## INTERNATIONAL ARRIVAL STATISTICS JULY 2024

### MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS:

In July 2024 compared with July 2023:

- ❖ Total arrivals of 24,596 increased by 7.5% (1,721)
- ❖ Total visitors of 19,039 increased by 10.2% (1,769)
- ❖ Total Visitors:
  - ✓ USA: 10.0% (up by 183 visitors)
  - ✓ AUST: 7.7% (up by 325 visitors)
  - ✓ NZ: 11.7% (up by 916 visitors)

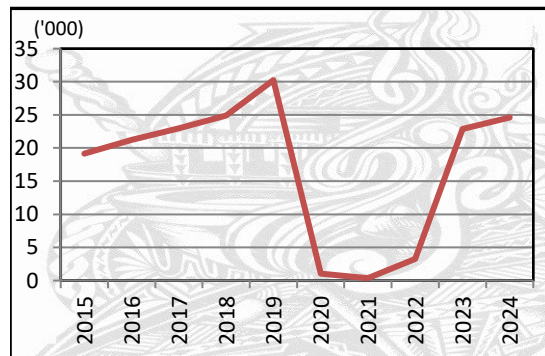
### 1. TOTAL ARRIVALS

The total International Arrival Statistics recorded for the month of **July 2024** totaling 24,596 arrivals, revealed an increase of 11.1 percent over the previous month of June 2024 and an increase of 7.5 percent over the corresponding month of July 2023.

Those who travelled to Samoa by Air represented 93.3% while 6.7% was represented by those who travelled by Sea.

Fig. 1 below graphically depicts the arrival numbers from June 2015 to July 2024, clearly showing the impact of Covid 19 on arrival numbers for April in 2021 and 2022.

Fig. 1: July Total Arrivals, 2015 – 2024

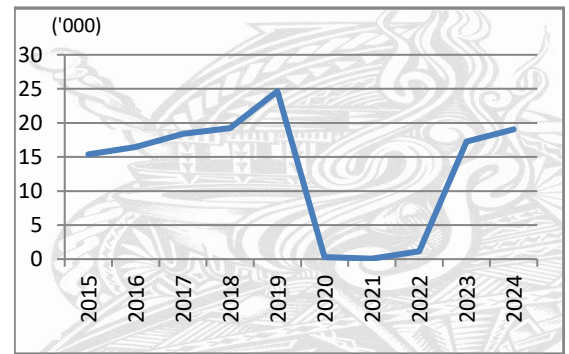


### 2. TOTAL VISITORS

Overall visitor numbers for the month under review stood at 19,036 revealing an increase of 17.9 percent over the previous month of June 2024 and an increase of 10.2 percent over the corresponding month of July 2023.

Fig. 2 illustrates the total number of visitors for July between 2015 and 2024, also indicating the impact of Covid 19 on visitor's numbers for April in 2021 and 2022.

Fig. 2: July Total Visitors, 2015 – 2024



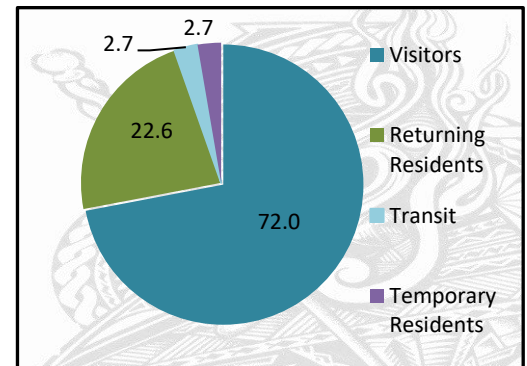
### 3. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY PURPOSE OF ENTRY

Visitors, (Table 2), made up the largest component of all arrivals with 72.0 percent (17,717), represented by 37.0 percent females (9,093) and 35.1 percent males (8,624).

