

Repurchase of own shares in the context of the liquidity contract

In the framework of the liquidity contract (see [press release dated Mar. 1st, 2016](#)), Proximus announces today that Kepler-Cheuvreux on behalf of Proximus has bought 10,600 own shares during the period between 2 January 2023 and 6 January 2023 on Euronext Brussels.

During the same period, Kepler-Cheuvreux on behalf of Proximus has sold 32,500 own shares and consequently this results in a net reduction of 21,900 own shares.
