheet

Okta’s vision is to free anyone to safely use any technology. Okta for Good helps turn that vision into reality by leveraging our Identity software platform, grant dollars, and employees’ generosity to enable positive change for people and planet. By working in partnership with all of our stakeholders, including customers, employees, and wider communities, we hope to dramatically expand how business and technology can be a powerful force for good.

Methodology: Okta’s fiscal calendar begins on February 1 and ends on January 31, and we refer to years based on the February start date of a fiscal year. The year that began on February 1, 2022, and ended on January 31, 2023, is here referred to as “2022” and “this year.”

*Auth0.org is the social-impact arm of Auth0, which was acquired by Okta in May 2021.

Key takeaways

1. Trust-based giving:

Okta for Good accelerated our trust-based philanthropic giving, exceeding our \$10M three-year philanthropy commitment and our \$3M racial equity commitment. In 2022 alone, we deployed \$6M in grants from the Okta for Good Fund, Okta, Inc., and Okta employees, supporting nearly 4,000 organizations around the world. Auth0.org* granted an additional \$3.5M in charitable grants to support 21 organizations.

2. Digital equity and security:

We leveraged our product and people expertise to help nonprofits around the world address barriers to digital equity and cybersecurity, donating \$5.2M in products and services this year (surpassing our \$10M three-year product donation commitment). We launched our Nonprofit Cybersecurity Portfolio, providing \$1M+ in grants to strengthen security across the social sector, and supported 27 organizations with \$750K in digital equity grants.

3. Meaningful climate action:

Okta has now achieved 100% renewable electricity for our global offices, remote workforce, and third-party cloud service consumption. In addition, our Science-Based Targets for emissions reductions were validated, and we expanded our climate equity grants, and collaborated with industry peers through the Business Council on Climate Change (BC3).