Male returning residents made up 12.2 percent (2,998) of total arrivals while their female counterpart made up 10.4 percent (2,559). (Refer Fig. 3)

Fig. 3: Total Arrivals, by Purpose of Entry, July 2024

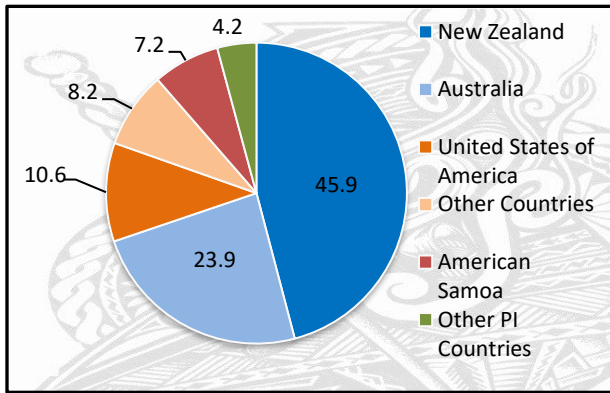


**4. TOTAL VISITORS BY COUNTRY OF USUAL RESIDENCE**

New Zealand remains as the leading country in visitors' arrival by country of usual residence (Table 3) accounting for 45.9 percent of total visitors or 8,743 visitors. Australia followed next with a distant 23.9 percent share (4,554).

United States of America reported 10.6 percent (2,014 visitors) while American Samoa reported 7.2 percent (1,370) of total visitors. (Refer Fig. 4)

**Fig. 4: Total Visitors, by Country of Usual Residence, July 2024**

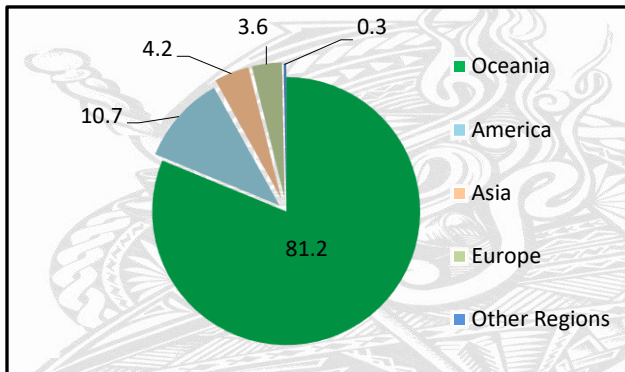


**5. TOTAL VISITORS BY REGION**

As usual, the Oceanic Region had the highest share of total visitors with 81.2 percent, followed by America with 10.7 percent.

Asia reported a share of 4.2 percent while Europe reported the least share of 3.6 percent. (Refer Fig. 5).

**Fig. 5: Total Visitors by Region, July 2024**



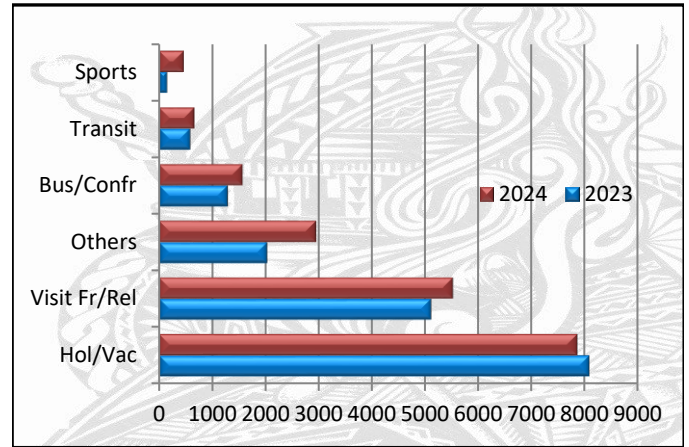
**6. TOTAL VISITORS BY PURPOSE OF VISIT**

The principal source markets (Table 4) namely New Zealand, Australia, American Samoa and the United States of America constitute 87.6 percent of all visitors visiting Samoa in July 2024.

The majority of visitors (7,865) entered our shores for holiday and vacation while 5,523 entered our shores to visit friends and relatives.

Those who were here on Business/Conference recorded 1,567 visitors while those for Sports purposes reported only 469 visitors. Fig.6 depicts total visitors by purpose of visit for July 2023 and July 2024.

**Fig. 6: Total Visitors, by Purpose of Visit, July 2023 & July 2024**

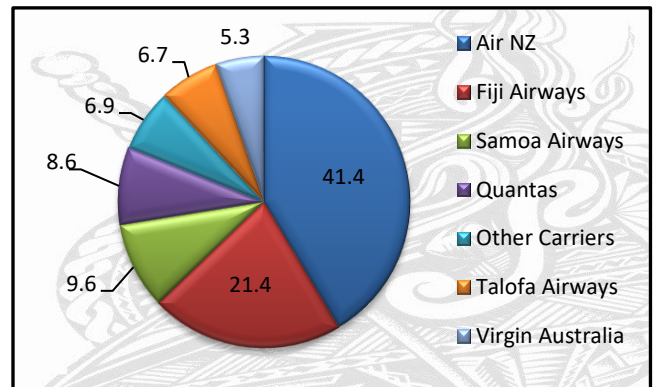


**7. TOTAL ARRIVALS BY CARRIER**

As depicted in table 5, Air New Zealand carried the highest share of passengers to Samoa with a 41.4 percent share, (10,191 passengers) followed by Fiji Airways with a 21.4 percent share (5,259 passengers).

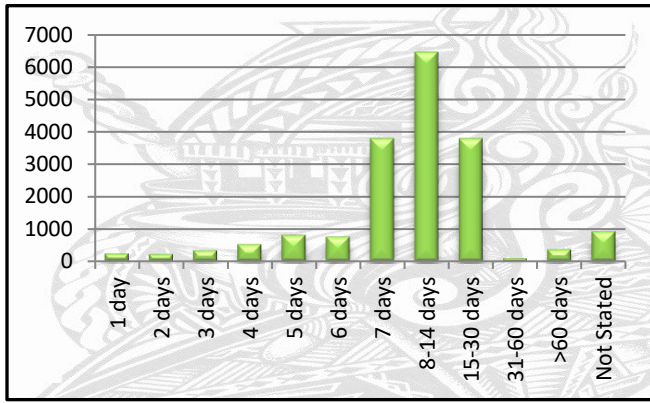
**Fig. 7: Total Arrivals by Carrier, July 2024**

Samoa Airways brought in 9.6 percent (2,373 passengers) of total arrivals while Quantas and Talofa Airways recorded shares of 8.6 percent (2,110) and 6.7 percent (1,657) respectively. Fig. 7 illustrates total arrivals by carrier during the reference period.

**8. TOTAL VISITORS BY DURATION OF STAY AND PLACE OF STAY**

As shown in Fig. 8 below, visitor's duration of stay in Samoa (Table 6) is between seven and thirty days.

On the other hand, the majority of visitors (47.1 percent or 8,647 visitors) reported staying in private accommodations or with families/ relatives while 42.3 percent (7,765) stayed in hotel/ motel. (Refer Fig. 9).

**Fig. 9: Total Visitors by Place of Stay, July 2024**

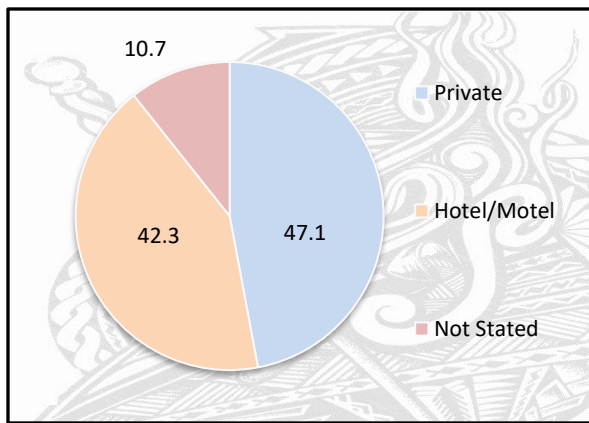
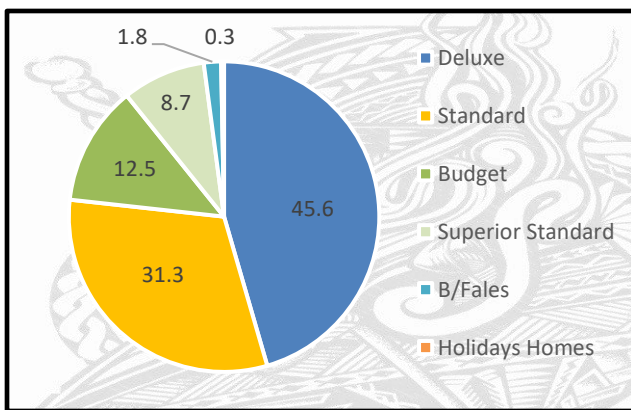


Fig. 10 portrays the number of visitors who stayed in hotels/ motels (7,765) by type of accommodation (hotel/ motel), within the reference month.

- (2) Apia Wharf (Matautu Port)
- (3) Fagalii International Airport

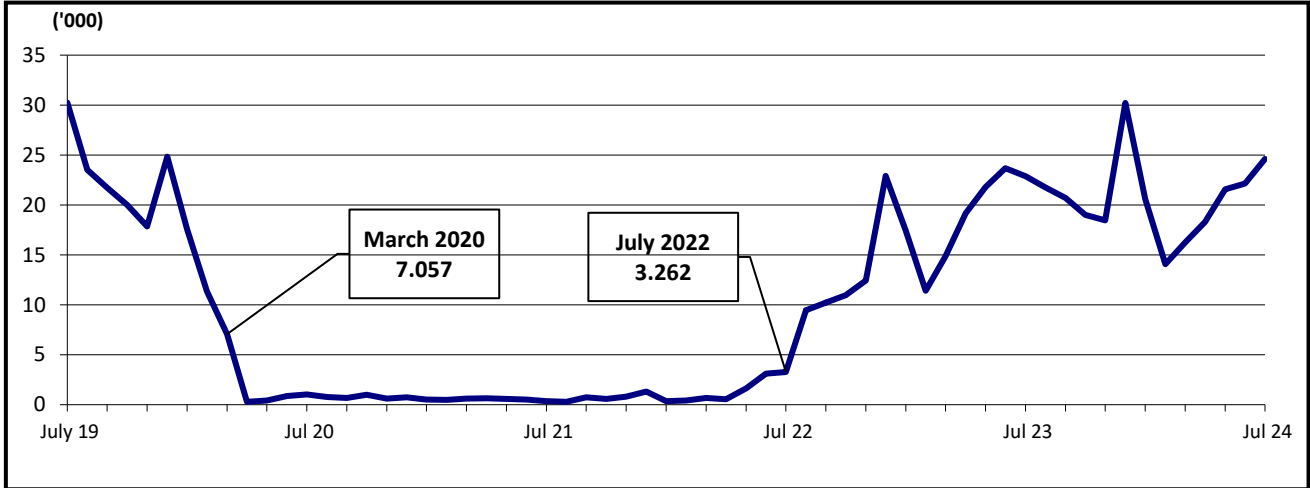
Futhermore, the BMS (Border Management Sytem) was also used for the compilation of such statistics.

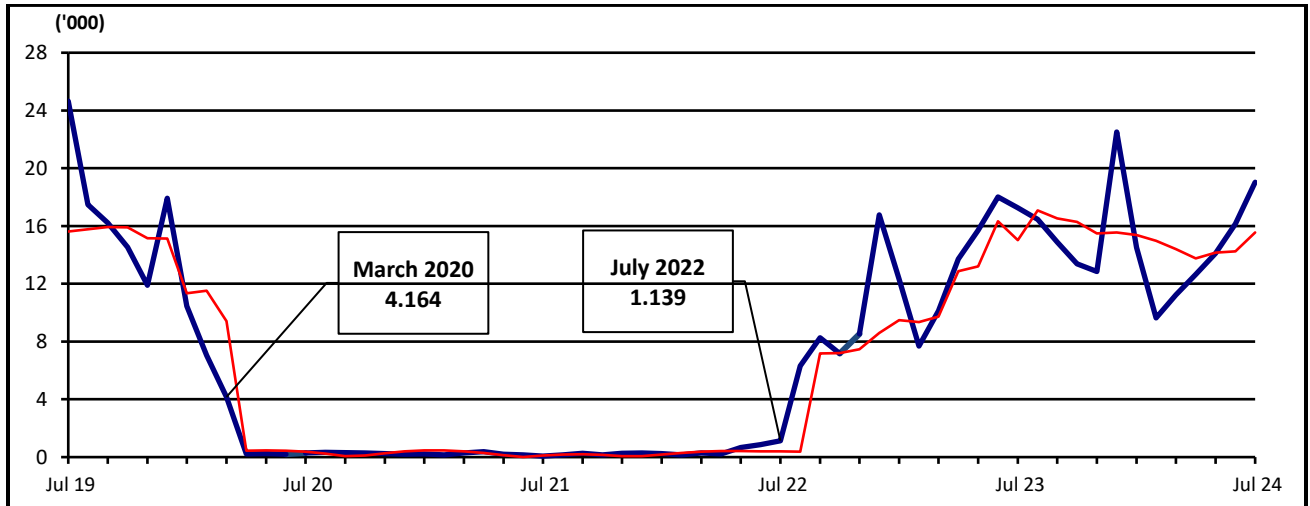

**Graph 1: Monthly Total Arrivals, July 2019 – July 2024**



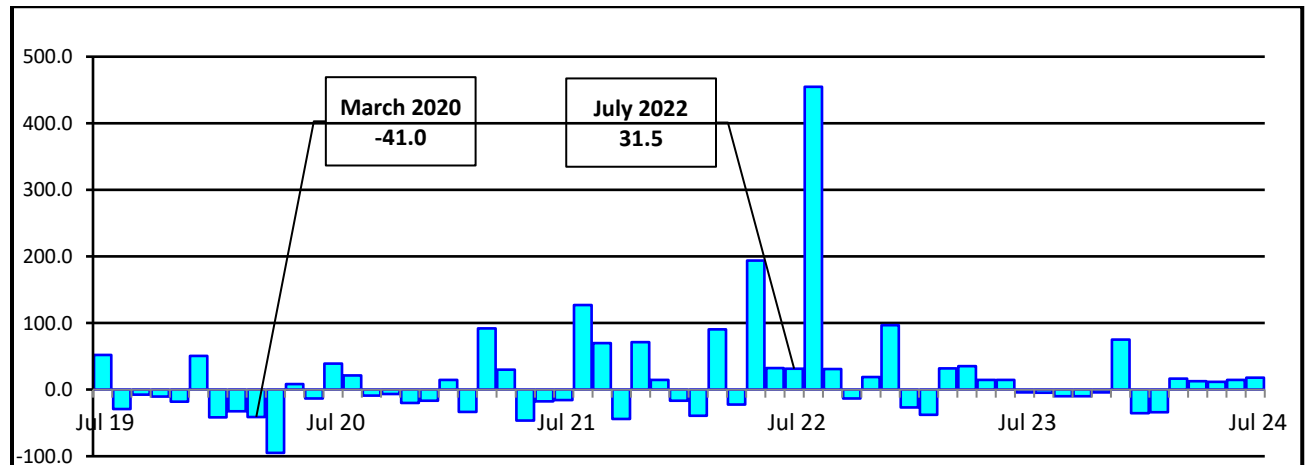
